

Excerpts From Internal Revenue Corie

Sec. 6321. Lien For Taxes.

If any person liable to pay any tax neglects or refuses to pay the same after demand, the amount (including any interest, additional amount, addition to tax, or assessable penalty, together with any costs that may accrue in addition thereto) shall be a lies in favor of the United States upon all property and rights to preperty, whether real or personal, belonging to such person.

Sec. 6322, Period Of Lien.

Unless another date is specifically fixed by law, the lien imposed by section 822's hall arise at the time the assessment is made and shall continue until the Hability for the amount so assessed (or a judgment against the taxpayer arising out of such (lability) is satisfied or becames unenforceable by reason of lapse of time.

Sec. 6323. Validity and Priority Against Certain Persons.

(a) Purchaser's, Holders Of Security Interests, Mechanic's Lienors, And Judgment Lien Creditors. — The lien imposed by section 6321 shall not be valid as upainst any purchaser, helder of a security interest, mechanic's lienor, or judgment lien creditor until notice thereof which quests the requirements of subsection (f) has been tilled by the Secretary.

(n) Place For Filling Notice; Form.—

(1) Plate-For Filing - The notice referred to in subsection (a) shall be filed -

(A) Under State Laws

(i) Real Property - In the case of real property, in one office within the State (or the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the lien is situated; and

(ii) Personal Property in the case of personal property, whether tangible or intangible, in one office within the State (or the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the lien is situated; of

(B) With Clark Of District Court - In the office of the ctark of the United States district court for the judicial_district in which the property subject to lien is situated, wherever the State has not by law designated one office which meets the requirements of subparagraph (A), or

(C) With Recorder Of Deeds Of The District Of Colombia - In the office of the Recorder of Deeds of the District of Colombia, if the property subject to the field is situated in the flistrict of

Columbia.

(2) Since Of Property Subject To Lien - For purposes of paragraphs (1) and (4), property shall be deemed to be shualed-(A) Real Property - In the case of teal property, at its

physical location; or

(B) Personal Property - In the case of personal property, whether tangible or intangible, at the residence of the taxpayer at the time the notice of lien is filled.

Fir purposes of paragraph (?) (B), the residence of a corporation or par meritip shall be deemed to be the place at which the principal promitive effice of the business is located, and the residence if a fax ayer whose residence is without the United States shall we formed to be in the District of Columbia.

(3) Form - The form and content of the notice related to in judge stant (a) shall be prescribed by the Becretary. Such notice shall be valid notwithstanding any other provision of tall in part on the form or content of a notice of lian.

(g) Refiling Of Notice. — For purposes of this section -

(1) General Rule. — Unless notice of tien is reflect in the manner prescribed in paragraph (2) during the required refilling period, such notice or iten shall be treated as filed on the date or which it is filled (in accordance with subsection (1)) plant the expiration of such refling period.

(2) Place For Filing. — A notice of lien refiled during the required refiling period shall be effective only -

(Å) If(i) such notice of hen is reflied in the office in which the prior notice of lien was filed, and

 (ii) in the case of real property, the fact of refiling is entered and recorded in an index to the extent required by

(E) its any case in which, 90 days or more price to the date of a refiling of notice of lien under subparagraph (A). the Secretary received written information (in the maximus prescribed in regulations issued by the Secretarian concerning a change in the taxpayer's residence, if a notification of such lies is also filed in accordance with subspection (i) in the State in which such residence is located.

(3) Required Refiling Period. — in the said of any notice of lies, the term "required refiling period" meads—
(A) the one-year period ending 30 days after the expiration of 6 years after the date of the assessment of the taix, and (B) the one-year period ending with the expiration of 6 years after the close of the proceding required refiling ceriod for such notice of lies.

Sec. 6325. Release Of Lien Or Discharge Of Property.

(a) Release Of Liett. — Subject to such regulations as the Secretary may prescribe, the Secretary entities a certificate of release of any lien imposed with respect to any internal revenue tax not later than 30 days after the day on which -

(f) Elability Satisfied or Unerforceable - The Secretary finds that the Hability for the amount assessed, together with all interest in respect thereof, has been fully satisfied or tist

become legally unenforceable; or

(2) Bond Accepted. There is furnished to the Secretary and excepted by him a bond that is conditioned upon the payment of the amount assessed, together with all interest in respot Usered within the time prescribed by law (including any extention or such time), and that is in accordance with such requirements within time, conditions, and form of the bendland sureties the soon, as may be specified by such regulations.

Sec. 6103. Confidentiality and Disclosure of Returns and Return Information.

(b) Disclosure of Certain Returns and Return, Information For Tax Administration Purposes,

(2) Disclosure of amount of putstanding lien. - if a notice of lien has been filed pursuant to section 6325(f), the amount of the outstanding obligation secured by such lien may be disclosed to any person who furnishes satisfactory written evidence that has a right in the property subject to such lien or intends to obtain a right in such property.
