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AMENDED UNITED STATES MARSHAL'S DEED

THIS INDENTURE, made this 15th day of December, 1983, between Peter J. Wilkes, United States Marshal for the Northern District of Illinois, party of the first part and the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development, for and on behalf of the United States of America, party of the second part, WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, in pursuance of a decree entered on the 23rd of May, 1983, by the United States District Court for the Northern District of Illinois, in a certain cause then pending therein, wherein the United States of America was plaintiff, and Exchange National Bank of Chicago, as Trustee No. 27711, dated April 9, 1973, and Sidney R. Olsen, Registrar of Torrens Titles, Cook County, Illinois, were defendants, Civil No. 81 C 2437, the said Marshal duly advertised according to law the premises hereinafter described for sale at public auction to the highest and best bidder for cash at the hour of 2:00 p.m. in the afternoon on July 20, 1983, at Room 704 of the Richard J. Daley Center, in the City of Chicago, County of Cook, State of Illinois.

AND WHEREAS, at the time and place aforesaid appointed for said sale, the United States Marshal attended to make the same, and offered and exposed said premises for sale at public auction to the highest and best bidder for case, and thereupon the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development offered and bid therefor the sum of Two Million, Six Hundred Forty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$2,645,000.00); this sum being the highest and best bid offered, said Marshal accordingly struck off and sold to said plaintiff, for the said sum of money, the

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said premises and thereupon did sign, seal, and deliver the usual Marshal's Certificate of Sale to the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development, for and on behalf of the United States of America.

NOW, THEREFORE, upon consideration thereof, the said party of the first part doth hereby convey unto the said United States Department of Housing and Urban Development, for and on behalf of the United States of America, party of the second part, its successors and assigns, the said premises which are situated in the County of Cook, State of Illinois:
