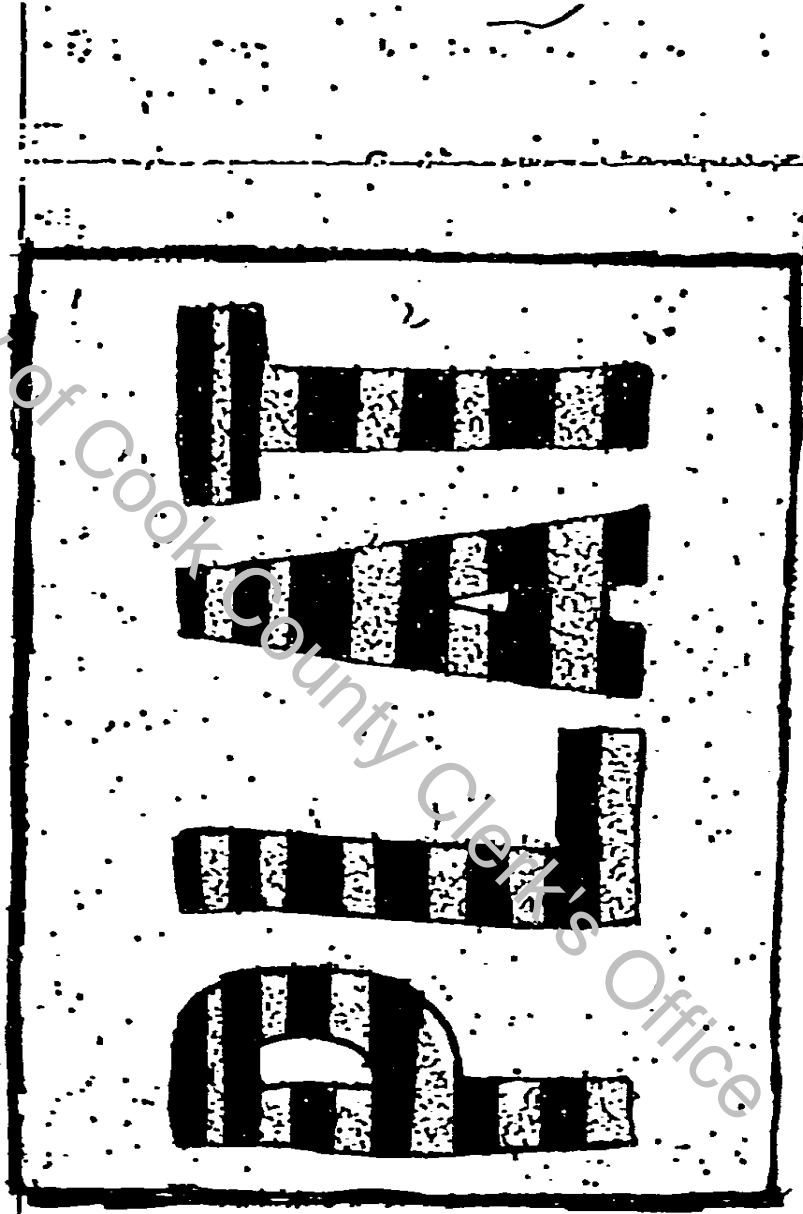

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ORDINANCE NO. 14-1965

AN ORDINANCE VACATING THE NORTH ONE-HALF OF 91ST STREET EAST OF THE WABASH RAILROAD IN THE CITY OF HOMETOWN, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that the public interest will be subserved by vacating the north one-half of 91st Street; that the relief to the public from the further burden and responsibility of maintaining said street will be equal to or greater than the benefits which shall accrue to the abutting property owners by reason of said vacation; and that the value of such relief is equal to or greater than the compensation that would be required to be paid by said abutting property owners.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of Hometown, Cook County, Illinois:

Section 1

That the public street hereinafter described as:

That part of West 91st Street (40 feet wide) as heretofore dedicated in J. E. Merrion and Company's Hometown Unit No. 1 (a subdivision of part of the Northeast Quarter of Section 3, Township 37 North, Range 13 East of the Third Principal Meridian as per plat thereof recorded October 15, 1949 as Document No. 14 651 625) lying northwesterly of the southwesterly prolongation of the southeasterly line of lot 337 in the aforesaid subdivision;

Also:

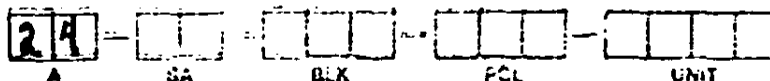
That part of the aforesaid West 91st Street lying southeasterly of the southwesterly prolongation of the northwesterly line of lot 336 in said J. E. Merrion and Company's Hometown Unit No. 1 Subdivision and lying northwesterly of the southwesterly prolongation of southeasterly line of lot 319 in the aforesaid subdivision;

Also:

That part of said West 91st Street lying southeasterly of the southwesterly prolongation of the northwesterly line of lot 318 in said J. E. Merrion and Company's Hometown Unit No. 1 Subdivision and lying West of the southerly prolongation of the east line of lot 281 in the aforesaid subdivision, all in Cook County, Illinois.

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Section 2

RESERVATION:

The City of Hometown, Illinois, reserves unto itself as a corporate municipality and to any public utility or cable TV facility, its successors or assigns, the right to install, maintain and relocate their respective facilities in, under, across and along those parts of the public street as herein vacated, with the right of free unobstructed access thereto at all times for any and all such purposes as may be reasonably required for the construction and efficient operation of said equipment.

The City of Hometown, Illinois, makes this vacation subject to "Intergovernmental Water Transmission Main Right-of-Way and Easement Agreement" entered into with the Village of Oak Lawn dated January 23, 1979, approved by Ordinance No. 2-1979, on file in the City Clerk's Office.

Section 3

That a plat of the vacated street is hereto attached.

Section 4

That this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.

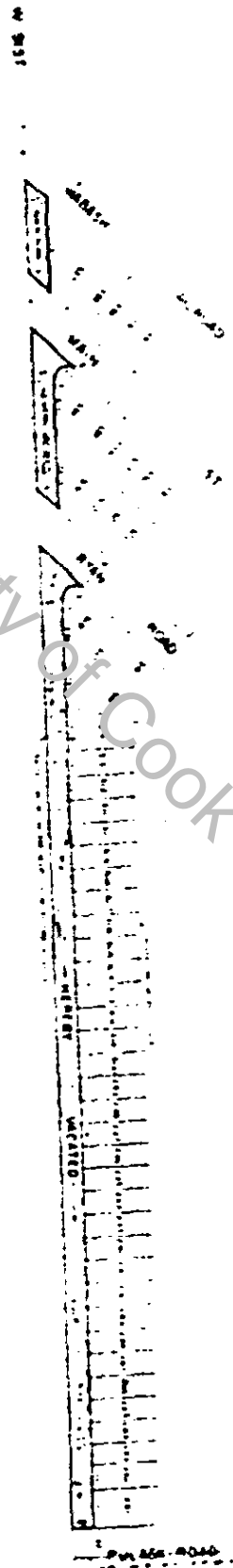
