1. Mortgagors shall (1) keep said premises in good condition and repair, without waste; (2) promptly repair, restore, or rebuild any buildings or improvements now or hereafter on the premises which may become damaged or be destroyed; (3) keep said premises free from mechanic's liens or liens imfavor of the United States or other liens or claims for lien not expressly subordinated to the lien hereof; (4) pay when due any indebtedness which may be secured by a lien or charge on the premises superior to the lien hereof, and upon request exhibit satisfactory evidence of the discharge of such prior lien to Trustee or to holders of the note; (5) complete within a reasonable time any building or buildings now or at any time in process of erection upon said premises; (6) comply with all requirements of law or municipal ordinances with respect to the premises and the use thereof; (7) make no material alterations in said premises except as required by law or municipal ordinance or as previously consented to in writing by the Trustee or holders of the note.

Mortgagors shall pay before any penalty attaches all general taxes, and shall pay special taxes, special assessments, water charges, sewer service charges, and other charges against the premises when due, and shall, upon written request, furnish to Trustee or to holders of the note the original or duplicate receipts therefor. To prevent default hereunder Mortgagors shall pay in full under protest, in the manner provided by statute, any tax or assessment which Mortgagors may desire to contest.

3. Mortgagors shall keep all buildings and improvements now or hereafter situated on said premises insured against loss or damage by fire, lightning and windstorm under policies providing for payment by the insurance companies of moneys sufficient either to pay the cost of replacing or repairing the same or to pay in full the indebtedness secured by the insurance companies satisfactory to the holders of the note, under insurance policies payable, in case of loss or damage, to Trustee for the benefit of the holders of the note, such rights to be evidenced by the standard mortgage clause to be attached to each policy, and shall deliver all policies, including additional and renewal policies, to holders of the note, and in case of surance about to expire, shall deliver renewal policies not less than ten days prior to the respective dates of expiration.

In case of default therein, Trustee or the holders of the note may, but need not, make any payment or perform any act hereinbefore required of Mortgagors in any form and manner deemed expedient, and may, but need not, make full or partial payments of principal or interest on prior encurbrances, if any, and purchase, discharge, compromise or settle any tax lie or other prior lien or title or claim thereof, or redeem from any tax rele or forfeiture affecting said premises or contest any tax or assessment. Such receiver shall have power to collect the rents, issues and profits of said premises during the pendency of such foreclosure suit and, is case of a sale and a deficiency, during the full statutory period for redemption, whether there be redemption or on, as well as during any further time—in Mortgagors, except for the intervention of such receiver, would be entitled to collect such rents, issues and profits, and all other powers vaich in ay be necessary or are usual in such cases for the protection, possession, control, management and operation of the premises during the will of air period. 10. No action for the enforcement of the lien of this Trust Deed or of any provision hereof shall be unject to any defense which would not be good and available to the party interposing same in an action at law upon the note hereby secured.

11. Trustee or the holders of the note shall have the right to inspect the premises at all reasonable ti nes and access thereto shall be permitted for that purpose.

12. Trustee has no duty to examine the title, location, existence, or condition of the premises, nor shall T ustee be obligated to record this Trust Deed or to exercise any power herein given unless expressly obligated by the terms hereof, nor be in the forming acts or omissions hereunder, except in case of his own gross negligence or misconduct or that of the agents or employees of Trustee, and he may require indemnities satisfactory to him before exercising any power herein given.

13. Trustee shall release this Trust Deed and the lien thereof by proper instrument upon presentation of satisfac release the release hereof to and at the causest of any person who shall either before or after maturity thereof, produce and exhibit Trustee the principal note, representing and at indebtedness hereby secured has been paid, which representation Trustee may accept as true without inquiry. Where a release is requested of su cessor trustees hereby secured has been paid, which representation Trustee may accept as true without inquiry. Where a release is requested of su cessor trustees cut successor trustee may accept as the genuine note herein described any note which bears a certificate of identification purports to be executed by a prior trustee hereunder or which conforms in substance with the description herein contained of the principal note a d which purports to be executed by the persons herein designated as the makers thereof; and where the release is requested of the original trusts a a c has giver executed a certificate on any instrument identifying same as the principal note described herein, he may accept as the genuine principal note and which purports to be executed by the persons the presented and which conforms in substance with the description herein contained of the mancipal note and which purports to be executed by the persons herein designated as makers thereof.

14. Trustee may resign by instrument in writing filed in the office of the Recorder or Registrar of Titles in which this instrument shall have

been recorded or filed. In case of the death, resignation, inability or refusal to act of Trustee, shall be first Successor in Trust and in the event of his or its death, resignation, inability or refusal to act, the then Recorder of Deeds of the county in which the premises are situated shall be second Successor in Trust. Any Successor in Trust hereunder shall have the identical title, powers and authority as are herein given Trustee, and any Trustee or successor shall be entitled to reasonable compensation for all acts performed hereunder.

15. This Trust Deed and all provisions hereof, shall extend to and be binding upon Mortgagors and all persons claiming under or through Mortgagors, and the word "Mortgagors" when used herein shall include all such persons and all persons at any time liable for the payment of the indebtedness or any part thereof, whether or not such persons shall have excluded the principal note, or this Trust Deed.
