

## Excerpts From Internal Revenue Crise

Sec. 6321. Lien For Taxes.

If any person liable to pay any tax neglects or refuses to , pay the same after demand, the amount (including any interest, additional amount, addition to tax, or assessable penalty, together with any costs that may accrue in addition thereto) shall be a lien in favor of the United States upon all property and rights to property, whether real or personal, belonging to such person.

Sec. 6322. Period Of Lien.

Unless another, date is apocifically fixed by law, the Hen-Imposed by section 6321 shall arise at the time the assessment is made and shall continue until the liability for the amount so assessed (or a judgment against the faxpayer arising out of such liability) is satisfied or becomes unenforceable by reason of lance of time.

Sec. 6323. Validity and Priority Against Certain Persons.

(a) Purchaser's, Holders OI Security Interests, Mechanic's Llenors, And Judgment Lien Creditors. — The lien imposed by section 6321 shalf not be valid as against any purchaser, holder of a security Interest, mechanica fienor, or judgment lies creditor until notice thereof which meats the requirements of subsection (f) has been filed by the Becretary.

## (f) Place For Filing Notice; Form.—

(1) Place For Filling . The notice referred to in subsection (a) shall be tiled -

(A) Under State Laws

(i) Real Property - in the case of real property, in one office within the State (or the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the lien is situated; and

(ii) Personal Property - In the case of personal property, whether tangible or intangible, in one office within the State (or the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State. in which the property subject to the lien is situated;

(B) With Clerk Of District Court - In the office of the clerk of the United States district court for the judicial district in which the property subject to lien is situated, whenever the State has not by law designated one office which meets the requirements of subparagraph (A), or

(C) With Recorder Of Deeds Of The District Of Columbia - In the office of the Recorder of Deeds of the District of Columbia if the property subject to the lien is situated in the District of Columbia.

(2) Situs Of Property Bubject To Lien - For purposes of paragraphs (1) and (4), property shall be deemed to be situated -

(A) Real Property - in the case of real property, at its

physical location; or

(B) Personal Property - in the case of personal property, bother rangible or intangible, at the residence of the taxy ayer at the time the notice of lien is filed.

Furnisposes of paragraph (2) (B), the residence of a corporation or par ners hip shall be deemed to be the place at which the principa: et.ecu'lye attice of the business is located, and the residence of the payer whose residence is without the United States shall be de imed to be in the District of Columbia.

(g) Refiling Of Notice. - For purposes of this section .

(1) General Rule, - Unless notice of fien is refiled in the manner prescribed in paragraph (2) during the required refiling period, such notice of tien shall be treated as filed on the date on which it is filed (in accordance with subsection (I)) after the expiration of such refiling period.

(2) Place For Filling. - A notice of then refilled during the required ratiling period shall be effective only -

(i) such notice of lien is relited in the office in which the prior notice of lien was filed, and

(ii) in the case of real property, the fact of refiling is entered and recorded in an index to the extent required by

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Secretary received written information (in the mar prescribed in regulations issued by the Secretary) concerning a change in the taxpayer's residence, if a notice of such lien is also filed in accordance with subsection (f) in the State in which such residence is located.

(3) Required Refilling Period. - in the said of any notice of lien, the term "required refsling period" means -(A) the one-year period ending 30 days after the expiration of 6 years after the date of the assessment of the tax. and (B) the one-year pariod ending with the expiration of 6 years after the close of the preceding required refiling period for such notice of lien.

6325. Release Of Lien Sec. Discharge Of Property.

(a) Release Of Lien, - Subject to such regulations as the Secretary may prescribe, the Secretary shall issue a certificate of release of any lien imposed with respect to any internal revenue tax not later than 30 days after the day on which .

(1) Liability Satisfied or Unenforceable - The Secretary tinds that the liability for the amount assessed, together with all interest in respect thereof, has been fully satisfied or has

become legally unenforceable; of

etteritain.

(2) Bond Accepted - There is furnished to the Secretary and eccepted by him a bond that is conditioned upon the payment of the amount assessed, together with all interest in respect mereof, within the time prescribed by law (including any extersion o such time), and that is in accordance with such requirements, enating to terms, conditions, and form of the word and suretics thyrobin, as may be specified by such regulations.
