THIS MORTGAGE ("Security Instrument") is made this 27TH day of SEPTEMBER 19 85 between the Mortgagor, HARRIS TRUST AND SAVINGS BANK, A CORPORATION OF ILLINOIS

NOT PERSONALLY, BUT AS TRUSTEE UNDER PROVISION OF A TRUST AGREEMENT DATED AUGUST 31ST 1985 AND KNOWN AS TRUST NO. 43295 (herein "Borrower"), and the Mortgagee, Citicorp Savings of Illinois, a Federal Savings and Loan Association, a corporation organized and existing under the laws of The United States, whose address is One South Dearborn Street, Chicago, Illinois 60603 (herein "Lender").

8. Inspection. Lender of its agent shall make reasonable inspections upon and inspections of the Property. Lender shall give Borrower notice at the time of an inspection specifying the reasons for the inspection.

9. Condemnation. The proceeds of any award or claim for damages, direct or consequential, in connection with any condemnation or other taking of any part of the Property, or for conveyance in lieu of condemnation, are hereby assigned and shall be paid to Lender.

10. Borrower Not Released; Forbearance by Lender Not a Waiver. Extension of the time for payment or modification or postponement of the due date of the monthly payments referred to in paragraphs 1 and 2, or change the amount of such payments, unless Lender and Borrower otherwise agree in writing, any applications of proceeds to principal shall not extend or postpone the due date of the monthly payments referred to in paragraphs 1 and 2, or change the amount of such payments.

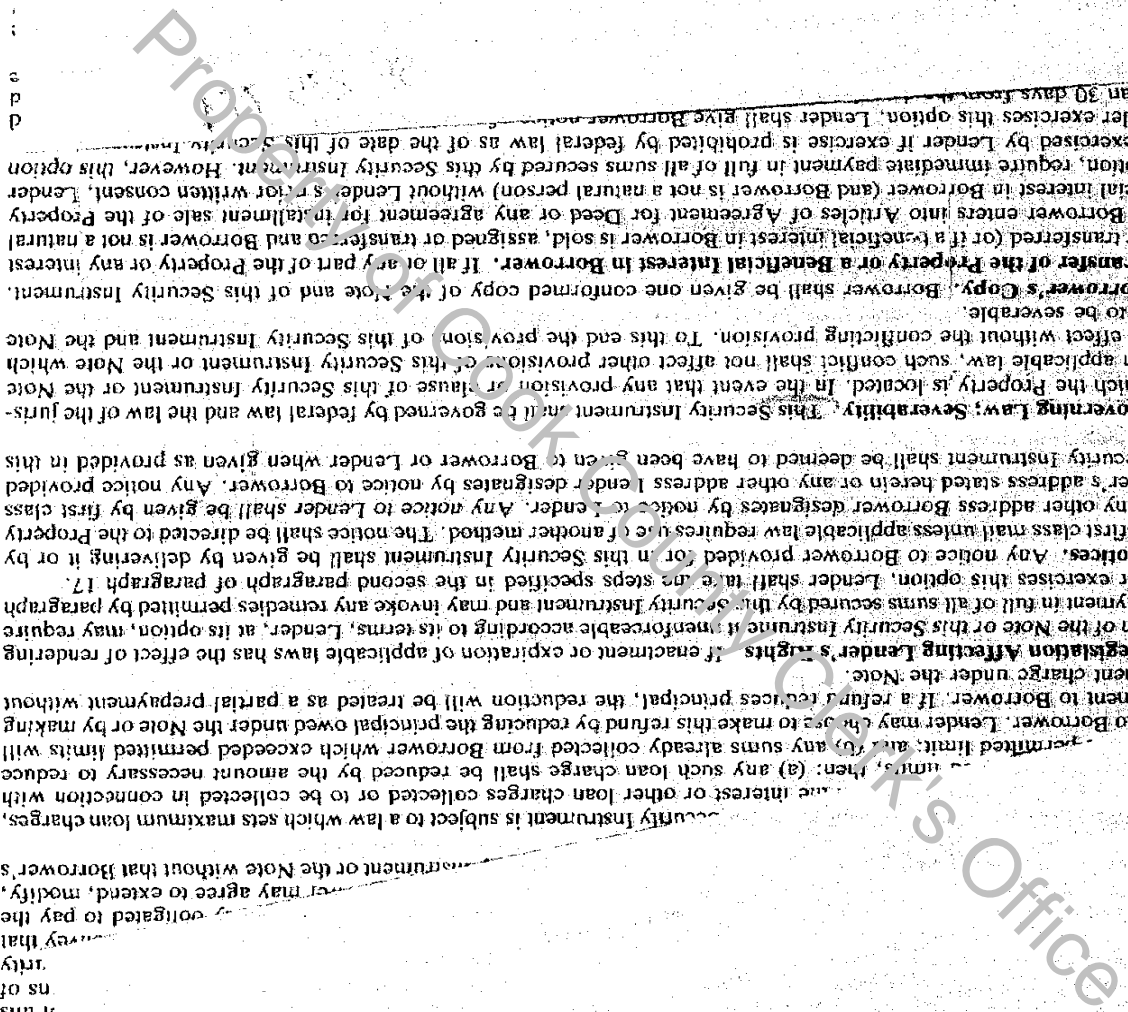
