- 1. Mortgagors shall (1) keep said premises in good condition and repair, without waste; (2) promptly repair, restore, or rebuild any buildings or improvements now or hereafter on the premises which may become damaged or be destroyed; (3) keep said premises free from mechanic's liens or liens in favor of the United States or other liens or claims for lien not expressly subordinated to the lien hereof; (4) pay when due any indebtedness which may be secured by a lien or charge on the premises superior to the lien hereof, and upon request exhibit satisfactory evidence of the discharge of such prior lien to Trustee or to holders of the note; (5) complete within a reasonable time any building or buildings now or at any time in process of erection upon said premises; (6) comply with all requirements of law or municipal ordinances with respect to the premises and the use thereof; (7) make no material alterations in said premises except as required by law or municipal ordinance or as previously consented to in writing by the Trustee or holders of the note.
- 2. Mortgagors shall pay before any penalty attaches all general taxes, and shall pay special taxes, special assessments, water charges, sewer service charges, and other charges against the premises when due, and shall, upon written request, furnish to Trustee or to holders of the note the original or duplic receipts therefor. To prevent default hereunder Mortgagors shall pay in full under protest, in the manner provided by statute, any tax or possessment which Mortgagors may desire to contest.
- 3. Mortgagors shall keep all buildings and improvements now or hereafter situated on said premises insured against loss or damage by fire, lightning and windstorm ander policies providing for payment by the insurance companies of moneys sufficient either to pay the cost of replacing or repairing the same 6. to ... v in full the indebtedness secured hereby, all in companies satisfactory to the holders of the note, under insurance policies payable, in case c. loss or damage, to Trustee for the benefit of the holders of the note, such rights to be evidenced by the standard mortgage clause to be attached to ... b policy, and shall deliver all policies, including additional and renewal policies, to holders of the note, and in case of insurance about to extre, hall deliver renewal policies not less than ten days prior to the respective dates of expiration.

- 11. Trustee or the holders of the note shall have the right to inspect the premises at all reasonable times and access thereto shall by primitted for that purpose.
- 12. Trustee has no duty to examine the title, location, existence, or condition of the premises, nor shall Trustee be obligated to record this Trust Deed or to exercise any power herein given unless expressly obligated by the terms hereof, nor be liable for any acts or omission hereunder, except in case of his own gross negligence or misconduct or that of the agents or employees of Trustee, and he may require indemnities satisfactory to him before exercising any power herein given.
- 13. in which the premises are situated shall be second Successor in Trust. Any Successor in Trust hereunder shall have the identical title, powers and
authority as are herein given Trustee, and any Trustee or successor shall be entitled to reasonable compensation for all acts performed hereunder.

15. This Trust Deed and all provisions hereof, shall extend to and be binding upon Mortgagors and all persons claiming under or through Mortgagors, and the word "Mortgagors" when used herein shall include all such persons and all persons at any time liable for the payment of the indebtedness or any part thereof, whether or not such persons shall have executed the principal note, or this Trust Deed.
