## THE FOLLOWING ARE THE COVENANTS, CONDITIONS AND PROVISIONS REFERRED TO ON PAGE 1 (THE REVERSE SIDE OF THIS TRUST DEED) AND WHICH FORM A PART OF THE TRUST DEED WHICH THERE BEGINS:

- 1. Mortgagors shall (1) keep said premises in good condition and repair, without waste; (2) promptly repair, restore, or rebuild any buildings or improvements now or hereafter on the premises which may become damaged or be destroyed; (3) keep said premises free from mechanics liens or liens in favor of the United States or other liens or claims for in not expressly subordinated to the lien hereof; (4) pay when due any indebtedness which may be secured by a lien or charge on the premises superior to the lien hereof, and upon request exhibit satisfactory evidence of the discharge of such prior lien to Trustee or to holders of the note; (5) complete within a reasonable time any buildings now or at any time in process of erection upon said premises; (6) comply with all requirements of law or municipal ordinances with respect to the premises and the use thereof; (7) make no material alterations in said premises except as required by law or municipal ordinance or as previously consented to in writing by the Trustee or holders of the note.
- 2. Mortgagors shall pay before any penalty attaches all general taxes, and shall pay special taxes, special assessments, water charges, sewer service charges, and other charges against the premises when due, and shall, upon written request, furnish to Trustee or to holders of the note the original or duplicate receipts therefor. To prevent default hereunder Mortgagors shall pay in full under protest, in the manner provided by statute, any "x or assessment which Mortgagors may desire to contest.

  3. Ye tgo for shall keep all buildings and improvements now or hereafter situated on said premises insured against loss or damage by fire, lightning, and indstorm under policies providing for payment by the insurance companies of moneys sufficient either to pay the cost of replacing or repairing the income of the payment of the holders of the note, under insurance policies payable; in case of loss or damage, to Trustee for the honders of the note, such rights to be evidenced by the standard mortgage clause to be attached to each policy, and shall deliver all policies, including additional and renewal policies, to holders of the note, and in case of insurance, about the respective dates of expiration.

  4. In case of default therein, Trustee or the holders of the note may, but need not, make full or partial payments of principal or interest on prior encumbrances, if any and purchase, discharge, compromise or settle any tax he nor other prior lien or title or claim thereof, or redeem from any tax sale or fortifitur, affecting said premises or contest any tax or assessment. All moneys paid for any of the purposes herein authorized and all expenses paid or incarr a for excendent therewith, including reasonable attorneys fees, and any other moneys advanced by Trustee or the holders of the note to protect the interest on some handitional indebeness secured hereby and shall become immediately due and payable without notice and with interest thereon at the rate of seven per cent per annum, Inaction of Trustee or holders of the note shall never be considered as a waiver of any rift accruing to them on account of any default hereunder on the part of Mortgagors.

