an Illinois banking corporation having its principal office in the Village of Skokie, Illinois, (herein referred to as "Trustee"), witnesseth:

THAT, WHEREAS, the Mortgagors are justly indebted to the legal holder or holders of the Installment Note hereinafter described (said legal holder or holders being herein referred to as Holders of the Note) in the principal sum of **Ten Thousand Nine-Hundred Fifty-Five Dollars and Forty Cents..... Dollars (\$10,955.40)**, evidence by one certain Installment Note of the Mortgagors of even date herewith, made payable to BREKINRIDGE and delivered, in and by which said Note the Mortgagors, or else to pay the said principal sum and interest on the balance of principal remaining from time to time unpaid at the rate of **12.5%** per annum prior to maturity in monthly installments as follows:
One Hundred Eighty-Two Dollars and Fifty-Nine Cents..... Dollars \$182.59,
on the **5th day of October 1975** and a like sum on the **5th day** of each and every month thereafter until said Note is fully paid except that the final payment of principal and interest, if not sooner paid, shall be due on the **5th day of September 1980**. All monthly payments on account of the indebtedness evidenced by said Note shall be first applied to interest on the unpaid principal balance and the remainder to principal and the principal of each installment unless paid when due shall bear interest at the rate of seven per cent per annum.

All payments of principal and interest shall be made payable at such banking house or trust company in the village of Skokie, Illinois, as the holders of the Note may, from time to time, in writing appoint, and in absence of such appointment, then at the office of Old Orchard Bank & Trust Co.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Mortgagors to secure the payment of the said principal sum of money and said interest in accordance with the terms, provisions and limitations of this Trust Deed, and the performance of the covenants and agreements herein contained, by the Mortgagors to be performed, and also in consideration of the sum of One Dollar in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents CONVEY and WARRANT unto the Trustee, its successors and assigns, the following described Real Estate and all of their estate, right, title and interest therein, situate, lying and being in the **Village of Glenview** County of **Cook** and State of Illinois, to wit:

which, with the property hereinafter described, is referred to herein as the "Premises."

TOGETHER with all buildings, improvements, fixtures, equipment, furniture, and appurtenances thereto belonging, and all rents, issues, and profits thereof for so long and during all such times as Mortgagors may be entitled thereto (which are pledged unconditionally and on a parity with all other obligations of the Mortgagors for the payment of the principal sum of the Note and interest thereon accrued hereby and not subsequently), and, without limiting the generality of the foregoing, all apparatus and equipment of every kind now or hereafter installed or thereto used to supply heat, gas, air conditioning, water, light, power, refrigeration (whether single units or centrally controlled), and ventilation, and all screens, window shades, storm shades and windows, curtains, floor coverings, gas and electric fixtures, stoves, bathtubs, sinks and water heaters. All of the foregoing are declared to be a part of said real estate whether previously attached thereto or not, and any agreement that similar apparatus, equipment or articles heretofore placed in the premises by the mortgagors or their successors or assigns shall be considered part of the real estate.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the premises unto the said Trustee, its successors and assigns, forever, for the purposes, and upon the uses and trusts herein set forth, free from all rights and benefits under and by virtue of the Homestead Exemption Laws of the State of Illinois, which said rights and benefits the Mortgagors do hereby expressly release and waive.

IT IS FURTHER UNDERSTOOD AND AGREED THAT:

1. Mortgagor shall (1) promptly repair, restore or rebuild any building or improvements now or hereafter on the premises which may be one damaged or destroyed; (2) keep all premises in good condition and repair, without waste, and free from mechanic's or other liens or claims for lien not expressly subordinated to the lien hereof; (3) pay when due, interest, taxes, rents, charges or any other amounts due to the holders of the Note, and upon request exhibit valid acts or evidence of the discharge of such obligation to Trustee or to holders of the Note; (4) comply with all applicable zoning, building, and similar ordinances or regulations affecting the use of the said premises; (5) comply with all requirements of law or municipal ordinances, with respect to the premises and the use thereof; and (6) without prior written consent of the holders of the Note being first had and obtained, (a) make no material alterations in said premises except as required by law or municipal ordinance, (b) any use of said property for a purpose other than that for which the same is now used, (c) any alterations, additions to, demolition or removal of any of the improvements, appurtenances, fixtures or equipment now or hereafter upon said property, (d) a sale, assignment or transfer of any right, title or interest in and to said property or any portion thereof, or any improvements, appurtenances, fixtures or equipment which may be found in or upon said property.

