Until the indebtedness aforesaid shall be fully paid, and in case of the failure of First Party, its successors or assigns to: (1) promptly repair, restore or rebuild any buildings or improvements now or herea to on the premises which may become damaged or be destroyed; (2) keep said premises in good condition and repair, without waste, and free from mechanics or other liens or claims for lien not expressly subordinated to the lien hereof; (3) pay when due any indebtedness which may be secured by a lien or charge on the premises superior to the lien hereof, and upon request exhibit satisfactory evidence of he discharge of such prior lien to Trustee or to holders of the note; (4) complete within a reasonable of any building or buildings now or at any time in process of erection upon said premises; (5) on ply with all requirements of law or numicipal ordinances with respect to the premises and the use interest. (6) refrain from making material alterations in said premises except as required by law or municipal ordinance; (7) pay before any penalty attaches all general taxes, and pay special taxes, special assessomely, water charges, sewer service charges, and other charges against the premises when due, and upon writ on request, to furnish to Trustee or to holders of the note duplicate receipts therefor; (3) pay in full unier protest in the manner provided by statute, any tax or assessment which First Party may desire to confact; (9) keep all buildings and improvements now or hereafter situated on said premises insured against loss or damage by fire, lightning or windstorm under policies providing for payment by the insurance of moneys sufficient either to pay the coet of replacing or repairing the same or to pay in the indebtedness secured hereby, all in companies satisfactory to the holders of the note, and in case of insurance shout to expire, to deliver renewal policies not less than ten days prior to the respective dates of expi atin; then Trustee or the holders of the note, and in case of insurance about of this paragraph.
- 2. The Trustee or the holders of the note hereby secured making any payment hereby authorized relating to taxes or assessments, may do so according to any bill, statement or estimate procured from the appropriate public office without inquiry into the accurricy of such bill, statement or estimate or into the validity of any tax, assessment, sale, forfeiture, tax lien or title or claim thereof.
- 3. At the option of the holders of the note and without notile a First Party, its successors or assigns, all unpaid indebtedness secured by this trust deed shall, not violated anything in the note or in this trust deed to the contrary, become due and payable (a) immediately in the case of default in making payment of any instalment of principal or interest on the note, or the event of the failure of First Party or its successors or assigns to do any of the things specifically set forth in paragraph one hereof and such default shall continue for three days, said option to be exprised at any time after the expiration of said three day period.
- 4. When the indebtedness hereby secured shall become due whether by accident ion or otherwise, holders of the note or Trustee shall have the right to foreclose the lien hereof. In any list to foreclose the lien hereof, there shall be allowed and included as additional indebtedness in the decree for sale all expenditures and expenses which may be paid or incurred by or on behalf of Trustee or holders of the note for attorneys' fees, Trustee's fees, appraiser's fees, outlays for documentary and expenses tenographers' charges, publication costs and costs (which may be estimated as to items the expended after entry of the decree) of procuring all such abstracts of title, title searches and examinations, guarantee policies, Torrens certificates, and similar data and assurances with respect to title as Trustee or holders of the note may deem to be reasonably necessary either to prosecute such suit or to evidence to bidders at any sale which may be had pursuant to such decree the true condition of the title to or the value of the premises. The proceeds of any foreclosure sale of the premises shall be distributed and applied in the following order of priority: First, on account of all costs and expenses incident to the foreclosure proceedings, including all such items as are mentioned in the preceding paragraph hereof; second, all other items which under the terms hereof constitute secured indebtedness additional to that evidenced by the note, with interest thereon as herein provided; third, all principal and interest remaining unpaid on the note; fourth, any overplus to First Party, its legal representatives or assigns, as their rights may appear. the not appear.
- 6. Upon, or at any time after the filing of a bill to foreclose this trust deed, the court in which such bill is filed may appoint a receiver of said premises. Such appointment may be made either before or after sale, without notice, without regard to the solvency or insolvency at the time of application

for such receiver, of the person or persons, if any, liable for the payment of the indebtedness secured hereby, and without regard to the then value of the premises or whether the same shall be then occupied as a homestead or not and the Trustee hereunder may be appointed as such receiver. Such receiver shall have power to collect the rents, issues and profits of said premises during the pendency of such foreclosure suit and, in case of a sale and a deficiency, during the full statutory period of redemption, whether there be redemption or not, as well as during any further time when First Party, its successors or assigns, except for the intervention of such receiver, would be entitled to collect such rents, issues and profits, and all other powers which may be necessary or are usual in such cases for the protection, possession, control, management and operation of the premises during the whole of said period. The Court from time to time may authorize the receiver to apply the net income in his hands in payment in whole or in part of: (1) The indebtedness secured hereby, or by any decree for foreclosing this trust deed, or any tax, special assessment or other lien which may be or become superior to the lien hereof or of such decree, provided such application is made prior to foreclosure sale; (2) the deficiency in case of a ale and deficiency.


