1. Mortgagors shall (a) promptly repair, restore or rebuild any buildings or improvements now or hereafter on the premises which may become damaged or be destroyed; (b) keep said premises in good condition and repair, without waste, and free from mechanic's or other tlens or claims for lies not not expected by subordinated to the lien hereof; (d) pay when due any indebtedness which may secured by a lien or charge on the premises superior to the lien hereof, and upon request exhibit satisfactory evidence of the discharge of such prior lien to Trustee or to holders of the note; (d) complete within a reasonable time any building or buildings now or at any time process of erection upon said premises; (e) comply with all requirements of law or municipal ordinance.
