TRUST DEED

This indenture, made May 18. 2023, between Joseph Brogan, a single person, of 1922 De Cook Ave., Park Ridge, IL 60068, herein referred to as "Mortgagor" and Chicago Title Land Trust Company, an Illinois corporation doing business in Chicago, Illinois, herein referred to as Trustee, witnesseth:

All such payments on account of the indebtedness evidenced by said note to be first applied to interest on the unpaid principal balance and the remainder to principal; provided that each installment unless paid when due shall result in Louir at admands of:

The covenants, conditions and provisions previously referred to are:

- 1. Mortgagor shall (a) promptly repair, restore and rebuild any buildings or improvements now or hereafter on the premises which may become damaged or be destroyed; (b) keep said premises in good condition and repair, without waste, and free from mechanic's or other liens or claims for hen not expressly subordinated to the lien hereof; (c) pay when due any indebtedness which may be secured by a lien or charge on the premises superior to the lien hereof, and upon request exhibit satisfactory evidence of the discharge of such prior lien to Trustee or to holders of the note, (d) complete within a reasonable time, (i) any building or buildings now under construction, (ii) or any building or buildings to be constructed upon said premises; (e) comply with all requirements of laws or municipal ordinances with respect to the premises and the use thereof; (f) make no material after rations in said premises except as required by law or municipal ordinance.
- 2. Mortgagor shall pay before any penalty attaches all general taxes, and shall pay special taxes, special assessments, whiter charges, sewer service charges, and other charges against the premises when due, and shall, upon written request, furnish to the Trustee or to the holders of the note duplicate receipts therefore. To prevent default here invier Mortgagor shall pay in full under protest, in the manner provided by statute, any tax or assessment, which Mortgagor desires to contest.
- 3. Mortgagor shall keep all buildings and improvements now or hereafter situated on said premises insured against loss or damage by fire, lightning or windstorm (and flood damage, where the lender is required by law to have its loan so insured) under policies providing for payment by the insurance companies of moneys sufficient either to pay the cost of replacing or repairing the same or to pay in full the indebtedness secured hereby, all in companies satisfactory to the holders of the note, under insurance policies payable, in case of loss or damage, to the Trustee for the benefit of the inciders of the note, such rights to be evidenced by the standard mortgage clause to be attached to each policy, and shall deliver all policies, including additional and renewal policies, to the holders of the note, and in case of insurance about to expire, shall deliver renewal policies not less than ten days prior to the respective dates of expiration.
- 4. In case of default therein, the Trustee or the holders of the note, or any or them, may, but need not, make any payment or perform any act hereinbefore required of Mortgagor in any room and manner deemed expedient, and may, but need not, make full or partial payments of principal or interest or prior encumbrances, if any, and purchase, discharge, compromise or settle any tax lien or other prior lien or title or claim thereof, or redeem from any tax sale or forfeiture affecting said premises or contest any tax or assessment. All moneys paid for any of the purposes herein authorized and all expenses paid or incurred in connection therewith, including attorneys' fees, and any other moneys advanced by the Trustee or the holders of the note, or of any of them, to protect the mortgaged premises and the lien hereof, plus reasonable compensation to the Trustee for each matter concerning which action herein authorized may be taken, shall be so much additional indebtedness secured hereby and shall become immediately due and payable without notice and with interest thereon at a rate equivalent to the highest post maturity rate set forth in the note secured by this trust deed, if any, otherwise the highest pre maturity rate set forth therein. Inaction of the Trustee or the holders of the note shall never be considered as a waiver of any right accruing to them on account of any default hereunder on the part of the Mortgagor.
- 5. The Trustee or the holders of the note hereby secured making any payment hereby authorized relating to taxes or assessments, may do so according to any bill, statement or estimate procured from the appropriate public office without inquiry into the accuracy of such bill, statement or estimate or into the validity of any tax, assessment, sale, forfeiture, tax lien or title or claim thereof.

