NOW, THEREFORE, virit Party to secure the payment of the said principal sum of money in accordance with the terms, provisions and limitations of this trust deed, and also in consideration of the sum of One Dollar in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, does by these presents convey and warrant unto the Trustee, its 100 lessors and assigns, the following described Real Estate to wit:

which, with the property hereinafter described, is referred to ereit as the "premises", hereby releasing and waiving all rights under and by virtue of the homestead exemption laws of the State of 1111 HOLE

TOGETHER with all improvements, tenements, easements, fixtures, and appurtenances thereto belonging, and all rents, issues and profits thereof for so long and dring all such times as First Party, their heirs or assigns may be entitled thereto (which are pledged grimarily and on a parity with a said real estate and not secondarily), and all apparatus, equipment or reles now or hereafter therein to rethereon used to supply heat, gas, air conditioning, water, light, power, refrigeration (whether single units or centrally controlled), and ventilation, including (without restriction; the foregoing), screens, window shades, storm doors and windows, floor coverings, inador beds, awnings, stoves and water heaters. All of the foregoing are declared to be a part of said real estate whether physically attached thereto or not, and it is agreed that all similar apparatus, equipment or articles hereafter plac at a the premises by First Party, their heirs or assigns shall be considered as constituting part of the real estate.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the premises unto the said Trustee, its successors and assigns, forever, for the purposes, and upon the uses and trusts herein set forth.

IT IS FURTHER UNDERSTOOD AND AGREED THAT:

1. Until the indebtedness aforesaid shall be fully paid, and in case of the failure of 'irst Party, their heirs or assigns to; (1) promptly repair, restore or rebuild any buildings or improvement, now or hereafter on the premises which may become damaged or be destroyed; (2) keep said premise. In good condition and repair, without waste, and free from mechanic's or other liens or claims for lien not expre aly subordinated to the lien hereof; (3) pay when due any indebtedness which may be secured by a lie or charge on the premises superior to the lien hereof, and upon request exhibit satisfactory evidence of the charge on the premises any form to holders of the note; (4) complete within a reasonable time are building or buildings now or at any time in process of erection upon said premises; (5) comply with all requirements of law or municipal ordinances with respect to the premises and the use thereof; (6) refrain from making material alterations in said premises except as required by law or municipal ordinance; (7) pay before any penalty attaches all general taxes, and pay special taxes, apecial assessments, water charges, sewer service charges, and other charges against the premises when due, and upon written request, to furnish to Trustee or to holders of the note duplicate receipts therefor; (8) pay in full under protest in the manner provided by statute, any tax or assessment which first Party may desire to contest; (9) keep all buildings and improvements now or hereafter situated on said premises insured against loss or damage by fire, lightning or windstorm under policles providing for payment by the insurance companies of moneys satisficate either to pay the coast of replacing or repairing the same or to pay in full the indebtedness secured hereby, all in companies satisfactory to the holders of the note, under insurance policies payable, in case of loss or damage, to Trustee for the benefit of the hidders of the note acust in the red not, make any payment or pay in the insurance about to expire, to deli perceivious of this paragraph.

If The Trustes or the holdern of the note hereby secured making any payment hereby authorized relating to taxes or assessments, may do so according to any bill, statement or estimate procured from the appropriate public office without inquiry into the according to such bill, statement or estimate or into the validity of any tax, assessment, sale, forfeiture, tax lien or title or claim thereof.

3. At the option of the holders of the note and without notice to First Party, their heres or assigns, all impaid indebtedness secured by this trust deed shall, notwithstanding anything in the note or in this trust deed to the contrary, become due and payable (a) immediately in the case of default in making payment on the note, or (b) in the event of the failure of First Party, their heirs or assigns to do any of the things specifically set forth in paragraph one hereof and such default shall continue for three days, said option to be exercised at any time after the expiration of said three day period.

- 4. When the indebtedness hereby secured shall become due whether by acceleration or otherwise, builders of the note or Trustee shall have the right to foreclose the lien hereof. In any suit to foreclose the lien hereof, there shall be allowed and included as additional indebtedness in the decree for sale all expensitures and expenses which may be paid or incurred by or on behalf of Trustee or holders of the note.
- 5. The proceeds of any foreclosure sale of the premises shall be distributed and applied in the following order of priority; First, on account of all costs and expenses incident to the foreclosure proceedings, including all such items as are mentioned in the preceding paragraphs hereof; second, all other items which under the terms hereof constitute secured indebtedness additional to that evidenced by the note, with interest thereon as herein provided; third, all principal and interest remaining unpaid on the note; fourth, any overplus to First Party, their heirs, legal representatives or assigns, as their rights may appear.
- 6. Trust on the holders of the note shall have the right to inspect the premises at all reasonable times and access three shall be permitted for that purpose.
- 7. Trustee this it lease this trust deed and the lien thereof by proper instrument upon presentation of satisfactory evidence that all indebtedness secured by this trust deed has been fully paid.
- 8. Trustee may resignly instrument in writing filed in the office of the Recorder or Registrar of Titles in which this instrument shall have been recorded or filed. In case of the resignation, inability or refusal to act of Trustee, the the Recorder of Deeds of the county in which the premises are situated shall be Successor in Trust. Any Siccessor in Trust hereunder shall have the identical title, powers and authority as are herein given Trustee and any Trustee or successor shall be entitled to reasonable compensation for all acts performed hereunder.
