THIS INDENTURE, Made November 19, 1985, between American National Bank and Trust Company of Chicago, a National Banking Association, not personally but as Trustee under the provisions of a Deed or Deeds in trust duly recorded and delivered to said Company in pursuance of a Trust Agreement dated 3/28/83 and known as trust number 57421, herein referred to as "First Party," and

BREMEN BANK & TRUST COMPANY

herein referred to as TRUSTEE, witnesseth:

THAT, WHEREAS First Party has concurrently herewith executed an instalment note bearing even date here-with in the Principal Sum of One hundred three thousand & 00/100 -----

made payable to BREMEN BANK & TRUST COMPANY

and delivered, in and by which said Note the First Party promises to pay out of that portion of the trust estate subject to said Trust Agreement and hereinafter specifically described, the said principal sum and interest from

DATE HEREON on the balance of principal remaining from time to time unpaid at the rate of \*\* per cent per annum in instalments as follows: Nine Hundred fifty-three & 70/100 plus interest

Dollars on the 19th day of December 1985 and Nine hundred fifty-three & 70/100 plus interest

Dollars on the 19th day of each month thereafter until said note is fully paid except that the final payment of principal plus interest, if not sooner paid, shall be due on the 19th day of November 1994. All such payments on account of the indebtedness evidenced by said note to be first applied to interest on the unpaid principal balance and the remainder to principal; provided that the principal of each instalment unless paid when due shall bear interest at the rate of \*\* per cent per annum, and all of said principal plus interest being made payable at such banking house or trust company in Tinley Park, Illinois, as the holders of the note may, from time to time, in writing appoint, and in absence of such appointment, then at the office of

BREMEN BANK & TRUST COMPANY

in said City.


NOW, THEREFORE, First Party to secure the payment of the principal sum of money and said interest in accordance with the terms, provisions and limitations of this trust deed, and also in consideration of the sum of One Dollar in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, does by these presents grant, release, alien and convey unto the Trustee, its successors and assigns, the following described Real Estate situate, lying and being in the COUNTY OF Cook AND STATE OF ILLINOIS, to wit:

Lot 6, and the South 54 feet of Lot 7 in the Plat of Subdivision of Cohen's Jo-Lee Manor, being a subdivision of the South  $\frac{1}{2}$  of that part lying East of Vincennes Road, of the North  $\frac{1}{2}$  of the South  $\frac{1}{2}$ , of the South West  $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 18, Township 36 North, Range 14 East of the Third Principal Meridian, also that part of the South  $\frac{1}{2}$  of the South West  $\frac{1}{4}$  of Said Section 18, Township 36 North, Range 14 East of the Third Principal Meridian, lying East of the Dixie Highway, in Cook County, Illinois.

which, with the property hereinafter described, is referred to herein as the "premises."

TOGETHER with all improvements, tenements, easements, fixtures, and appurtenances thereto belonging, and all rents, issues and profits thereof for so long and during all such times as First Party, its successors or assigns may be entitled thereto (which are pledged primarily and on a parity with said real estate and not secondarily), and all apparatus, equipment or articles now or hereafter therein or thereon used to supply heat, gas, air conditioning, water, light, power, refrigeration (whether single units or centrally controlled), and ventilation, including (without restricting the foregoing), screens, window shades, storm doors and windows, floor coverings, indoor beds, awnings, stoves and water heaters. All of the foregoing are declared to be a part of said real estate whether physically attached thereto or not, and it is agreed that all similar apparatus, equipment or articles hereinafter placed in the premises by First Party or its successors or assigns shall be considered as constituting part of the real estate.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the premises unto the said Trustee, its successors and assigns, forever, for the purposes, and upon the uses and trusts herein set forth.

IT IS FURTHER UNDERSTOOD AND AGREED THAT:

L. Until the indebtedness aforesaid shall be fully paid, and in case of the failure of First Party, its successors or assigns to: (1) promptly repair, restore or rebuild any buildings or improvement now or hereafter on the premises which may become damaged or be destroyed; (2) keep said premises in good condition and repair, without waste, and free from mechanic's or other liens or claims for hire not expressly subordinated to the lien hereof; (3) pay when due any indebtedness which may be secured by a lien or charge on the premises superior to the lien hereof, and upon request exhibit satisfactory evidence of the discharge of such prior lien to Trustee or to holders of the notes; (4) complete within a reasonable time any building or buildings now or at any time in process of erection upon said premises; (5) comply with all requirements of law or municipal ordinances with respect to the premises and the use thereof; (6) refrain from making material alterations in said premises except as required by law or municipal ordinance; (7) pay before any penalty attaches all general taxes, and pay special taxes, special assessments, water charges, power service charges, and other charges under protest, in the manner provided by statute, any tax or assessment which First Party may desire to contest; (8) keep all buildings and improvements now or hereafter situated on said premises insured against loss or damage by fire, lightning or windstorm under policies providing for payment by the insurance companies of money sufficient either to pay the cost of replacing or repairing the same or to pay in full the indebtedness secured hereby, all in companies satisfactory to the holders of the note, under insurance policies payable, in case of loss or damage, to Trustee for the benefit of the
