## IT IS FURTHER UNDERSTOOD AND AGREED THAT:

- 1. Until the 'mach' edness aforesaid shall be fully paid, and in case of the failure of First Party, its successors or assigns U. (1) promptly repair, restore or rebuild any buildings or improvements now or hereafter on the prealiss, which may become damaged or be destroyed; (2) keep said premises in good condition and repair without waste, and free from mechanic's or other liens or claims for lien not expressly subordinated to 'ne lien hereof; (3) pay when due any indebtedness which may be secured by a lien or charge on the neep sess superior to the lien hereof, and upon request exhibit satisfactory evidence of the discharge of sucl prior lien to Trustee or to holders of the note; (4) complete within a reasonable time any building or buildings now or at any time in process of erection upon said premises; (5) comply with all requirem m's of law or municipal ordinances with respect to the premises and the use thereof; (6) refrain from raking material alterations in said premises except as required by law or municipal ordinance; (7) pay before any penalty attaches all general taxes, and pay special taxes, special assessments, water charges, sever service charges, and other charges against the premises when due, and upon written request, to furnish to Pratee or to holders of the note duplicate receipts therefor; (8) pay in full under protest in the manner provided by statute, any tax or assessment which First Party may desire to contest; (9) keep all buildings not improvements now or hereafter situated on said premises insured against loss or damage by fire, lightning or windstorm under policies providing for payment by the insurance companies of moneys surfeien' either to pay the cost of replacing or repairing the same or to pay in full the indebtedness secure 1 breby, all in companies satisfactory to the holders of the holders of the note, such rights to be evidence to the standard mortage clause to be attached to each policy; and to deliver all policies, including n'all contains a finite or the policies, to hol
- 2. The Trustee or the holders of the note hereby secured making any payment hereby cuth rized relating to taxes or assessments, may do so according to any bill, statement or estimate product from the appropriate public office without inquiry into the accuracy of such bill, statement or estimate or into the validity of any tax, assessment, sale, for feiture, tax lien or title or claim thereof.
- 3. At the option of the holders of the note and without notice to First Party, its successors or assigns, all unpaid indebtedness secured by this trust deed shall, notwithstanding anything in the note or in this trust deed to the contrary, become due and payable (a) immediately in the case of default in making payment of any instalment of principal or interest on the note, or (b) in the event of the failure of First Party or its successors or assigns to do any of the things specifically set forth in paragraph one hereof and such default shall continue for three days, said option to be exercised at any time after the expiration of said three day period.
- 4. When the indebtedness hereby secured shall become due whether by acceleration or otherwise, holders of the note or Trustee shall have the right to foreclose the lien hereof. In any suit to foreclose the lien hereof, there shall be allowed and included as additional indebtedness in the decree for sale all expenditures and expenses which may be paid or incurred by or on behalf of Trustee or holders of the note for attorneys' fees, Trustee's fees, appraiser's fees, outlays for documentary and expert evidence, stenographers' charges, publication costs and costs (which may be estimated as to items to be expended after entry of the decree) of procuring all such abstracts of title, title searches and examinations, guarantee policies, Torrens certificates, and similar data and assurances with respect to title as Trustee or holders of the note may deem to be reasonably necessary either to prosecute such suit or to evidence to bidders at any sale which may be had pursuant to such decree the true condition of the title to or the value of the premises. All expenditures and expenses of the nature in this paragraph mentioned shall become so much additional indebtedness secured hereby and immediately due and payable, with interest thereon at the rate of seven per cent per annum, when paid or incurred by Trustee or holders of the note in connection with (a) any proceeding, including probate and bankruptcy proceedings, to which either of them shall be a party, either as plaintiff, claimant or defendant, by reason of this trust deed or any indebtedness hereby secured; or (b) preparations for the commencement of any suit for the foreclosure hereof after accrual of such right to foreclose whether or not actually commenced; or (c) preparations for the defense of any threatened suit or proceeding which might affect the premises or the security hereof, whether or not actually commenced.
- 5. The proceeds of any foreclosure sale of the premises shall be distributed and applied in the following order of priority: First, on account of all costs and expenses incident to the foreclosure proceedings, including all such items as are mentioned in the preceding paragraph hereof; second, all other items which under the terms hereof constitute secured indebtedness additional to that evidenced by the note, with interest thereon as herein provided; third, all principal and interest remaining unpaid on the note; fourth, any overplus to First Party, its legal representatives or assigns, as their rights may appear.
- 6. Upon, or at any time after the filing of a bill to foreclose this trust deed, the court in which such bill is filed may appoint a receiver of said premises. Such appointment may be made either before or after sale, without notice, without regard to the solvency or insolvency at the time of application

