This Indenture Witnesseth, THAT THE GRANTOR

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the property and all the appurtenances thereto, unto the said person, for the uses and purposes herein and in said trust agreement set forth.

The case of a joint and several liability trust is similar to the case of a general power of appointment trust, except that the holder of the general power of appointment may exercise it only to the extent that the rights of the trust have been exhausted by the exercise of the other powers of the trust. The general power of appointment may be changed or prolonged to the extent that the holder of the general power of appointment has the right to do so. In addition, the general power of appointment may be exercised to the extent that the holder of the general power of appointment has the right to do so under the terms of the trust, or after an amendment executed by the holder of the general power of appointment. The general power of appointment may be exercised to the extent that the holder of the general power of appointment has the right to do so under the terms of the trust created by this Indenture and the law of the jurisdiction in which the holder of the general power of appointment resides. Any amendment thereto was executed in accordance with the trusts, and no amendment thereto was made without the written consent and agreement of all or some amendment thereto and binding upon all beneficiaries thereunder. Each such amendment was duly authorized and empowered to execute and deliver every such deed, will, trust, lease, power of appointment, or other instrument or conveyance as may be necessary to effect the purpose for which such successor in interest acts, and each such amendment is made in the course of a succession of successors in trust, power, authority, during such time as the holder of the general power of appointment and any title, estate, rights, powers, authorities, during such time as the holder of the general power of appointment and any title, estate, rights,

The interest of each and every beneficiary in the real estate and personal property mentioned herein or any of them shall be only in the earnings, accretions and proceeds arising from the said real estate, as reported by said real estate, and such interest is hereby declared to be personal property, and the bearing and burden of all taxes of any kind of interest, legal or equitable, in or to said real estate as well as to any interest in the earnings, accretions and proceeds thereof, has been released.

If the title to any of the above lands is now or hereafter registered, the Registrar of Titles is hereby directed not to register or note in the certificate of title or duplicate thereof any general or specific words of trust or appointment, or with limitations, or words of similar import, in accordance with the statutory rules made and provided.

And the said grantor hereby expressly waives and releases all liability and all right or benefit under and by virtue of any and all Statutes of the State of Illinois providing for the exemption of homesteads from sale on execution or otherwise.
