TRUST DEED (MORTGAGE)

THIS INDENTURE, dated August 12, 1975, between

Christ A. Weist and Donna M. Weist, his wife

of the City of Chicago, County of Cook, State of Illinois (hereinafter called the "Grantors") and CONTINENTAL ILLINOIS NATIONAL BANK AND TRUST COMPANY OF CHICAGO, a national banking association doing business in the City of Chicago, County of Cook, State of Illinois (hereinafter, together with its successors and assigns, called the "Trustee").

WITNESSED:

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of a certain Retail Installment Contract (hereinafter called the "Contract"), of even date hereinafter between the Grantors and Active Lumber, & Remodeling Company, as Seller, the Grantors are justly indebted in the sum of Twenty-Two thousand Nine Hundred Fifty and 00/100 (\$22,500) Dollars to the legal holder of the Contract, which indebtedness is payable at the offices of CONTINENTAL ILLINOIS NATIONAL BANK AND TRUST COMPANY OF CHICAGO, 231 South LaSalle Street, Chicago, Illinois 60693 in 120 successive monthly installments, each of \$191.25, except for a final installment of \$_____, commencing 45 days after the Completion Date provided for in the Contract, and on the same date of each month thereafter until paid in full;

NOW, THEREFORE, to secure the payment, in accordance with the provisions of the Contract, of said indebtedness, and the performance of all other covenants, agreements and obligations of the Grantors under the Contract and hereunder, the Grantors hereby CONVEY and WARRANT to the Trustee the following described real estate (hereinafter called the "premises") situated in the City of Chicago, County of Cook, State of Illinois, to wit:

South twenty-five (25) feet of the North two hundred twelve (212) feet of the West 101.47 Feet of Lot six (6) in Block twenty-seven (27) in Canal Trustees' Subdivision of Blocks in South fractional Section 29 Township 39 North, Range 14-Eas of the Third Principal Meridian.

(This is a Junior Lien) subject to that certain mortgage from Christ A. Weist and Donna M. Weist, his wife to District Savings & Loan Association dated September 14, 1962 and registered September 14, 1962 as Document No. 18590862.

together with all improvements, tenements, easements, fixtures and appurtenances now or hereafter thereto belonging, including all heating, air-conditioning, gas and plumbing apparatus and fixtures, and every other appurtenance thereto, and all rents, issues and profits thereof or therefrom, hereby releasing and waiving my and all rights under and by virtue of the homestead exemption laws of the State of Illinois.

The Grantors covenant and agree (1) to pay said indebtedness, and all other amounts that may be payable under the Contract, as provided in the Contract or according to any instrument extending the time of payment, (2) to pay, before any penalty attaches, all taxes and assessments against said premises, and to defend to exhibit receipts therefor, (3) within sixty days after any destruction or damage, to rebuild or restore all buildings and improvements on the premises that may have been destroyed or damaged, (4) that waste to the premises shall not be committed, (5) to keep all buildings and other improvements on the premises or hereafter on the premises insured against such risks, for such amounts and with such companies and under such policies, and in such form, all as shall reasonably be satisfactory to the legal holder of the Contract, such policies shall provide that loss thereunder shall be payable first to the holder of any prior encumbrance on the premises, and second to the Trustee, in their respective interests as appear, and, upon request, to furnish to the Trustee or to the legal holder of the Contract, such evidence of such insurance and loss to pay, when due, all indebtedness which may be secured by any prior encumbrance on the premises.

The Grantors further agree that if any tax or assessment, or any other amount secured hereby shall at the option of the legal holder of the Contract, be not paid, procure such insurance or pay such taxes or assessments, a discharge or partition may be had in title after time the premises, or pay the indebtedness securing any prior encumbrance on the premises, and the Grantors agree to reimburse the Trustee or the legal holder of the Contract, as the case may be, upon demand, for the amounts so paid, together with interest thereon at the highest law contract rate from the date of payment to the date of reimbursement, and the same shall be a much additional indebtedness security hereby.

The Grantors further agree that in the event of a breach of any of the aforesaid covenants or agreements, or of any covenants or agreements contained in the Contract, the holder of the second hereby shall, at the option of the legal holder of the Contract, without demand or notice of any kind, but notwithstanding the said payment, and shall be recoverable by fine, late fees, or by suit of law or both, to the same extent as such indebtedness is created by its express terms.

The Grantors further agree that all expenses in full discharge paid or incurred in behalf of plaintiff in connection with the foreclosure hereof (including reasonable attorney's fees, surface for documentary expenses, stamp fees, charges and cost of procuring or completing abstract showing the above items of expense and verifying the foreclosed title) shall be paid by the Grantors, and the like expenses and disbursements as incurred by the legal holder pending when the Trustee or the legal holder of the Contract, as such, may be a party, shall also be paid by the Grantors. All legal expenses and disbursements shall be an additional lien upon the premises, and shall be taxed, levied and recovered in any decree that may be rendered in such cause, in the proceedings, which proceedings, whether decree of sale shall have been entered or not, shall be determined, not reduced, but increased, until all such expenses and disbursements, and the costs of suit, including attorney's fees, have been paid. The Grantors, for the Grantors and for the heirs, executors, administrators, successors and assigns of the Grantors, waive all right to the possession of and the use from the premises pending such foreclosure proceedings, and agree that, up to the time of a decree suspending a foreclosure of this Trust Deed, the court in which such complaint is filed may at any time, and without regard to the Grantors or any party claiming under the Grantors, appoint a receiver to take possession or charge of the premises with power to collect the rents, avails and profits of the premises.

The Trustee shall, upon receipt of the amount of the fees, if any, for the preparation of such release, release this Trust Deed and the hen thereto by proper instrument, upon presentation of satisfactory evidence that all indebtedness secured by this Trust Deed has been fully paid, and the Trustee may execute and deliver a copy hereof to the representative of any person who shall, either before or after the maturity thereof, produce and exhibit to the Trustee the Contract, representing that all indebtedness secured hereby has been paid, which representative, the Trustee may accept true and without further inquiry.

The hen of this Trust Deed is a witness and subscriber to the fact of any prior encumbrance of record on the premises.

The term "Grantors" as used herein shall mean all persons signing this Trust Deed and each of them, and this Trust Deed shall be jointly and severally binding upon such persons and their respective heirs, executors, administrators, successors and assigns.

All obligations of the Grantors, and all rights, powers and remedies of the Trustee and the holder of the Contract, expressed herein shall be in addition to, and not in limitation of, those provided in the Contract or by law.

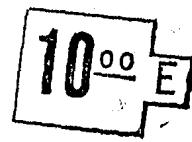
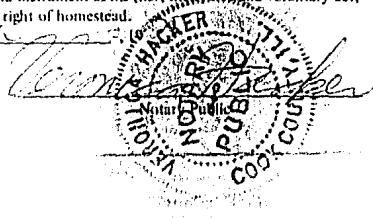
