- 10. No action for the enforcement of the lien of this Trust Deed or of any provision hereof shall be subject to any defense which would not be good and available to the party interposing same in an action at law upon the note hereby secured.
- 11. Trustee or the holders of the note shall have the right to inspect the premises at all reasonable times and access thereto shall be per mitted for that purpose.
- 12. Trustee has no duty to examine the title, location, existence, or condition of the premises, nor shall Trustee be obligated to re ord this Trust Deed or to exercise any power herein given unless expressly obligated by the terms hereof, nor be liable for any acts or omission, hereunder, except in case of his own gross negligence or misconduct or that of the agents or employees of Trustee, and he may require indemnities satisfactory to him before exercising any power herein given.
- 13. Trustee shall release this Trust Deed and the Jien thereof by proper instrument upon presentation of satisfactory evidence that all inshebtedness secured by this Trust Deed has been fully paid; and Trustee may execute and deliver a release hereof to and at the request of any person who shall either before or after maturity thereof, produce and exhibit to Trustee the principal note, representing that all indebtedness hereby secured has been paid, which representation Trustee may accept as true without inquiry. Where a release is requested of a successor trustee, such successor trustee may accept as the genuine note herein described any note which bears a certificate of identification purporting to be exceuted by a prior trustee hereunder or which conforms in substance with the description herein contained of the principal note and which purports to be executed by the persons herein designated as the makers thereof; and where the release is requested of the original trustee and he has never executed a certificate on any instrument identifying same as the principal note described herein, he may accept as the genuine principal note herein described any note which may be presented and which purports to be executed by the persons herein designated as makers thereof.
 - 14. Trustee may tesign by instrument in writing filed in the office of the Recorder or Registrar of Titles in which this instrument shall have

been recorded or filed. In case of the death, resignation, inability or refusal to act of Trustee,
