UNITED STATES MARSHAL'S DEED

THIS INDENTURE, made this 7th day of June , 1979, between John J. Adams, United States Marshal for the Northern District of Illinois, party of the first part, and the Secretary of Housing and Urban Development, Washington, D. C., for and on behalf of the United States of America, rarty of the second part,

WHEREAS, in r rsuance of a decree entered on July 21, 1978, by the United States District Court for the Northern District of Illinois, in a certain cause pending therein, wherein the United States of America was the plaintiff and Exchange National Bank of Chicago, a National Banking Association, as Trustee Under Trust Agreement Date 1 June 2, 1962, Known as Trust No. 14454, and "Unknown Owners" and Marvin A. Jones, were defendants, Civil No. 78 C 281, the said Marshal duly advertised according to law the premises hereinafter described for sale at public auction to the highest and best bidder for cash at the hour of 2:00 P.M. in the afternoon on Peramber 15, 1978, at the Richard J. Daley Center, in the City of Chicago, County of Cook, State of Illinois.

AND WHEREAS, at the time and place aforesaid appointed for said sale, the United States Marshal attended to make the same, and offered and exposed said premises for sale at public auction to the highest and best bidder for cash, and thereupon the Secretary of Housing and Urban Development, Washington, D. C., offered and bid therefor the sum of Seventy-Four Thousand (\$74,000.00) Plars, this sum being the highest and best bid offered, said Marshal accordingly struck off and sold to the Secretary of Housing and Urban Development, Washington, D. C., for the said sum of money, the said premises, and thereupon did sign, seal and deliver the usual Marshal's Certificate of Sale to the Secretary of Housing and Urban Development, Washington, D. C., for and on behalf of the United States of America.

DECREE OF FORECLOSURF

This cause having been heard by the court upon the record herein, the court finds:


- 1. That it has jurisdiction of the parties to and the subject matter of this suit;
- That all the material allegations of the complaint are true and proven;
- 3. That, by virtue of the Mortgage and Mortgage Note secured as alleged in the verified complaint, there is due to the plaintiff, and it has a valid and subsisting lien upon the hereinafter described property as follows:

(A) a. Unpaid principal balance as of June 30, 1978 \$71,295.06

b. Unpaid accrued interest at 6% per annum to 6,773.20 June 30, 1978

c. Unpaid accrued service charges to June 30, 294.98

(B) That, although the plaintiff, United States of America is exempt from payment of court costs, Marshal's fees and United States actor...v's fees, this exemption does not extend to the defendants nor to their assigns nor to any purchaser or purchasers (other than plaintiff) at any sale held under any decree entered in this cause, and the court costs, Marshal's fees and United States Attorney's fees should be computed and made a part of this decree as constructive costs to be collected in the event of any sale to any purchaser or purchasers (other than plaintiff). The constructive costs to the defendants of this decree are as follows:

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- 4. That the rights and interests of all the other parties to this cause, in and to the property here insiter described, are inferior to the liens of the plaintiff mentioned in saturgraph 3 of this decree;
- 5. That the Mortgage described in the complaint and hereby fore-closed was recorded in the Office of the Recorder of Deeds of Cook County, Illinois, on June 21, 1974 as Document No. 22758,003, and the property herein referred to and directed to be sold is that situated in Cook County, Illinois, described as Mollows:

Lots 14, 15, 16 and 17 in Block 10 in Dauphin Park, a subdivision of the North 3/4 of the West 1/2 lying West of Illinois Central Railroad right of way in Section 2, Township 37 North, Range 14 East of the Third Principal Meridian, in Cook County, Illinois.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED:

A. That, unless within three days from the date of the entry of this decree there shall be paid to the plaintiff the respective sums, with interest thereon and for the uses and benefits mentioned in paragraph 3(a) and 3(b) of this decree, the real estate hereinabove described, together with all improvements thereon and appurtenances belonging thereto, or so much thereof as may be necessary to pay the

B. That said Marshal give public relies of the time, place and terms of such sale by publishing the same at least once in each week for four (4) successive weeks in a secular newspape of general circulation published in Cook County, Illinois, the first publication to be not less than four (4) weeks before the date of said sale, that he may adjourn the sale so advertised by giving public notice by proclamation, and by publishing in the same manner as hereinabove provided for the giving of the first notice; that plaintiff or any of the parties to this cause may become the purchaser or purchasers at such sale; that, upon such sale being made, said Marshal execute and deliver to the purchaser or purchasers a Certificate or Certificates of Sale and record a duplicate thereof, as required by law.

C. That said Marshal, upon making such sale, shall with all commercial speed report the same to the Court for its approval and confirmation, and he shall likewise report the distribution of the proceeds of sale and his acts and doing in connection therewith; that, out of the proceeds of such sale, he shall make distribution in the following order of priority:

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- for his dislataments and expenses necessarily incurred in correction with such sale;
- (b) to the plaintiff or his attorney of record, the amount mentioned in paragraph 3(a) of this decree, plus additional interest to date of sale; and
- (c) for his commission and the constructive costs taxed by the Clerk of this Court.
- D. That the Marshal take receipts from the respective parties to whom he may have made payments as aforesaid, and file same with his report of sale and distribution in this Court; that if, after payment of all the foregoing items, there shall still be a semainder he hold the surplus subject to the further order of this Court, and if there be insufficient funds to pay in full the amounts found duberein, he specify the amount of deficiency in his report of sale.
- E. That defendant, Exchange National Bank of Chicago, as Trustee under Trust No. 14454, was personally served on February 6, 1978; and that defendant, Marvin A. Jones, through his attorney, filed his appearance on April 18, 1978.
- F. That, if this Court shall approve the Marshal's report, the Marshal or his successor, upon production of said Certificate of Sale by the legal holder thereof, shall forthwith execute and deliver to him a good and sufficient Deed of conveyance of said premises; and that thereupon the grantee or grantees in such Deed, or his or their

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legal representative or representatives or assigns, be let into possession of said promises; and that any of the parties to this cause who shall be in possession of said premises, or any portion thereof, or any persons who may have come into such possession under them, or any of them, since the commencement of this suit, shall, upon production of said Deed of conveyonce, surrender possession of said premises to said grantee or grantees, his or her representatives or assigns, and in default of so doing a Writ of Assistance shall issue.

The Court hereby retains jurisdiction of the subject matter of this cause and of all the parties hereto for the purpose of enforcing this decree, and for the purpose of appointing or continuing a Receiver herein.


