The purposes for which the corporation are organized are:

To manufacture, handle, process, buy, sell, own, hold, pledge and deal in and with goods, wares and merchandise of all kinds and description;

To buy, sell, own, hold, mortgage, lease, operate, manage and deal in and with real estate of every kind and description;

To engage in the operation of a printing and duplicating business and to render service in the preparation, duplication, printing, mailing and delivery of all sorts and descriptions, and to do all things and render all services allied to the printing and graphic arts industry; and

To initiate, carry on and conclude any and all other lawful transactions or undertakings at any time customarily, conveniently or advantageously to be conducted in connection with the foregoing and calculated, directly or indirectly to enhance the value of or render profitable any of the corporation's properties, pursuits or rights; and to deal in investments in general.

The foregoing clauses shall be construed both as objects and powers, and the foregoing enumeration of specific powers shall not be held to limit or restrict in any manner the general powers given to corporations under the laws of the State of Illinois.

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The corporation will not discount bills or notes or buy and sell bills of exchange.

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
