THE FOLLOWING ARE THE COVENANTS, CONDITIONS AND PROVISIONS REFERRED TO ON PAGE 1 (THE REVERSE SIDE OF THIS TRUST DEED) AND WHICH FORM A PART OF THE TRUST DEED WHICH THERE BEGINS:

- 1. Mortgagors shall (1) keep said premises in good condition and repair, without waste; (2) promptly repair, restore, or rebuild an buildings or improvements now or hereafter on the premises which may become damaged or be destroyed; (3) keep said premises free from mechanic's liens or liens in favor of the United States or other liens or claims for lien not expressly subordinated to the lien hereof; (4) pay whe due any indebtedness which may be secured by a lien or charge on the premises superior to the lien hereof, and upon request exhibit satisfactor evidence of the discharge of such prior lien to Trustee or to holders of the note; (5) complete within a reasonable time any building or building now or at any time in process of erection upon said premises; (6) comply with all requirements of law or municipal ordinances with respect to the premises and the use thereof; (7) make no material alterations in said premises except as required by law or municipal ordinance or a previously consented to in writing by the Trustee or holders of the note.
- 2. Mortgagors shall pay before any penalty attaches all general taxes, and shall pay special taxes, special assessments, water charges, sewer service charges, and other charges against the premises when due, and shall, upon written request, furnish to Trustee or to holders of the note the original or duplicate receipts therefor. To prevent default hereunder Mortgagors shall pay in full under protest, in the manner provided by statute, any tax or assessment which Mortgagors may desire to contest.
- 3. Mortgagors shall keep all buildings and improvements now or hereafter situated on said premises insured against loss or damage by fire, lightning and windstorm under policies providing for payment by the insurance companies of moneys sufficient either to pay the cost of replacing or repairing the same or to pay in full the indebtedness secured hereby, all in companies satisfactory to the holders of the note, under insurance policies provided to access of damage, to Trustee for the benefit of the holders of the note, such rights to be evidenced by the standard mortgage classet is be attached to each policy, and shall deliver all policies, including additional and renewal policies, to holders of the note, and in case classes are shall deliver renewal policies not less than ten days prior to the respective dates of expiration.
- 4. In c so of default therein, Trustee or the holders of the note may, but need not, make any payment or perform any act hereinbefore required of Mort agers in any form and manner deemed expedient, and may, but need not, make full or partial payments of principal or interest on prior encumb ances, if any, and purchase, discharge, compromise or settle any tax lien or other prior lien or title or claim thereof, or redeem from any tax size of refeture affecting said premises or contest any tax or assessment. All moneys paid for any of the purposes herein authorized and all expenses it in a first incurred in connection therewith, including reasonable attorneys' fees, and any other moneys advanced by Trustee or the holders of the note. The cach matter concerning which action herein at hor zed may be taken, shall be so much additional indebtedness secured hereby and shall become immediately due and payable without notice and y in interest thereon at the rate of seven per cent per annum. Inaction of Trustee or holders of the note shall never be considered as a waiver, an right accruing to them on account of any default hereunder on the part of Mortgagors.
- 5.