  5. The Trustee or the holders of the non-hereby secured making any payment hereby authorized relating to taxes or assessments, may do
- 5. The Trustee or the holders of the not hereby secured making any payment hereby authorized relating to taxes or assessments, may do so according to any bill, statement or est mat produced from the appropriate public office without inquiry into the accuracy of such bill, statement or estimate or into the validity of any tax assessment, sale, forfeiture, tax lien or title or claim thereof.
- 6. Mortgagors shall pay each item of indebted as berein mentioned, both principal and interest, when due according to the terms hereof. At the election of the holders of the principal note and yithout notice to Mortgagors, all unpaid indebtedness secured by this Trust Deed shall, notwithstanding anything in the principal note or it this Trust Deed to the contrary, become due and payable when default shall occur in payment of principal or interest, or in case default shall occur and continue for three days in the performance of any other agreement of the Mortgagors berein contained.
- 7. When the indebtedness hereby secured shall becare in whether by the terms of the note described on page one or by acceleration or otherwise, holders of the note or Trustee shall have the right of oeel see the lien hereof and also shall have all other rights provided by the laws of Illinois for the enforcement of a mortgage debt, In any sur in the celose the lien hereof, there shall be allowed and included as additional inhebtedness in the decree for sale all expenditures and expenses who have been appeared by or on behalf of Trustee of the note for attorneys fees. Trustee's fees, appraiser's fees, outlays for documer any and expert evidence, stenographers' charges, publication costs and costs (which may be estimated as to items to be expended after entry of the decree of procuring all such abstracts of title, title searches and examinations, guarantee policies. Torrens certificates, and similar data and assur onces, with respect to title as Trustee or holders of the note may deem to be reasonably necessary either to proceute such sail to it evidence to I siders at any sale which may be had pursuant to such decree the true condition of the title to or the value of the premises. In addition, all expenditives and expenses of the nature in this paragraph mentioned shall become so much additional indebtedness secured hereby and immediately dies of all any action, said or proceeding, including but not limited to probate and bank ruptey proceedings, to which either of them shall be a pair, either as plaintiff, claiman or defendant, by reason of this Trust Deed or any indebtedness hereby secured; or (b) preparations for the commenced or a support of proceeding such which either of them shall be a pair, either as plaintiff, claiman or defendant, by reason of this Trust Deed or any indebtedness hereby secured; or (c) preparations for the forcelose whether or not actually commenced; or (c) preparations for the branch and proceeding the proceeding such might to forcelose whether or not actually commenced or (c) preparat
- 8. The proceeds of any foreclosure sale of the premises shall be distributed and applied to the following order of priority: First, on account of all costs and expenses incident to the foreclosure proceedings, including all such items as are mentioned in the preceding paragraph hereof; second, all other items which under the terms hereof constitute secured indebtedness additional to that evidenced by the note hereby secured, with interest thereon as herein provided, third, all principal and interest remaining unpaid; four the same very large to Mortgagors, their heirs, legal representatives or assigns as their rights may appear.
- 9. Upon or at any time after the filing of a complaint to foreclose this Trust Deed, the Court which such complaint is filed may appoint a receiver of said premises. Such appointment may be made either before or after sale, without notice, "tibout egard to the solvency or insolvency of Mortgagors at the time of application for such acceiver and without regard to the then value of the premises or whether the same shall be then occupied as a homestead or not and the Trustee hereunder may be appointed as such receiver. Such receive had have power to collect the rents, issues and profits of said premises during the pendency of such foreclosure suit and, in case of a sale and a being completed to the full statutory period for redemption, whether there be redemption or not, as well as during any further times when Mortgagor, except for the intervention of such receiver, would be entitled to collect such rents, issues and profits, and all other powers which may be neces, sary or are usual in such cases for the protection, possession, control, management and operation of the premises during the whole of said period. The orat from time to time may authorize the receiver to apply the net income in his hands in payment in whole or in part of: (1) The indebtedness secured hereby, or by any decree foreclosing this Trust Deed, or any tax, special assessment or other lien which may be or become superior to the 'in hereof or of such decree, provided such application is made prior to foreclosure sale: (2) the deliciency in case of a sale and deficiency.
- 10. No action for the enforcement of the lien of this Trust Deed or of any provision hereof shall be subject to any defense and have would not be good and available to the party interposing same in an action at law upon the note hereby secured.
- 11. Trustee or the holders of the note shall have the right to inspect the premises at all reasonable times and access the reto ' 12' be permitted for that purpose.
- 12. Trustee has no duty to examine the title, location, existence, or condition of the premises, nor shall Trustee be obligated 's re-ord this Trust Deed or to exercise any power herein given unless expressly obligated by the terms hereof, nor be liable for any acts or or ssion hereunder, except in case of his own gross negligence or misconduct or that of the agents or employees of Trustee, and he may require indentition satisfactory to him before exercising any power herein given.
- 13. Trustee shall release this Trust Deed and the lien thereof by proper instrument upon presentation of satisfactory evidence that all 1 is debtedness secured by this Trust Deed has been fully paid; and Trustee may execute and deliver a release hereof to and at the request of any person who shall either before or after maturity thereof, produce and exhibit to Trustee the principal note, representing that all indebtedness hereby secured has been paid, which representation Trustee may accept as true without inquiry. Where a release is requested of a successor trustee, successor trustee may accept as the genuine note herein described any note which bears a certificate of identification purporting to be executed by a prior trustee hereunder or which conforms in substance with the description herein contained of the principal note and which purports to be executed by the persons herein designated as the makers thereof; and where the release is requested of the original trustee and he has never executed a certificate on any instrument identifying same as the principal note described herein, he may accept as the genuine principal note herein described any note which may be presented and which conforms in substance with the description herein contained of the principal note and which purports to be executed by the persons herein designated as makers thereof.
- 14. Trustee may resign by instrument in writing filed in the office of the Recorder or Registrar of Titles in which this instrument shall have

been recorded or filed. In case of the death, resignation, inability or refusal to act of Trustee, R.A. Elden
shall be first Successor in Trust and in the event of his or its death, resignation, inability or refusal to act, the then Recorder of Deeds of the county
in which the premises are situated shall be second Successor in Trust. Any Successor in Trust centured shall have the identical title, powers and
authority as are herein given Trustee, and any Trustee or successor shall be entitled to reasonable compensation for all acts performed hereunder.

15. This Trust Deed and all provisions hereof, shall extend to and be binding upon Mortgagors and all persons claiming under or through Mortgagors, and the word "Mortgagors" when used herein shall include all such persons and all persons at any time liable for the payment of the indebtedness or any part thereof, whether or not such persons shall have executed the principal note, or this Trust Deed.
