

Sec. 6321. Lien For Taxes.

Sec. 6323. Validity and Priority Against Certain Persons.

Sec. 6325. Release Of Lien Or Discharge Of Property.

- (a) Release Of Lien: Subject to such requisitions as the Secretary may prescribe, the Secretary may issue a pertificate of release of any "an imposed with respect to any internal revenue tax if -
- (1) Liability Salisited or Unenforceable. The Tecretary finds that the hability for the amount assessed, together with all interest in respect thereof, has been fully salisfied or has become legally unenforceable, or
- (2) Bond Accepted. There is furnished to the Secretary and accepted by him a bond that is conditioned upon the payment of the amount assessed, together with all interest in respect thereof, within the time prescribed few tincluding any extension of such time), and that is in acceptance with such requirements islating to terms, condition, and form of the bond and sureties thereon, as may be a notified by such regulations.
