- 1. Where a release is requested of a successor trustee, such successor trustee may accept as the genuine note herein described any note which bears a certificate of identification purporting to be executed by a prior trustee hereunder or which conforms in substance with the description herein contained of the principal note and which purports to be executed by the persons herein designated as the makers thereof; and where the release is requested of the original trustee and he has never executed a certificate on any instrument identifying same as the principal note described herein, he may accept as the genuine principal note herein described any note which may be presented and which conforms in substance with the description herein contained of the principal note and which purports to be executed by the persons herein designated as makers thereof.
- 14. Trustee may resign by instrument in writing filed in the office of the Recorder or Registrar of Titles in which this instrument shall have been recorded or filed. In case of the death, resignation, inability or refusal to act of Trustee, shall be first Successor in Trust and in the event of his or its death, resignation, inability or refusal to act, the then Recorder of Deeds of the county in which the premises are situated shall be second Successor in Trust.