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- 6. Mortgagor shall pay each item of indebtedness herein mentioned, both principal and interest, when due according to the terms hereof. At the option of the holders of the installment note, and without notice to Mortgagor, all unpaid indebtedness secured by this Trust Deed shall, notwithstanding anything in the installment note or in this Trust Deed to the contrary, become due and payable (a) immediately in the case of default in making any payment on the installment note, or (b) when default shall occur and continue for three days in the payment of any interest or in the performance of any other agreement of the Mortgagor herein contained.
- When the indebtedness hereby secured shall become due whether by acceleration or otherwise, holders of the note, or the Trustee shall have the right to foreclose the lien hereof. In any suit to foreclose the lien hereof there shall be allowed and included as additional indebtedness in the decree for sale all expenditures and expenses, which may be paid or incurred by or on behalf of the Trustee or holders of the notes, or any of them, for attrirn ys' fees, Trustee's fees, appraiser's fees, outlays for documentary and expert evidence, stenographers' and ges, publication costs and costs (which may be estimated as to Items to be expended after entry of the decree of procuring all such abstracts of title, title searches and examinations, guarantee policies, Torrens certificates, and similar data and assurances with respect to title as Trustee or holders of the notes, or any of them, may deem to be reasonably necessary either to prosecute such suit or to evidence to bidders at any sale which may be had pursuant to such decree the true condition of the title to or the value of the premises. All expenditures and expenses of the nature in this paragraph mentioned shall become so much additional indebtedness secured hereby and immediately due and payable, with interest thereon at a rate equivalent to the highest post maturity rate set forth in the notes securing this trust deed, if any, otherwise the highest pre maturity rate set forth therein, when paid or incurred by Trustee or holders of the notes in connection with (a) any proceeding including probate and bankruptcy proceedings, to which either of them shall be a party, either as plaintiff claimant or defendant, by reason of this trust deed or any indebtedness hereby secured; or (b) preparations for the commencement of any suit for the foreclosure hereof after accrual of such right to foreclose whether or not actually commenced; or (c) preparations for the defense of any threatened suit or proceeding which might affect the premises or the courity hereof, whether or not actually commenced.
- 8. The proceeds of any foreclosure sale of the premises shall be distributed and applied in the following order of priority: First, on account of all costs and expenses incident to the foreclosure proceedings, including all such items as are mentioned in the preceding paragraph hereof; second, all other items which under the terms hereof constitute secured indebtedness additional to that evidenced by the principal notes with interest thereon as herein provided; third, all principal and interest remaining unpaid on the principal notes; fourth, any overplus to Mortgagor, their heirs, legal representatives or assigns, as their rights may approar.
- 9. Upon, or at any time after the filling of a bill to foreclose this trust deed, the court in which such bill is filed may appoint a receiver of said premises. Such appointment may be made either before or after sale, without notice, without regard to the solvency or insolvency of the Mortgagor at the time of application for such receiver and without regard to the then value of the premises or whether the same shall be then occupied as a homestead or not and the Trustee hereunder may be appointed as such receiver. Such receiver shall have the power to collect the rents, issues and profits of said premises during the pendency of such foreclosure suit and, in case of a sale and a deficiency, during the full statutory period of redemption, whether there be redemption or not, as well as during any further times when Mortgagor, except for the intervention of such receiver, would be entitled to collect such rents, issues and profits, and all other powers which may be necessary or are usual in such cases for the protection, possession, control, management, and operation of the premises during the whole of said period. The Court from time to time may authorize the receiver to apply the net income in his hands in payment in whole or in part of: (a) The Indebtedness secured hereby, or by any



decree foreclosing this trust deed, or any tax, special assessment or other lien which may be or become superior to the lien hereof or of such decree, provided such application is made prior to foreclosure sale; (b) the deficiency in case of sale and deficiency.

- 10. No action for the enforcement of the lien or of any provision hereof shall be subject to any defense which would not be good and available to the party interposing same in an action at law upon the notes hereby secured.
- 11. Trustee or the holders of the notes, or of any of them, shall have the right to inspect the premises at all reasonable times and access thereto shall be permitted for that purpose.
- 12. Trustee has no duty to examine the title, location, existence, or condition of the Premises, or to inquire into the validity of the signatures or the identity capacity, or authority of the signatories on the note or the trust deed, nor sna'l flustee be obligated to record this trust deed or to exercise any power herein given unless expressly obligated by the terms hereof, nor be liable for any acts or omissions hereunder, except in case of its own gross negligence or misconduct or that of the agents or employees of Trustee, and it may require indemnities satisfactory to 't before exercising any power herein given.
- 13. Trustee shall release this trust dead and the lien thereof by proper instrument upon presentation of satisfactory evidence that all indeptedness secured by this trust deed has been fully paid; and Trustee may execute and deliver a release hereof to and at the request of any person who shall either before or after maturity thereof, produce and exhibit to Trustee the principal notes, representing that all indebtedness hereby secured has been paid, which representation Trustee may accept as true without inquiry. Where a release is requested of a successor trustee, such successor trustee may accept as the genuine notes herein described any notes which bear an identification number ourporting to be placed thereon by a prior trustee hereunder or which conform in substance with the description herein contained of the principal notes and which purport to be executed by the persons herein designater as the makers thereof; and where the release is requested of the original trustee and it has never placed its identification number on the principal notes described herein, it may accept as the genuine principal notes herein described any notes which may be presented and which conform in substance with the description herein contained of the principal notes and which purport to be executed by the persons herein designated as makers thereof.
- 14. Trustee may resign by instrument in writing filed in the office of the Recorder in which this instrument shall have been recorded. Any Successor in Trust hereunder shall have the identical title, powers and authority as are herein given Trustee.
- 15. This Trust Deed and all provisions hereof, shall extend to the be binding upon Mortgagor and all persons claiming under or through Mortgagor, and the word "Mortgagor" when used herein shall include an such persons and all persons liable for the payment of the indebtedness or any part thereof, whether or not such persons shall have executed the principal notes or this Trust Deed.
- 16. The Mortgagor hereby waives any and all rights of redemption from sale under any order or decree of foreclosure of this trust deed, on its own behalf of each and every person, except decree or judgment creditors of the Mortgagor, acquiring any interest in or title to the premises subsequent to the date of this trust deed.
- 17. Before releasing this trust deed, Trustee or successor shall receive for its services a fee as determined by its rate schedule in effect when the release deed is issued. Trustee or successor shall be entitled to reasonable compensation for any other act or service performed under any provisions of this trust deed.



The provisions of the "Trust and Trustees Act" of the State of Illinois shall be applicable to this trust Deed.

Notwithstanding the above provisions, the mortgagor shall be allowed a ten-day grace period on the monthly installment, if payment is not received on or before the tenth day after the due date, a penalty of Ten Per Cent (10%) of the Payment Amount shall be as less id and due with said payment. Any penalty not paid shall continue to accrue until paid. The amount due shall be construed to mean the monthly payment.
- 4. The maker hereof hereby agrees to deposit mouthly with the holder of this Installment Note and Trust Deed, a Cotto sum equal to One Twelfth (1/12) of the annual real est; te taxes upon demand of the holder.
