## IT IS FURTHER UNDERSTOOD AND AGREED THAT:

1. Until the indebtedness aforesaid shall be fully paid, and in case of the failure of first Party, their heirs or assigns to: (1) promptly repair, restore or rebuild any buildings or improvements now or hereafter on the premises which may become damaged or be destroyed; (2) keep said pr.nises of good condition and repair, without waste, and free from mechanic's or other liens or claims for lien not expressly subordinated to the lien hereof; (3) pay when due any indebtedness which may be secured by a lier or charge on the premises superior to the lien hereof, and upon request exhibit satisfactory evidence of the discharge of such prior lien to Trustee or to holders of the note; (4) complete within a reasonable may building or buildings now or at any time in process of erection upon said premises; (5) comply with all requirements of law or municipal ordinances with respect to the premises and the use thereof; (6) refrain from making material alterations in said premises except as required by law or municipal ordinance; (7) pay before any penalty attaches all general taxes, and pay special taxes, special assessments, water charges, sewer service charges, and other charges against the premises when due, and upon written request, to furnish to Trustee or to holders of the note duplicate receipts therefor; (8) pay in full under protest in the manner provided by statute, any tax or assessment which First Party may desire to contest; (9) keep all buildings and improvements now or hereafter situated on said premises insured against loss or damage by fire, lightning or windstorm under policies providing for payment by the insurance companies of moneys sufficient either to pay the cost of replacing or repairing the same or to pay in full the indebtedness secured hereby, all in companies satisfactory to the holders of the note, such rights to be evidenced by the standard mortages clause to be attached to each policy; and to deliver all policies, including additional and renewal policies, to holders of the note, and in cas

2. The Trustee or the holders of the note hereby secured making any payment hereby authorized relating to taxes or assessments, may do so according to any bill, statement or estimate procured from the appropriate public office without inquiry into the accuracy of such bill, statement or estimate or into the validity of any tax, assessment, sale, forfeiture, tax lien or title or claim thereof.

3. At the option of the holders of the note and without notice to First Party, their heirs or assigns, all unpaid indebtedness secured by this trust deed shall, notwithstanding anything in the note or in this trust deed to the contrary, become due and payable (a) immediately in the case of default in making payment on the note, or (b) in the event of the failure of First Party, their heirs or assigns to do any of the things specifically set forth in paragraph one hereof and such default shall continue for three days, said option to be exercised at any time after the expiration of said three day period.

4. When the indebtedness hereby secured shall become due whether by acceleration or otherwise, holders of the note or Trustee shall have the right to foreclose the lien hereof. In any suit to foreclose the lien hereof, there shall be allowed and included as additional indebtedness in the decree for sale all expect ditures and expenses which may be paid or incurred by or on behalf of Trustee or holders of the note.

5. The proceeds of any foreclosure sale of the premises shall be distributed and applied in the following order of priority: First, on account of all costs and expenses incident to the foreclosure proceedings including all such items as are mentioned in the preceding paragraphs hereof; second, all other items which nor the terms hereof constitute secured indebtedness additional to that evidenced by the note, with in secs; thereon as herein provided; third, all principal and interest remaining unpaid on the note; fourth, in a complus to First Party, their heirs, legal representatives or assigns, as their rights may appear.

6. Truste or the holders of the note shall have the right to inspect the premises at all reasonable times and access thereto shall be permitted for that purpose.

7. Trustee stail release this trust deed and the lien thereof by proper instrument upon presentation of satisfactory evidence that all indebtedness secured by this trust deed has been fully paid.

8. Trustee may resign by instrument in writing filed in the office of the Recorder or Registrar of Titles in which this instrument shows been recorded or filed. In case of the resignation, inability or refusal to act of Trustee, the thin Recorder of Deeds of the county in which the premises are situated shall be Successor in Trust. Any Successor in Trust hereunder shall have the identical title, powers and authority as are herein given Trustee and Trustee or successor shall be entitled to reasonable compensation for all acts performed hereunder.
