MUD AMENDMENT TO RESTRICTIVE COVENANTS

This AMENDMENT TO RESTRICTIVE COVENANTS is made as of <u>January 19, 2023</u> by <u>O'KEEFE APARTMENTS OLVNER LLC</u>, an <u>Illinois limited liability company</u> ("Borrower"), and <u>ILLINOIS HOUSING DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY</u> ("Agency").

WHEREAS, Borrower has optoined financing from Merchants Capital Corp., an Indiana corporation ("Lender") for the benefit of the project known as O'Keefe

Apartments ("Project"), which loan is secured by a Multifamily Mortgage.

Assignment of Leases and Rents and Security Agreement ("Security Instrument") dated as of January 19, 2023, and recorded in the Recorder's Office of Cook County, Illinois ("Records") contemporaneously herewith and is insured by the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development ("HUD"),

WHEREAS, Borrower has received an allocation or innois Affordable Housing

Tax Credits from the Agency, which Agency has required certain restrictions be recorded against the Project; and

predecessor in interest to the Borrower, entered into that certain <u>lhinces Affordable</u>

Housing Tax Credit Regulatory Agreement respect to the Project, as more particularly described in Exhibit A attached hereto, dated as of <u>2005 [blanks in date left incomplete in recorded document]</u>, and recorded in the Records on <u>September 15, 2006</u>, as <u>Document Number 0625817081</u>, as subsequently amended by a HUD Amendment to Restrictive Covenants dated as of November 1, 2015, and recorded in the Records on November 18, 2015, as Document Number 15322450445, (the Illinois Affordable Housing Tax Credit Regulatory Agreement dated as of 2005 and HUD Amendment to Restrictive Covenants dated as of November 1, 2015, are collectively referred to in this HUD Amendment as the "Restrictive Covenants").

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WHEREAS, HUD requires as a condition of its insuring Lender's financing to the Project, that the lien and covenants of the Restrictive Covenants be subordinated to the lien, covenants, and enforcement of the Security Instrument; and

WHEREAS, the Agency has agreed to subordinate the Restrictive Covenants to the lien of the Mortgage Loan in accordance with the terms of this Amendment.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing and for other consideration the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, the parties hereby agree as follows:

- (a) In the event of any conflict between any provision contained elsewhere in the Restrictive Covenants and any provision contained in this Amendment, the provision contained in it is Amendment shall govern and be controlling in all respects as set forth more fully herein
 - (b) The following terms shall have the following definitions:

"Code" means the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended.

"HUD" means the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development.

"HUD Regulatory Agreement" means the Regulatory Agreement between Borrower and HUD with respect to the Project, as the same may be supplemented, amended or modified from time to time.

"Lender" means Merchants Capital Corp., an Indiana corporation, its successors and assigns.

"Mortgage Loan" means the mortgage loan made by Lenger to the Borrower pursuant to the Mortgage Loan Documents with respect to the Project.

"Mortgage Loan Documents" means the Security Instrument, the AUD Regulatory Agreement and all other documents required by HUD or Lender in connection with the Mortgage Loan.

"National Housing Act" means the National Housing Act 12 USC § 1701 & seq., as amended.

"Program Obligations" has the meaning set forth in the Security Instrument.

"Residual Receipts" has the meaning specified in the HUD Regulatory Agreement.

"Security Instrument" means the mortgage or deed of trust from Borrower in favor of Lender, as the same may be supplemented, amended or modified.

"Surplus Cash" has the meaning specified in the HUD Regulatory Agreement.

(c) Notwithstanding anything in the Restrictive Covenants to the contrary, except the requirements in 26 U.S.C. 42(h)(6)(E)(ii), to the extent applicable, the provisions hereof are expressly subordinate to (i) the Mortgage Loan Documents,

including without limitation, the Security Instrument, and (ii) Program Obligations (the Mortgage Loan Documents and Program Obligations are collectively referred to herein as the "HUD Requirements"). Borrower covenants that it will not take or permit any action that would result in a violation of the Code, HUD Requirements or Restrictive Covenants. In the event of any conflict between the provisions of the Restrictive Covenants and the provisions of the HUD Requirements, HUD shall be and remains entitled to enforce the HUD Requirements. Notwithstanding the foregoing, nothing herein limits the Agency's ability to enforce the terms of the Restrictive Covenants, provided such terms do not conflict with statutory provisions of the National Housing Act or the regulations related thereto. The Borrower represents and warrants that to the best of Sorrower's knowledge the Restrictive Covenants impose no terms or requirements—that conflict with the National Housing Act and related regulations.

- (d) in accordance with 26 U.S.C. 42(h)(6)(E)(i)(1), in the event of foreclosure (or deed in lieu of inteclosure), the Restrictive Covenants (including without limitation, any and all land use covenants and/or restrictions contained herein) shall automatically terminate, with the exception of the requirements of 26 U.S.C. 42(h)(6)(E)(ii) above, to the extent applicable, or as otherwise approved by HUD
- (e) Borrower and the Agency acknowledge that Borrower's failure to comply with the covenants provided in the Restrictive Covenants will does not and will not serve as a basis for default under the HUD Requirements, unless a separate default also arises under the HUD Requirements.
- (f) Except for the Agency's reporting requirement, in enforcing the Restrictive Covenants the Agency will not file any claim against the Project, the Mortgage Loan proceeds, any reserve or deposit required by HUD in connection with the Security Instrument or HUD Regulatory Agreement, or the rents or other income from the property other than a claim against:
 - i. Available surplus cash, if the Borrower is a for-profit entity;
 - ii. Available distributions of surplus cash and residual receipts authorized for release by HUD, if the Borrower is a limited distribution entity, or
 - iii. Available residual receipts authorized for release by HUD, if the Porrower is a non-profit entity; or
 - iv. A HUD-approved collateral assignment of any HAP contract.
- (g) For so long as the Mortgage Loan is outstanding, Borrower and Agency shall not further amend the Restrictive Covenants, with the exception of clerical errors or administrative correction of non-substantive matters, without HUD's prior written consent.
- (h) Subject to the HUD Regulatory Agreement, the Agency may require the Borrower to indemnify and hold the Agency harmless from all loss, cost, damage and

expense arising from any claim or proceeding instituted against Agency relating to the subordination and covenants set forth in the Restrictive Covenants, provided, however, that Borrower's obligation to indemnify and hold the Agency harmless shall be limited to available surplus cash and/or residual receipts of the Borrower.

(i) Notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained herein, it is not the intent of any of the parties hereto to cause a recapture of the Low Income Housing Tax Credits or any portion thereof related to any potential conflicts between the HUD Requirements and the Restrictive Covenants. Borrower represents and warrants that to the best of Borrower's knowledge the HUD Requirements impose no requirements which may be inconsistent with full compliance with the Restrictive Covenants. The acknowledged purpose of the HUD Requirements is to articulate requirements imposed by HUD, consistent with its governing statutes, and the acknowledged purpose of the Restrictive Covenants is to articulate requirements imposed by Section 42 of the Code. In the event an apparent conflict between the HUD Requirements and the Restrictive Covenant arises, the raties and HUD will work in good faith to determine which federally imposed requirement is controlling. It is the primary responsibility of the Borrower, with advice of counsel, to determine that it will be able to comply with the HUD Requirements and its obligations under the Restrictive Covenants.

The statements and representations contained in this Amendment and all supporting documentation thereto are true, accura'e, and complete. This certification has been made, presented, and delivered for the purpose of influencing an official action of HUD in insuring a multifamily loan, and may be relieu upon by HUD as a true statement of the facts contained therein.