2. Mortgagors shall pay before any penalty attaches all general taxes, and shall pay special taxes, special assessments, water charges, sewer service charges, and other charges against the premises when due, and shall, upon written request, furnish to Trustee or to holders of the note duplicate records thereof. To prevent default hereunder Mortgagors shall pay in full under protest, in the manner provided by statute, and tax or assessment which Mortgagors may desire to contest.

3. Mortgagors shall keep all buildings, equipment and fixtures constituting the Mortgaged Property or any part thereof insured against loss or damage by fire and lightning with extended coverage (and windstorm and hail if not included in extended coverage) or other casualty, in such amounts and with responsible insurance company or companies acceptable to the Trustee or holder(s) of the principal note secured hereby, (but such coverage shall in no event be less than 80% of the insurable value thereof), and all risks insurable under such policies shall be payable to Trustee by the mortgagee or trustee clause known as Cook County Inspection Bureau Standard form, or such other form as satisfactory to the Trustee or holder(s) of the Note secured hereby to be attached to such policies, and all such policies shall be delivered to Trustee. In case of the foreclosure of this Trust Deed, the costs in the collection of the principal note and interest thereon, including attorney's fees, and all expenses of collection, may cause a new loss clause to be attached to each of said policies making the loss thereunder payable to said decree creditor; and any such foreclosure decree, may further provide, that in case of one or more redemptions under said decree, pursuant to the status in such case made and provided, then and in every such case, each successive redeemer may cause the preceding loss clause attached to each insurance policy to be canceled and a new loss clause be attached thereto, making the loss thereunder payable to the new redeemer. In the event of a foreclosure sale, Trustee is hereby authorized, without consent of Mortgagors, to assign any and all insurance policies to the holder of the certificate of sale. In the event of a foreclosure sale, the holder(s) of the principal note, holder(s) of the certificate of sale or the decree creditor, who may be, is hereby authorized and to settle and adjust any claim under such policies, without consent of Mortgagors, as to allow Mortgagors to agree with the insurance company or companies the amount to be paid upon the loss. In either case the holder(s) of the policy or policies is authorized to collect and apply for any such insurance money and apply it in reduction of the indebtedness secured hereby, whether due or not, or may allow Mortgagors to use said insurance money or any part thereof, in repairing the damage or restoring the building or improvement, provided that in any payout occurring after the end of the term period for the full amount secured hereby, in case of loss after foreclosure proceedings have been instituted the proceeds of any such insurance policies or policies applied as aforesaid in repairing or restoring the building or improvement, shall be used to pay the amount due in accordance with any decree of foreclosure that may be entered in any such proceeding, and the balance, if any, shall be paid to the owner of the equity of redemption if he shall then be entitled to the same as the court may direct.

4. In case Mortgagor shall fail to perform any covenant herein contained, Trustee or the holders of the Note may, but need not, make any payment or perform any act hereinbefore required of Mortgagor in any form and manner described or required, and in case of any such failure, may make full or partial payment of principal or interest, or both, or any other sums due, or may foreclose, or otherwise dispose of the property, or may sue for damages, or may purchase, discharge, compromise or settle any action or claim or other proceeding, or may take title to the property or any part thereof from the holder(s) or from another, or for any other purpose, effecting a release or discharge of the Note, or may contest any tax assessment. All monies paid for any of the purposes herein authorized and all expenses paid or incurred in connection therewith, including attorney's fees, and any other monies advanced by Trustee or the holders of the Note to protect the mortgaged premises and the lien hereof, plus reasonable compensation to Trustee for each matter concerning which action herein authorized may be taken, shall be so much additional indebtedness secured hereby and shall become immediately due and payable without notice and with interest thereon at the rate of seven per cent per annum. Inaction of Trustee or holders of the Note shall never be considered as a waiver of any right accruing to them on account of any default hereunder on the part of Mortgagor.

5. The Trustee or the holders of the Note hereby assume making any payment hereby authorized relating to taxes or assessments, may do so according to any bill, statement or estimate presented from the appropriate public office without inquiry into the accuracy of such bill, statement or estimate or into the validity of any tax, assessment, fee, forfeiture, tax, fine or title or claim thereto.

