WHEREAS, in pursuance of a decree entered on May 2, 1980, by the United States District Court for the Northern District of Illinois, in a certain cause pending therein, wherein the United States of America was the plaintiff and Baptist Towers, Inc., was defendant; Civil Action No. 7° C 2491, the said Marshal duly advertised according to law the premises hereinafter described for sale at public auction to the highest and best bidder for cash at the hour of 1:00 P.M. in the afternoon on June 12, 1980, at the Richard J.
