### AMENDED FINAL JUDGMENT ORDER

of Chicago In Trust For The Use Of The Schools, a Municipal Corporation, for the ascertainment of just compensation to be paid for the taking by plaintiff, of property described in the Complaint for Condemnation. The Complaint for Condemnation having been filed October 8, 1991, and the plaintiff, appearing by its attorney, Earl 7. Neal & Associates, Special Assistant General Counsel, and it appearing to the Court that all parties defendants herein have been served with process in the manner and form provided by statute and all parties interested in the subject property are before the Court and the Court having jurisdiction of the plaintiff and all of the respondents to this suit and of the property legally described herein and the subject matter hereof, and on December 11, 1991, this cause was heretofore duly set for trial for the ascertainment of just compensation to be paid for the taking of the real property hereinafter described, which real property is set forth in said Complaint for Condemnation and the Court having heard testimony, both oral and documentary, and arguments and representation of counsel

in open Court and the parties through their respective attorneys and having waived in the Court being fully advised in the premises, finds and determines that the just compensation to be paid by the plaintiff herein to the owners for the fee simple title to the subject property legally described as follows:

#### (SEE ATTACHED EXHIBIT "A")

is the sum of SEVENTEEN THOUSAND AND NO/100 (\$17,000) DOLLARS for the fee simple title thereto.

AND IT FURTHER appearing that the Sheriff of Cook County attempted to serve process of summons on defendant I. Rita at 201 North Wells, Chicago, Illinois, and that the sheriff's service of process was returned not served because said defendant was not listed at this address. Plaintiff has exercised due diffence in trying to locate said defendant but has been unable to obtain any additional information concerning the location of this party. Wherefore, plaintiff caused a publication to be placed in the Chicago Law Bulletin on October 11, October 18, and October 25, 1991 notifying and advising the public and the defendant of this proceeding to acquire the subject property and notifying them to appear in taid proceeding.

And it appearing to the Court that plaintiff deposited SIX THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED AND NO/100 (\$6,500) DOLLARS on February 4, 1992 with the Treasurer of Cook County, Illinois.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED AND ADJUDGED by the Court that the plaintiff pay to the County Treasurer of Cook County, Illinois, on or before November 20, 1994, for the benefit of the owner or owners of the party or parties interested in the subject property, the additional sum of TEN THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED (\$10,500) DOLLARS said amount

being full and final satisfaction of all takings, damages, costs and claims of defendants arising out of or resulting from plaintiff's Complaint and acquisition of the subjection of the subjection costs. No interest shall accrue on this award.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that upon deposit of said compensation with the County Treasurer as aforesaid, the plaintiff herein shall be vested with the fee simple absolute title 10 and possession of said real property.

The Court funds that there is no just reason for delaying the enforcement of said judgment.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this matter be and is hereby removed from the trial calender.