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for such receiver, of the person or persons, if any, liable for the payment of the indebtedness secured hereby, and without regard to the then value of the premises or whether the same shall be then occupied as a homestead or not and the Trustee hereunder may be appointed as such receiver. Such receiver shall have power to collect the rents, issues and profits of said premises during the pendency of such foreclosure suit and, in case of a sale and a deficiency, during the full statutory period of redemption, whether there be redemption or not, as well as during any furtner time when First Party, its successors or assigns, except for the intervention of such receiver, would be entitled to collect such rents, issues and profits, and all other powers which may be necessary or are usual in such cases for the protection, possession, control, management and operation of the premises during the whole of said period. The Court from time to time may authorize the receiver to apply the net income in his hands in payment in whole of in part of: (1) The indebtedness secured hereby, or by any decree for foreclosing this trust deed, or any tax secial assessment or other lien which may be or become superior to the lien hereof or of such decree, provided such application is made prior to foreclosure sale; (2) the deficiency in case of a sale and deficiency.

- 7. Trus or o the holders of the note shall have the right to inspect the premises at all reasonable times and across hereto shall be permitted for that purpose.
- 8. Trustee has an duty to examine the title, location, existence, or condition of the premises, nor shall Trustee be obligated to record this trust deed or to exercise any power herein given unless expressly obligated by the terms hereof, nor be liable for any acts or omissions hereunder, except in case of its own gross negligence or micro duct or that of the agents or employees of Trustee, and it may require indemnities satisfactory to it before exercising any power herein given.
- 9. Trustee shall release this trust deed and the lien thereof by proper instrument upon presentation of satisfactory evidence that all is obtedness secured by this trust deed has been fully paid; and Trustee may execute and deliver a release hereof to and at the request of any person who shall, either before or after maturity thereof, produce and exhibit to Trustee the note representing that all indebtedness hereby secured has been paid, whi is representation Trustee may accept as true without inquiry. Where a release is requested of a successor trustee, such successor trustee may accept as the genuine note herein described any note which bears a certificate of identification purporting to be executed by a prior trustee hereunder or which conforms is a betance with the description herein contained of the note and which purports to be executed on behalf of First Party; and where the release is requested of the original trustee and it has never executed a relicate on any instrument identifying same as the note described herein, it may accept as the genuine and herein contained of the note and which conforms in substance with the description herein contained of the note and which purports to be executed on behalf of First Party.
- 10. Trustee may resign by instrument in writing file! in the office of the Recorder or Registrar of Titles in which this instrument shall have been recorded or f ed. In case of the resignation, inability or refusal to act of Trustee, the then Recorder of Deeds of the cand, in which the premises are situated shall be Successor in Trust. Any Successor in Trust hereunder that have the identical title, powers and authority as are herein given Trustee, and any Trustee or successor shall be entitled to reasonable compensation for all acts performed hereunder.
  - 11. Note hereinbefore referred to contains the following clause:

Said note also contains a promise by the maker thereof to deposit add.comal security for the payment of taxes, assessments, insurance premiums and other charges.

THIS TRUST DEED is executed by the undersigned Trustee, not personally, but as Trustee as afore-said; and it is expressly understood and agreed by the parties hereto, anything herein to the containing that each and all of the covenants, undertakings and agreements herein made are made and intended, not as personal covenants, undertakings and agreements of the Trustee, named and referred to in said Agreement, for the purpose of binding it personally, but this instrument is executed and derivered by the First National Bank of Evergreen Park, as Trustee, solely in the exercise of the powers conterred upon it as such Trustee, and no personal liability or personal responsibility is assumed by, nor shall at any time be asserted or enforced against, the First National Bank of Evergreen Park, its agents, or employees, on account hereof, or on account of any covenant, undertaking or agreement herein or in said principal note contained, either expressed or implied, all such personal liability, if any, being hereby expressly waived and released by the party of the second part or holder or holders of said principal or interest notes hereof, and by all persons claiming by or through or under said party of the second part or the holder or holders, owner or owners of such principal notes, and by every person now or hereafter claiming any right or security hereunder.

Anything herein contained to the contrary notwithstanding, it is understood and agreed that the First National Bank of Evergreen Park, individually, shall have no obligation to see to the performance or non-performance of any of the covenants herein contained and shall not be personally liable for any action or nonaction taken in violation of any of the covenants herein contained, it being understood that the payment of the money secured hereby and the performance of the covenants herein contained shall be enforced only out of the property hereby mortgaged and the rents, issues, and profits thereof.
