TOGETHER with all improvements, tenements, easements, fixtures, and appurtenances thereto belonging, and all rents, issues and profits thereof for so long and during all such times as Mortgagors may be entitled thereto (which are pledged primarily and on a parity with said real estate and not secondarily), and all apparatus, equipment or articles now or hereafter therein or thereon used to supply heat, gas, air conditioning, water, light, power, refrigeration (whether single units or centrally controlled), and ventilation, including (without restricting the foregoing), screens, window shades, storm doors and windows, floor cover-

ings, inador beds, awnings, stoves and water heaters. All of the foregoing are declared to be a part of said real estate whether physically attached thereto or not, and it is agreed that all similar apparatus, equipment or articles hereafter placed in the premises by the mortgagors or their successors or assigns shall be considered as constituting part of the real estate.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the premises unto the said Trustee, its successors and assigns, forever, for the purposes, and upon the uses and trusts herein set forth, free from all rights and benefits under and by virtue of the Homestead Exemption Laws of the State of Illinois, which said rights and benefits the Mortgagors do hereby expressly release and waive.

#### IT IS FURTHER UNDERSTOOD AND AGREED THAT:

- 1. Mortgagors shall (1) promptly repair, restore or rebuild any buildings or improvements now or hereafter on the premises which may become damaged or be destroyed; (2) keep said premises in good condition and repair, without waste, and free from mechanic's or other liens or claims for lien not expressly sub-ordinated to the lien hereof; (3) pay when due any indebtedness which may be secured by a lien or charge on the premises superior to the lien hereof, and upon request exhibit satisfactory evidence of the discharge of such prior lien to Trustee or to holders of the note; (4) complete within a reasonable time any building or building so now or at any time in process of erection upon said premises; (5) comply with all requirements of a variable ordinances with respect to the premises and the use thereof; (6) make no material alterations and premises except as required by law or municipal ordinance.
- 2. Acc ragors shall pay before any penalty attaches all general taxes, and shall pay special taxes, special assess news, water charges, sewer service charges, and other charges against the premises when due, and shall, to or written request, furnish to Trustee or to holders of the note duplicate receipts therefor. To prevent defaul leveluder mortgagors shall pay in full under protest, in the manner provided by statute, any tax or assessment which Mortgagors may desire to contest.

Mortgag rs halkeep all buildings and improvements now or hereafter situated on said premises insured against loss of amage by fire, lightning or windstorm under policies providing for payment by the insurance companies of moner sufficient either to pay the cost of replacing or repairing the same or to pay in full the indebtedness see red i preby, all in companies satisfactory to the holders of the note, under insurance policies payable, in case of loss or damage, to Trustee for the benefit of the holders of the note, such rights to be evidenced by the tended mortgage clause to be attached to each policy, and shall deliver all policies, including additional and reasw I policies, to holders of the note, and in case of insurance about to expire, shall deliver renewal policies not loss in an ten days prior to the respective dates of expiration.

  4. In case of default therein. The set or the holders of the note may, but need not, make any payment or perform any act hereinbefore the set of Mortgagors in any form and manner deemed expedient, and may, but need not, make full or partial payments of principal or interest on prior encumbrances, if any, and purchase, discharge, compromise or settle any 'ax lien or other prior lien or title or claim thereof, or redeem from any tax sale or forfeiture affecting sail premises or contest any tax or assessment. All moneys paid for any of the purposes herein authorized and all expenses paid or incurred in connection therewith, including attorney's fees, and any other moneys advinced by Trustee or the holders of the note to protect the mortgaged premises and the lien hereof, plus reasonable compensation to Trustee for each matter concerning which action herein authorized may be taken, shall but so much additional indebtedness secured hereby and shall become immediately due and payable without notice and with interest thereon at the rate of seven per cent per annum. Inaction of Trustee or holders of the not shall never be considered as a waiver of any right accruing to them on account of any default hereunder on the prior of Mortgagors.

At the option of the holders of the notion without notice to Mortgagors, all unpaid indebtedness secured by this Trust Deed shall, notwithstanding an thing in the note or in this Trust Deed to the contrary, become due and payable (a) immediately in the case of do all in making payment of any instalment of principal or interest on the note, or (b) when default shall occur and continue for three days in the performance of any other agreement of the Mortgagors herein contained
- 7. When the indebtedness hereby secured shall become due whether by acceleration or otherwise, holders of the note or Trustee shall have the right to foreclose the lien hereof. In any suit of foreclose the lien hereof, there shall be allowed and included as additional indebtedness in the decree for sale elementary and expenses which may be paid or incurred by or on behalf of Trustee or holders of the note for attorneys' fees, Trustee's fees, appraiser's fees, outlays for documentary and expert evidence, stenographer charges, publication costs and costs (which may be estimated as to items to be expended after entry or larges, publication costs and costs (which may be estimated as to items to be expended after entry or larges, publication costs and assurances with respect to title as Trustee or holders of the note may deem to be a asonably necessary either to prosecute such suit or to evidence to bidders at any sale which may be had fur use to such decree the true condition of the title to or the value of the premises.   8. The proceeds of any foreclosure sale of the premises shall be distributed and applied in the follow-

