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## THE FOLLOWING ARE THE COVENANTS, CONDITIONS AND PROVISIONS REFERRED TO ON PAGE 1 (THE REVERSE SIDE OF THIS TRUST DEED) AND WHICH FORM A PART OF THE TRUST DEED WHICH THERE BEGINS:

- 1. Mortgagors shall (1) keep said premises in good condition and repair, without waste; (2) promptly repair, restore, or rebuild any buildings or improvements now or hereafter on the premises which may become damaged or be destroyed; (3) keep said premises free from mechanic's liens or liens in favor of the United States or other liens or claims for lien not expressly subordinated to the lien hereof; (4) pay when due any indebtedness which may be secured by a lien or charge on the premises superior to the lien hereof, and upon request exhibit satisfactory evidence of the discharge of such prior lien to Trustee or to holders of the note; (5) complete within a reasonable time any buildings now or at any time in process of erection upon said premises; (6) comply with all requirements of law or municipal ordinances with respect to the premises and the use thereof; (7) make no material alterations in said premises except as required by law or municipal ordinance or as previously consented to in writing by the Trustee or holders of the note.
- 2. Mortgagors shall pay before any penalty attaches all general taxes, and shall pay special taxes, special assessments, water charges, sewer service charges, and other charges against the premises when due, and shall, upon written request, furnish to Trustee or to holders of the note the original or duplicate receipts therefor. To prevent default hereunder Mortgagors shall pay in full under protest, in the manner provided by statute, any tax or assessment which Mortgagors may desire to contest.
- 3. Mortgagors shall keep all buildings and improvements now or hereafter situated on said premises insured against loss or damage by fire, lightning and windstorm under policies providing for payment by the insurance companies of moneys sufficient either to pay the cost of replacing or repairing the same or to pay in full the indebtedness secured hereby, all in companies satisfactory to the holders of the note, under insurance policies payable, in case of loss or damage, to Trustee for the benefit of the holders of the note, such rights to be evidenced by the standard mortgage clause to be attached to each policy, and shall deliver all policies, including additional and renewal policies, to holders of the note, and in case of insuranc bout to expire, shall deliver renewal policies toat less than ten days prior to the respective dates of expiration.
- 4. In c sc of efault therein. Trustee or the holders of the note may, but need not, make any payment or perform any act hereinbefore required of Mortgagors in any form and manner deemed expedient, and may, but need not, make full or partial payments of principal or interest on prior encumbrance. Tany, and purchase, discharge, compromise or settle any tax lien or other prior lien or title or claim thereof, or redeem from any tax sale or fee-feiture affecting said premises or contest any tax to a sessement. All moneys paid for any of the purposes herein authorized and all expenses pair or incurred in connection therewith, including reasonable automeys paid for any of the purposes herein authorized holders of the note of principle the mortgaged premises and the lien hereof, plus reasonable compensation to Trustee for each matter concerning which action herein acute and may be taken, shall be so much additional indebtedness secured hereby and shall become immediately due and payable without notice ar with interest thereon at the rate of nine per cent per annum.   6. Mortgagors shall pay each ten of indebtedness herein mentioned, both principal and interest, when due according to the terms hereof, at the election of the holders of the pr. pal note, and without notice to Mortgagors, all unpaid indebtedness secured by this Trust Deed shall, notwithstanding anything in the principal note or in this Trust Deed to the contrary, become due and payable when default shall occur in payment of principal or interest, or in ease default shall occur and continue for three days in the performance of any other agreement of the Mortgagors herein contained.
- 7. When the indebtedness hereby secured shall become due whether by the terms of the note described on page one or by acceleration or otherwise, holders of the note or Trustee shall have the sight to foreclose the lien hereof and also shall have all other rights provided by the laws of Illinois for the enforcement of a mortgage debt. - 9. Upon or at any time after the filing of a complaint to foreclose this Trust De.d. ne Court in which such complaint is filed may appoint a receiver of said premises. Such appointment may be made either before or after sale, w. thou. notice, without regard to the solvency or insolvency of Mortgagors at the time of application for such receiver and without regard to the then al. of the premises or whether the same shall be then occupied as a homestead or not and the Trustee hereunder may be appointed as such receiver, but receiver shall have power to collect the rents, issues and profits of said premises during the pendency of such foreclosure suit and, in case the sale and a deficiency, during the full statutory period for redemption, whether there be redemption or not, as well as during any further time when Mortgagors, except for the intervention of such receiver, would be entitled to collect such rents, issues and profits, and all other powers which made on the protection, possession, control, management and operation of the premises during the whole of the period. The Court from time to time may authorize the receiver to apply the net income in his hands in payment in whole or in part of: (1) The indebtedness secured hereby, or by any deterte foreclosing this Trust Deed, or any tax, special assessment or other lien which may be or be one sperior to the lien hereof or of such decree, provided such application is made prior to foreclosure sale; (2) the deficiency in case of a sale and deficiency.
- 10. No action for the enforcement of the lien of this Trust Deed or of any provision hereof shall be subject to any defense which would not ood and available to the party interposing same in an action at law upon the note hereby secured.
- 11. Trustee or the holders of the note shall have the right to inspect the premises at all reasonable times and access thereto shall be permitted for that purpose.
- 12. Trustee has no duty to examine the title, location, existence, or condition of the premises, nor shall Truste re obligated to record this Trust Deed or to exercise any power herein given unless expressly obligated by the terms hereof, nor be liable for any acts or omissions hereunder, except in case of his own gross negligence or misconduct or that of the agents or employees of Trustee, and here may require indemnities satisfactory to him before exercising any power herein given.
- 13. Trustee shall release this Trust Deed and the lien thereof by proper instrument upon presentation of satisfactory eidence that all indebtedness secured by this Trust Deed has been fully paid; and Trustee may execute and deliver a release hereof to and at the row of of any person who shall either before or after maturity thereof, produce and exhibit to Trustee the principal note, representing the and electronic sharps secured has been paid, which representation Trustee may accept as true without inquiry. Any Successor in Trust hereunder shall have the identical title, powers and authority as are herein given Trustee, and any Trustee or successor shall be entitled to reasonable compensation for all acts performed hereunder.

15. This Trust Deed and all provisions hereof, shall extend to and be binding upon Mortgagors and all persons claiming under or through Mortgagors, and the word "Mortgagors" when used herein shall include all such persons and all persons at any time liable for the payment of the indebtedness or any part thereof, whether or not such persons shall have exceeded the principal note, or this Trust Deed.
