



ORDINANCE NO. 86-7 PROVIDING FOR VACATION OF THE NORTH-SOUTH ALLEY BETWEEN 25TH AVENUE AND 26TH AVENUE AND SOUTH OF 23RD STREET

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Village of Broadview, Cook County, Illinois, has determined that it is in the best interest of the public to vacate the alley hereinafter described;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Broadview, Cook County, Illinois, pursuant to <u>Ill. Rev. Stat.</u>, Chap. 24, Sec. 11-91-1, that:

SECTION 1: All of the alley running North and South between 25th Avenue and 26th Avenue and South of 23rd Street, in the Village of Broadview, Illinois, be and is hereby vacated, according to the Plat thereof attached hereto, a further legal description being as follows:

A public alley, 20 feet in width, the Easterly line of which is coincident with the West lines of Lots 1 through 5 inclusive, Block 4 of Komarek's West 22nd Street Seventh Addition, being a subdivision of the North 1040.0 feet of the East half of the East half of the Northeast quarter of Section 28, Township 39 North, Range 12, East of the Third Principal Meridian, in Cook County, Illinois.

SECTION 2: The vacation provided for herein is made upon the express condition that within 30 days after the passage of this ordinance, the abutting landowners shall pay or cause to be paid to the Village of Broadview, plinois, the sum of \$.75 per square foot of alley which shall be vacated to them, said sum being equal to the benefits which will accrue to them by reason of this vacation.

SECTION 3: The Village retains the right to maintain, operate, repair and replace, by itself or its authorized agent, any poles, wires, pipes, conduits, sewer mains, water mains, or any other facility or equipment for the maintenance or operation of any utility now located in the alley vacated herein.

SECTION 1: All of the alley running North and South between 25th Avenue and 26th Avenue and South of 13rd Street, in the Village of Broadview, Illinois, be and is hereby vacated, according to the Plat thereof attached hereto, a further legal description being as follows:

A public alley, 20 feet in width, the Easterly line of which is coincident with the West lines of Lots 1 through 5 inclusive, Block 4 of Komarek's West 22nd Street Seventh Addition, being a subdivision of the North 1040.0 feet of the East half of the East half of the Northeast quarter of Section 28, Township 39 North, Range 12, East of the Third Principal Meridian, in Cook County, Illinois.

SECTION 2: The vacation provided for herein is made upon the express condition that within 30 days after the passage of this ordinance, the abutting landowners shall pay or cause to be paid to the Village of Broadview. Olinois, the sum of \$.75 per square foot of alley which shall be vacated to them, said sum being equal to the benefits which will accrue to them by reason of this vacation.

SECTION 3: The Village retains the right to maintain, operate, repair and replace, by itself or its authorized agent, any poles, wires, pipes, conduits, sewer mains, water mains, or any other facility or equipment for the maintenance or operation of any utility now located in the alley vacated herein.
