

Sec. 6321. Lien For Taxes.

Sec. 6322. Period Of Lien.

Unless another date is specifically lixed by law, the lien imposed by section 6321/shall/arise at the time the assessment is made and shall continue until the liability for the amount so assessed (or a judgment against the taxpayer arising out of such liability) is satisfied or becomes unenforceable by reason of lapse of time.

Sec. 6323. Validity and Priority Against Certain Persons.

- (a) Purchasers, Holders D1 Security Interests, Mechanic's Lienors, And Judgment Lien Creditors.—The lien imposed by section 5321 shall not be valid as against any purchaser, holder of a security interest, mechanic's lienor, or judgment lien creditor until notice thereof which meets the requirements of subsection (f) has been filed by the Secretary.
- (b) Protection For Certain Interests Even Though Notice Filed. - Even though notice of a lien imposed by section 6321 has been filed, such lien shall not be valid-

(3) Form.—The form and content of the notice referred to in subsection (a) shall be prescribed by the Sucretary Such notice shall be valid notwithstanding any office provision of law regarding the form or content of a notice of lien.

(g) Refiling Of Notice.—For purpose of this section-

(1) General Rule .- Unless notice of fien is refilled in the manner prescribed in paragraph (2) during the required reliling period, such notice of lien shall be treated as filled on the date on which it is filled (in accordance with subsection (f)) after the expiration of such refiling period.

(a) Release Of Lien. - Subject to such regulations as the Segretary may prescribe, she Secretary shall assue a certificate by release of any lien imposed with respect to any lien imposed with respect to any liternal revenue tax not rater than 30 days after the day on

(1) Liability Satisfied or Unenforceable. - The Secretary finds that the liability for the amount assessed, together with all interest in respect thereof, has been fully satisfied or has

become legally unonforceable; or