The proceeds of any foreclosure sale of the premises shall be distributed and applied in the following order of priority: First, on account of all costs and expenses incident to the foreclosure proceedings, including all such items as are mentioned in the preceding paragraph hereof; second, all other items which under the terms hereof constitute secured indebtedness additional to that evidenced by the note, with interest thereon as herein provided; third, all principal and interest remaining unpaid on the note; fourth, any overplus to Mortgagors, their heirs, legal representatives or assigns, as their rights may appear.
- 9. Upon, or at any time after the filling of a bill to foreclose this trust deed, the court in which such bill is filed may appoint a receiver of said premises. Such appointment may be made either before or after sale, without notice, without regard to the solvency or insolvency of Mortgagors at the time of application for such receiver and without regard to the then value of the premises or whether the same shall be then occupied as a homestead or not and the Trustee hereunder may be appointed as such receiver. Such receiver shall have power to collect the rents, issues and profits of said premises during the pendency of such foreclosure auit and, in case of a sale and a deficiency, during the full statutory period of redemption, whether there be redemption or not, as well as during any further times when Mortgagors, except for the intervention of such

receiver, would be entitled to collect such rents, issues and profits, and all other powers which may be necessary or are usual in such cases for the protection, possession, control, management and operation of the premises during the whole of said period. The Court from time to time may authorize the receiver to apply the net income in his hands in payment in whole or in part of: (1) The indebtedness secured hereby, or by any decree foreclosing this trust deed, or any tax, special assessment or other lien which may be or become superior to the lien hereof or of such decree, provided such application is made prior to foreclosure sale; (2) the deficiency in case of a sale and deficiency.

- 10. No action for the enforcement of the lien or of any provision hereof shall be subject to any defense which would not be good and available to the party interposing same in an action at law upon the note hereby secured.
- 11. Trustee or the holders of the note shall have the right to inspect the premises at all reasonable times and access thereto shall be permitted for that purpose.
- 12. Trustee has no duty to examine the title, location, existence, or condition of the premises, nor shall Trustee be obligated to record this trust deed or to exercise any power herein given unless expressly obligated by the terms hereof, nor be liable for any acts or omissions hereunder, except in case of its own cross negligence or misconduct or that of the agents or employees of Trustee, and it may require indemnities stisfactory to it before exercising any power herein given.
- 13. Trustee shall release this trust deed and the lien thereof by proper instrument upon presentation of satisfactory evidence that all indebtedness secured by this trust deed has been fully paid; and Trustee may evidence and deliver a release hereof to and at the request of any person who shall, either before or after naturity thereof, produce and exhibit to Trustee the note, representing that all indebtedness hereby secured has been aid, which representation Trustee may accept as true without inquiry. Where a release is requested of surcessor trustee, such successor trustee may accept as the genuine note herein described any note which bears a craff ate of identification purporting to be executed by a prior trustee hereunder or which conforms in substance with the description herein contained of the note and which purports to be executed by the persons herein designated as the makers thereof; and where the release is requested of the original trustee and it has never executed a craffication on any instrument identifying same as the note described herein, it may accept as the genuine note herein contained of the note and which purports to be executed by the persons herein designated as makers thereof.
- 14. The Truster is resign by instrument in writing filed in the office of the Recorder or Registrar of Titles in which this in trument shall have been recorded or filed. In case of the resignation, inability or refusal to act as Trustee, the then Recorder of Deeds of the county in which the premises are situated shall be Successor in Trust. Any Si coessor, in Trust hereunder shall have the identical title, powers and authority as are herein given Trustee, and any Trustee or successor shall be entitled to reasonable compensation for all acts performed hereunder.
- 15. This Trust Deed and all process me hereof, shall extend to and be binding upon Mortgagors and all persons claiming under or through Mo tga or, and the word "Mortgagors" when used herein shall include all such persons and all persons liable for the symmeth of the indebtedness or any part thereof, whether or not such persons shall have executed the note or this Trust Deed.
- 16. The Mortgagors shall not without t'e we 'tten consent of the Trustee or the holders of the note sell or convey the property herein described s bject to the interest of the Trustee or the holder of the note whether or not such purchaser shall assume or agree to pay the indebtedness hereby secured. Upon any application for the Trustee's or the holder's of the note consent to such a transaction, the Trustee or the holder of the note may require from the purchaser we'. Information as would normally be required if the purchaser were a new loan applicant. Consent shall not be increasonably withheld, but Trustee or the holder of the note may impose a service charge not exceeding 1% of the original amount of the indebtedness hereby secured and may adjust the contractual interest rate upor the urpaid balance of the obligation secured by this trust deed.
- 17. The lien of this Trust Deed also secures the repayment of the principal and interest on any other indebtedness due and owing from the mortgagors to the holder of the principal note secured by this Trust Deed.

It is understood that in addition to the above mentioned metally sincipal and interest payment, the Mortgagors agree to deposit in an escrew account 1/12th of the estimated improved Real Estate tax bill or the last ascertainable improved Real Estate tax bill monthly, from year to a calendar beging (January to January), not on a "when issued and payable" basis. In add that the rest of the mortgagors agree to deposit 1/12th of the annual hazard insurance premium based on when the college enpires, or when the next premium installment is due. It is also understood that the Trustee or the anide of the note will pay no interest for any monies deposited in said escrew account for taxes and/or it surpose members.
