THIS INDENTURE, made this 14th day of January, 1976, between AMERICAN NATIONAL BANK AND TRUST COMPANY OF CHICAGO, a corporation duly organized and existing as a national banking association under the laws of the United States of America, and duly authorized to accept and execute trusts within the State of Illinois, not personally but as Trustee under the provisions of a deed or deeds in trust duly recorded and delivered to said national banking association in pursuance of a certain Trust Agreement, dated the 1st day of June, 1972, and known as Trust Number 76823, party of the first part, and EILEEN I. PARCEL 2: The North 8 feet of the South 40 feet of the West 19 feet, all being of Lots 26, 27, 28 and 29 taken as a tract in Hitchcock's Subdivision of the West 1/2 of Block 9 in the Canal Trustee's Subdivision of Section 33, Township 40 North, Range 14, East of the Third Principal Meridian, in Cook County, Illinois.
