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holders of the note, such rights to be deduced by the standard mutual clause to attach to each policy; and, to deliver all policies, including additional and renewal policies, to holders of the note, and in case of insurance about to expire, to deliver renewal policies not less than ten days prior to the respective dates of expiration; then Trustee or the holders of the note may, but need not, make any payment or perform any act heretofore set forth in any form and manner deemed expedient, and may, but need not, make full or partial payments of principal or interest on prior encumbrances, if any, and to purchase, discharge, compromise or settle any tax, lien or other prior lien or title or claim thereof, or redeem from any tax sale or forfeiture affecting said premises or interests, any tax or assessment. All monies paid for any of the purposes herein authorized and all expenses paid or incurred in connection therewith, including attorney's fees and all other monies advanced by Trustee or the holders of the note to protect the mortgaged premises and the lien hereof, plus reasonable compensation to calculate for each month occurring in which action herein authorized may be taken, shall bear interest additional indebtedness secured hereby and shall become immediately due and payable without notice and with interest thereon at the rate of eight per cent per annum. Inaction of Trustee or holders of the note shall never be considered as a waiver of any right according to them on account of any of the provisions of this paragraph.

2. The Trustee or the holders of the note hereby secured making any payment hereby, authorized relating to taxes or assessments, may do so according to any bill, statement or estimate procured from the appropriate public office without inquiry into the accuracy of such bill, statement or estimate or into the validity of any tax, assessment, sale, forfeiture, tax lien or title or claim thereof.

3. At the option of the holders of the note and without notice to First Party, its successors or assigns, all unpaid indebtedness secured by this trust deed shall, notwithstanding anything in the note or in this trust deed to the contrary, become due and payable (a) immediately in the case of default in making payment of any instalment of principal or interest on the note, or (b) in the event of the failure of First Party or its successors or assigns to do any of the things specifically set forth in paragraph one hereof and such default shall continue for three days, said option to be exercised at any time thereafter.

4. When the indebtedness hereby secured shall become due whether by acceleration or otherwise, holders of the note or Trustee shall have the right to foreclose the lien hereof. In any suit to foreclose the lien hereof, there shall be allowed and included as additional indebtedness in the decree, for sale all expenditures and expenses which may be paid or incurred by or on behalf of Trustee or holders of the note for attorneys' fees, Trustee's fees, appraiser's fees, outlays for documentary and expert evidence, stenographers' charges, publication costs and costs (which may be estimated as to items to be expended after entry of the decree) of procuring all such abstracts of title, title searches and examinations, guarantee policies, Torrens certificates and similar data and insurances with respect to title as Trustee or holders of the note may deem to be reasonably necessary either to prosecute such suit or to evidence to bidders at any sale which may be had pursuant to such decree the true condition of the title to or the value of the premises. All expenditures and expenses of the nature in this paragraph mentioned shall become so much additional indebtedness secured hereby and immediately due and payable, with interest thereon at the rate of eight per cent per annum, when paid or incurred by Trustee or holders of the note in connection with (a) any proceeding, including probate and bankruptcy proceedings, to which either of them shall be a party, either as plaintiff, claimant or defendant, by reason of this trust deed or any indebtedness hereby secured; or (b) preparations for the commencement of any suit for the foreclosure hereof after accrual of such right to foreclose whether or not actually commenced; or (c) preparations for the defense of any threatened suit or proceeding which might affect the premises or the security hereof, whether or not actually commenced.

5. The proceeds of any foreclosure sale of the premises shall be distributed and applied in the following order of priority: First, on account of all costs and expenses incident to the foreclosure proceedings, including all such items as are mentioned in the preceding paragraph hereof; second, all other items which under the terms hereof constitute secured indebtedness additional to that evidenced by the note, with interest thereon as herein provided; third, all principal and interest remaining unpaid on the note; fourth, any overplus to First Party, its legal representatives or assigns, as their rights may appear.

