THIS MORTGAGE made this 5th day of December, 1986 by Casa Central Padres Corporation, (herein called "Mortgagor"), to THE FIRST NATIONAL BANK OF CHICAGO, (the "Mortgagee"), a national banking association, organized and existing under the laws of the United States of America, having its principal office at One First National Plaza, Chicago, Illinois 60670.

W I T N E S S E T H:

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is indebted to Mortgagee in the principal sum of One Hundred Forty Five Dollars (\$145,000) or so much thereof as may be disbursed and outstanding from time to time pursuant to a Rehabilitation Loan Agreement between Mortgagor and Beneficiary of Mortgagor and Mortgagee of even date herewith (herein called the "Loan Agreement") plus interest in the amount as provided in and evidenced by a promissory note (the "Note") of even date herewith for said amount and payable in accordance with the terms thereof.

WHEREAS, the Note provides for payments of principal and interest at the rate therein specified payable in accordance with the terms thereof with all unpaid principal and unpaid and accrued interest due and payable on or before 3/1/2007. The Note bears even date herewith and is payable to the order of Mortgagee at its principal office (which indebtedness, including principal and all interest hereon as set forth in the Note, is hereinafter called the "Indebtedness").

NOW, THEREFORE, KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, to secure (a) the payment of the Indebtedness, (b) the repayment of any advances or expenses of any kind incurred by Mortgagee pursuant to the provisions of or on account of the Note or this Mortgage, (c) the repayment of future advances, if any, disbursed by Mortgagee to Mortgagor in accordance with the terms of the Mortgage or in excess of the principal of the Indebtedness, (d) the performance and observance of all of the terms, covenants, provisions and agreements of this Mortgage, and the Note, the parties agree as follows:

ARTICLE I

GRANT

1.01 The Mortgagor hereby grants, bargains, sells, releases, conveys, assigns, transfers, mortgages and confirms unto the Mortgagee, and grants a security interest in, the real estate described in Exhibit A attached hereto and made a part hereof (the "real estate"), which with the property, estates and interests hereinafter described is referred to herein as the "Property."

ARTICLE III

WAIVER OF REDEMPTION

Mortgagor shall not, and will not, apply for or avail itself of any appraisement, valuation, stay, extension or exemption law, or so-called "Moratorium Laws," now existing or hereafter enacted, in order to prevent or hinder the enforcement of foreclosure of this Mortgage, but hereby waives the benefit of such laws. Mortgagor for itself and all who may claim through or under it waives any and all right to have the Property, and any estates comprising the Property, marshalled upon any foreclosure of the lien hereon and agree that any court having jurisdiction to foreclose such lien may order the Property sold as an entirety. No provision of this paragraph or of this Mortgage shall prevent Beneficiary from bidding at any foreclosure sale of the Property.

ARTICLE IV

In any such event, Mortgagee and any person designated by Mortgagee shall have, and is hereby granted, the right to enter upon the Property at any time and from time to time for the purposes of performing any such act or taking any such action, and all moneys expended by Mortgagee in connection with making such payment or performing such act (including, but not limited to, legal expenses and disbursements), together with interest thereon from the date of each such expenditure, shall be paid by Mortgagor to Mortgagee within ten (10) days after written notice to Mortgagor demanding such payment, and shall be secured by this Mortgage, and Mortgagee shall have same rights and remedies in the event of nonpayment of any such sums by Mortgagor as in the case of a default by Mortgagor in the payment of the Indebtedness. Nothing in this Paragraph or in any other part of this Mortgage shall be construed to require Mortgagee to make any payment or perform any obligation of Mortgagor or any of them. Any action taken by Mortgagee hereunder or in relation to the Property is for the sole benefit of Mortgagee and no other person shall rely upon any action, inaction, inspection or other act of Mortgagee in dealing with the Property or Mortgagor.

ARTICLE VII

ASSIGNMENT OF LEASES, RENTS AND CONTRACTS

7.01 Mortgagor hereby assigns to Mortgagee all of Mortgagor's interest in all rents, issues and profits of the Property, as further security for the payment of the Indebtedness and other sums secured hereby. Mortgagor grants to Mortgagee the right to enter the Property and to let the Property, or any part thereof, and to apply said rents, issues, profits and proceeds after payment of all charges and expenses, on account of the Indebtedness and other sums secured hereby. This assignment and grant shall continue in effect until the Indebtedness and other sums secured hereby are paid in full. Mortgagee hereby agrees not to exercise the right to enter the Property for the purpose of collecting said rents, issues or profits and Mortgagor shall be entitled to collect and receive said rents, issues, profits and proceeds until the occurrence of a default by Mortgagor under the terms and provisions hereof; provided that any rents, issues and profits collected and received by Mortgagor after the occurrence of a default hereunder which is not cured within the applicable grace period provided hereby shall be deemed collected and received by Mortgagor in trust for Mortgagee and Mortgagor shall account to Mortgagee for the full amount of such receipts. If the proceeds are insufficient to pay such Indebtedness in full, Mortgagee may declare the balance remaining unpaid immediately due and payable, and avail itself of any of the remedies provided for in the event of any default. Any proceeds remaining after application upon the Indebtedness shall be paid by Mortgagee to Mortgagor.