6. Mortgagors shall pay each item of indebtedness herein mentioned, both principal and interest, when due according to the terms hereof. At the option of the holders of the Note, and without notice to Mortgagors, all unpaid indebtedness accrued by this Trust Deed shall notwithstanding anything in the Note or in this Trust Deed to the contrary, become due and payable (a) in the case of default for ten days in making payment of any installment of principal or interest on the Note, or (b) when default shall occur and continue for thirty days in the performance of any other agreement of the Mortgagors herein made.

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7. When the indebtedness hereby secured shall become due whether by acceleration or otherwise, holders of the Note or Trustee shall have the right to foreclose the lien hereof. In any suit to foreclose the lien hereof, there shall be allowed and included as additional indebtedness in the decree for sale all expenditures and expenses which may be paid or incurred by or on behalf of Trustee or holders of the Note for attorney's fees, Trustee's fees, appraiser's fees, outlays for documentary and expert evidence, stenographers' charges, publication costs and costs of service, which may be incurred in the entry of the decree for proceeding at law or otherwise of title, title search, recording, and other expenses of title. Taxes, certificates, and similar debts and assessments with respect thereto, as well as Trustee's hold of such property, shall be reasonably necessary either to prosecute such suit or to evidence to bidders at any sale which may be had pursuant to such decree the true condition of the title to or of the value of the premises. All expenditures and expenses of the nature in this paragraph mentioned shall become so much additional indebtedness secured hereby and immediately due and payable, with interest thereon at the rate of seven per cent per annum, when paid or incurred by Trustee or holders of the Note in connection with (a) any proceeding, including probate and bankruptcy proceedings, to which either of them shall be a party, either as plaintiff, claimant or defendant, by reason of this Trust Deed or any indebtedness hereby secured; or (b) preparations for the commencement of any suit for the foreclosure hereof after accrual of such right to foreclose whether or not actually commenced; or (c) preparations for the defense of any threatened suit or proceeding which might affect the premises or the security hereof, whether or not actually commenced.

8. The proceeds of any foreclosure sale of the premises shall be distributed and applied in the following order of priority: First, on account of all costs and expenses incident to the foreclosure proceedings, including all such items as are mentioned in the preceding paragraph hereof; second, all other items which under the terms hereof constitute secured indebtedness additional to that evidenced by the Note, with interest thereon as herein provided; third, all principal and interest remaining unpaid on the Note; fourth, any debt due to Mortgagors; fifth, heirs, legal representatives or assigns, as their rights may appear.

9. Upon, or at any time after the filing of a bill in chancery this Trust Deed, the court in which such bill is filed may appoint a receiver of said premises. Such appointment may be made either before or after sale, without notice, without regard to the solvency or insolvency of Mortgagors at the time of application for such receiver and without regard to the fair value of the premises or whether the same shall be then occupied as a homestead or not and the Trustee hereunder may be appointed as such receiver. Mortgagors shall have power to sell all or any part of the premises at public auction or at private sale, and in either case, if the sale does not produce a deficiency, during the full statutory period of redemption, whether there be redemption or not, as well as during any further times when Mortgagors, except for the intention of avoidance, would be entitled to collect such rents, issues and profits, and all other powers which may be necessary or are usual in such cases for the protection, possession, control, management and operation of the premises during the whole of such period. The Court from time to time may authorize the receiver to apply the net income in his hands in payment in whole or in part of: (1) The indebtedness secured hereby, or by any decree foreclosing this Trust Deed, or any tax, special assessment or other lien which may be or become superior to the lien hereof or of such debts, provided such application is made prior to foreclosure sale; (2) the deficiency in case of a sale and deficiency.

10. No action for the enforcement of the lien or of any provision hereof shall be subject to any defense which would not be good and available to the party interposing same in an action at law upon the Note hereby secured.

11. Trustee or the holders of the Note shall have the right to inspect the premises at all reasonable times and access thereto shall be permitted for that purpose.

12. Trustee has no duty to examine the title, location, existence, or condition of the premises, nor shall Trustee be obliged to record this Trust Deed or to exercise any power herein given unless expressly obligated by the terms hereof, nor be liable for any acts or omissions hereunder, except in case of its own gross negligence or misconduct or that of the agents or employees of Trustee, and it may require indemnities satisfactory to it before exercising any power herein given.