6. Upon, or at any time after the filing of a bill to foreclose this trust deed, the court in which such bill is filed may appoint a receiver of said premises. Such appointment may be made either before or after sale, without notice, without regard to the solvency or insolvency at the time of application for such receiver, of the person or persons, if any, liable for the payment of the indebtedness secured hereby, and without regard to the then value of the premises or whether the same shall be then occupied as a homestead or not and the Trustee hereunder may be appointed as such receiver. Such receiver shall have power to collect the rents, issues and profits of said premises during the pendency of such foreclosure suit and, in case of a sale and deficiency, during the full statutory period of redemption, whether there be redemption or not, as well as during any further times when First Party, its successors or assigns, except for the intervention of such receiver, would be entitled to collect such rents, issues and profits, and all other powers which may be necessary or are usual in such cases for the protection, possession, control, management and operation of the premises during the whole of said period. The court from time to time may authorize the receiver to apply the net income in his hands in payment in whole or in part of: (1) The indebtedness secured hereby, or by a decree foreclosing this trust deed, or any tax, special assessment or other lien which may be or become superior to the lien hereof or of such decree, provided such application is made prior to foreclosure sale; (2) the deficiency in case of a sale and deficiency.

7. Trustee or the holders of the note shall have the right to inspect the premises at all reasonable times and access thereto shall be permitted for that purpose.

8. Trustee has no duty to examine the title, location, existence, or condition of the premises, nor shall Trustee be obligated to record this trust deed or to exercise any power herein given unless expressly obligated by the terms hereof, nor be liable for any acts or omissions hereunder, except in case of its own gross negligence or misconduct or that of its agents or employees of Trustee, and it may require indemnities satisfactory to it before exercising any power herein given.

9. Trustee shall release this trust deed and the note thereof by proper instrument upon presentation of satisfactory evidence that all indebtedness secured by this trust deed has been fully paid; and Trustee may execute and deliver a release hereof to and at the request of any person who shall either before or after maturity thereof, produce and exhibit to Trustee the note reciting that all indebtedness hereby secured has been paid; which representations Trustee may accept as true without inquiry. Where a release is requested of a successor trustee, such successor trustee may accept as the genuine note herein described any note which bears a certificate of identification purporting to be executed by a prior trustee hereunder or which conforms in substance with the description herein contained of the note and which purports to be executed on behalf of First Party, and where the release is requested of the original trustee and it has never executed a certificate on any instrument identifying same as the note described herein, it may accept as the genuine note herein described any note which may be presented and which conforms in substance with the description herein contained of the note and which purports to be executed on behalf of First Party.

10. Trustee may resign by instrument in writing filed in the office of the Recorder or Register of Titles in which this instrument shall have been recorded or filed. In case of the resignation, inability or refusal to act as Trustee, the then Recorder of Deeds of the county in which the premises are situated shall be Successor in Trust hereunder and have the identical title, powers and authority as are herein given Trustee, and all acts performed hereunder.


11. That in the event title shall be conveyed to any person or persons, firm, trust or corporation, other than the undersigned or any one or more of them, then the Trustee after such transfer of title shall have the right to adjust the annual rate of interest to be paid under the terms of the Note secured hereunder. Whenever, the Bank, its successors or assigns shall increase the rate of interest in accordance with the foregoing provision, it shall give written notice specifying the new rate, and the effective date of any such increase shall be the date of such transfer or conveyance. The grant of a security interest hereby specifically excludes any security interests in furniture, appliances, kitchenware, and any other property which qualifies as "household goods" as defined in 12 C.F.R. 227.12, unless such security interests are either possessory security interests or purchase money security interests.

12. The grant of a security interest hereby specifically excludes any security interests in furniture, appliances, kitchenware, and other property which qualifies as "household goods" as defined in 12 C.F.R. 227.12, unless such security interests are either possessory security interests or purchase money security interests.