13. Trustee shall be causa sua this Trust Deed and the lien hereof by proper instrument upon presentation of satisfactory evidence that all indebtedness secured by this Trust Deed has been fully paid, and Trustee may execute a release hereof to and in favor of any person who shall, either before or after maturity thereof, prepay and exhibit to Trustee the note, representing that all indebtedness hereby secured has been paid, which representation Trustee may accept as true without inquiry. Where a release is executed of a successor trustee, such successor trustee may accept as the genuine Note herein described any note which bears a certificate of identification purporting to be executed by a prior trustee hereunder or which conforms in substance with the description herein contained of the Note and which purports to be executed by the persons herein designated as successors thereto; and where the release is requested of the original trustee and it has never executed a certificate on any instrument identifying same as the Note described herein, it may accept as the genuine Note herein described any note which may be presented and which conforms in substance with the description herein contained of the Note and which purports to be executed by the persons herein designated as successors thereto.

14. Trustee may resign by instrument in writing filed in the office of the Recorder or Registrar of Titles in which this instrument shall have been recorded or filed. In case of the resignation, inability or refusal of any Old Orchard Bank & Trust Co., as Trustee, then the Chicago Title and Trust Company, of Cook County, Illinois, shall be and it is hereby appointed Successor in Trust. Any Successor in Trust hereunder shall have the identical title, powers and authority as are herein given Trustee, and any Trustee or successor shall be entitled to reasonable compensation for all acts performed hereunder.

15. This Trust Deed and all provisions hereof, shall extend to and be binding upon Mortgagors and all persons claiming under or through Mortgagors; and the word "Mortgagors" when used herein shall include all such persons and all persons liable for the payment of the indebtedness or any part thereof, whether or not such persons shall have executed the Note or this Trust Deed.

16. In order to provide for the payment of taxes, assessments and insurance premiums required to be paid hereunder by Mortgagors, Mortgagors shall deposit with the holders of the Note, or such other person, firm or corporation as is in law of the Note may designate, on each monthly payment date an amount equal to 1/12th of the annual taxes and assessments levied against the premises and 1/12th of the annual premium on all such insurance as determined by the amount of the last available bills. The money thus deposited in such trust and insurance reserves are to be held without interest and to be applied in the payment of such taxes and assessments as the same become due or for renewing insurance policies when the same expire or for paying premiums thereon, and in the event any deficit shall exist in the amount of such deposits, Mortgagors agree to deposit any sum necessary to meet such deficiency. Nothing in this paragraph contained, however, shall relieve Mortgagors from the performance of all obligations, covenants and agreements of Mortgagors herein contained, the holder(s) of the Note may apply any and all sums then on deposit on account of the indebtedness secured hereby.

17. Old Orchard Bank & Trust Co., individually may buy, sell, own and hold the Note or any interest therein, before or after maturity, and whether or not a default shall occur hereunder, and said holder(s) & holder(s) of the Note or any interest therein in every subsequent holder thereof shall be entitled to all the same security and to all the same rights and remedies as are provided for in this Trust Deed, provided, however, if such holder(s) were not the Trustee under this Trust Deed. No merger of the interest of said Bank as a holder of the Note and as Trustee hereunder shall ever be deemed to have occurred or happened. Any actions or remedies provided in this Trust Deed to be taken by the Trustee or the holder of the Note may be taken jointly by the Trustee and any holder of the Note.

18. The covenants, agreements, conditions, promises and undertakings in this Trust Deed contained, shall extend to and be binding upon Mortgagors and any and all persons claiming by, through or under Mortgagors, the same as if they were in every case named and expressed, and all the covenants hereof shall bind them, and each of them, both jointly and severally, and shall inure to the benefit of Trustee, its successors and assigns, and of the holders of the Note.

19. Except as herein expressly provided to the contrary, no remedy or right herein conferred upon or reserved to the Trustee, or to the holder(s) of the note hereby secured, is intended to be to the exclusion of any other remedy or right, but each and every such remedy or right shall be cumulative and shall be in addition to every other remedy or right given hereunder and now or hereafter existing at law or in equity. No delay or omission to exercise any remedy or right accruing on any default shall impair any such remedy or right, or shall be construed to be a waiver of any such default, or acquiescence therein, nor shall it affect any subsequent default of the same or a different nature. Every such remedy or right may be exercised from time to time and as often as may be deemed expedient. — Trustee or by the holder(s) of the Note hereby secured.

20. The invalidity of any one or more covenants, phrases, clauses, sentences or paragraphs of this Trust Deed shall not affect the remaining portions of this Trust Deed, or any part thereof, and in case of any such invalidity, this Trust Deed shall be construed as if such invalid covenants, phrases, clauses, sentences or paragraphs had not been inserted.


