If at any time the amount of the real estate taxes, assessments (general or special), water and sewer charges or insurance premiums are increased or...

5. Tax and Insurance Deposits. In order to more fully protect the security of the Mortgage and to provide security to the Mortgagee for the payment of real estate taxes, assessments (general and special), water and sewer charges, and insurance premiums...

4. Insurance. Mortgagee shall keep all buildings and improvements now or hereafter situated on said premises insured, until the indebtedness secured by this Mortgage is fully paid, or in the case of foreclosure, until the expiration of any period of redemption, against loss or damage by fire and...

3. Payment of Taxes. Mortgagee shall pay before any penalty attaches all general taxes, and shall pay special taxes, special assessments, water charges, sewer service charges, and other charges against the premises when due, and shall, upon written request, furnish to Mortgagee duplicate receipts therefor...

2. Sale or Transfer of Premises or Interest Therein. Mortgagee agrees and understands that it shall constitute an event of default under this Mortgage and the Note entitling it to remedies herein and in the Note to be exercised if (a) the Mortgagee, or any beneficiary of the Mortgage, shall convey title to, or otherwise transfer or permit any equitable or beneficial interest in the premises to become vested in any person...

1. Maintenance, Repair and Restoration of Improvements, Payment of Prior Liens, Etc. Mortgagee shall (a) promptly repair, restore or rebuild any buildings or improvements now or hereafter on the premises which may become damaged or be destroyed; (b) keep said premises in good condition and repair, without waste, and free from mechanical liens or other liens or claims for lien not expressly subordinated to the lien hereof; (c) pay when due any indebtedness which may be secured by a lien or charge on the premises superior to the lien hereof...

15. Acceleration of Indebtedness in Case of Default. If (a) default in the making of any installment due in accordance with the terms thereof of principal or interest; or (b) the Mortgagee shall file a petition in voluntary bankruptcy under the United States Bankruptcy Code or any similar law, state or federal, whether now or hereafter existing, or an answer admitting insolvency or inability to pay its debts, or fail to obtain a vacation or stay of involuntary proceedings within ten (10) days, as hereinafter provided; or (c) the Mortgagee shall be adjudicated a bankrupt, or a trustee or a receiver shall be appointed for the Mortgagor or for all of its property or the major part thereof in any involuntary proceeding, or any court shall have taken jurisdiction of the property of the Mortgagor or the major part thereof in any involuntary proceeding for the reorganization, dissolution, liquidation or winding up of the Mortgagor, and such trustee or receiver shall not be discharged or such jurisdiction relinquished or vacated or stayed on appeal or otherwise stayed within ten (10) days; or (d) the Mortgagor shall make an assignment for the benefit of creditors, or shall admit in writing its inability to pay its debts generally as they become due, or shall consent to the appointment of a receiver or trustee or liquidator of all of its property or the major part thereof; or (e) default shall be made in the due observance or performance of any other of the covenants, agreements or conditions hereinbefore or hereinafter contained, required to be kept or performed or observed by the Mortgagor and the same shall continue for three (3) days, then and in every such case the whole of said principal sum hereby secured shall, at once, at the option of the Mortgagee, become immediately due and payable, together with accrued interest thereon, without notice to Mortgagor.

16. Foreclosure; Expense of Litigation. When the indebtedness hereby secured, or any part thereof, shall become due, whether by acceleration or otherwise, Mortgagee shall have the right to foreclose the lien hereof for such indebtedness or part thereof. In any suit to foreclose the lien hereof, there shall be allowed and included as additional indebtedness in the decree for sale all expenditures and expenses which may be paid or incurred by or on behalf of Mortgagee for attorneys' fees, appraiser's fees, outlays for documentary and expert evidence, stenographers' charges, publication costs, and costs (which may be estimated as to items to be expended after entry of the decree) of procuring all such abstracts of title, title searches and examinations, title insurance policies, Torrens certificates, and similar data and assurances with respect to title as Mortgagee may deem reasonably necessary either to prosecute such suit or to evidence to bidders at any sale which may be had pursuant to such decree the true condition of the title to or the value of the premises. All expenditures and expenses of the nature in this paragraph mentioned, and such expenses and fees as may be incurred in the protection of said premises and the maintenance of the lien of this mortgage, including the fees of any attorney employed by Mortgagee in any litigation or proceeding affecting this Mortgage, the Note or said premises, including probate and bankruptcy proceedings, or in preparations for the commencement or defense of any proceeding or threatened suit or proceedings, whether or not actually commenced, shall be immediately due and payable by Mortgagor, with interest thereon at the rate applicable to the indebtedness secured by this Mortgage and the same shall be secured by this Mortgage.

17. Application of Proceeds of Foreclosure Sale. The proceeds of any foreclosure sale of the premises shall be distributed and applied in the following order of priority: First, on account of all costs and expenses incident to the foreclosure proceedings, including all such items as are mentioned in the preceding paragraph hereof; second, all other items which under the terms hereof constitute secured indebtedness additional to that evidenced by the Note, with interest thereon as herein provided; third, all principal and interest remaining unpaid on the Note; fourth, any overplus to Mortgagor, its successors or assigns, as their rights may appear.

18. Appointment of Receiver. Upon, or at any time after the filing of a complaint to foreclose this Mortgage, the court in which such complaint is filed may appoint a receiver of said premises. Such appointment may be made either before or after sale, without notice, without regard to the solvency or insolvency of Mortgagor at the time of application for such receiver and without regard to the then value of the premises or whether the same shall be then occupied as a homestead or not and the Mortgagee hereunder or any holder of the Note may be appointed as such receiver. Such receiver shall have power to collect the rents, issues and profits of said premises during the pendency of such foreclosure suit and in case of a sale and a deficiency, during the full statutory period of redemption, whether there be redemption or not, as well as during any further times when Mortgagor, except for the intervention of such receiver, would be entitled to collect such rents, issues and profits, and all other powers which may be necessary or are usual in such cases for the protection, possession, control, management and operation of the premises during the whole of said period. The court from time to time may authorize the receiver to apply the net income in his hands in payment in whole or in part of: (a) the indebtedness secured hereby, or by any decree foreclosing this Mortgage, or any tax, special assessment or other lien which may be or become superior to the lien hereof or of such decree, provided such application is made prior to foreclosure sale; (b) the deficiency in case of a sale and deficiency.

19. Assignment of Rents and Leases. To further secure the indebtedness secured hereby, Mortgagor does hereby sell, assign and transfer unto the Mortgagee all the rents, issues and profits now due and which may hereafter become due under or by virtue of any lease, whether written or verbal, or any letting of, or of any agreement for the use or occupancy of the premises or any part thereof, which may have been heretofore or may be hereafter made or agreed to or which may be made or agreed to by the Mortgagee under the powers herein granted, it being the intention hereby to establish an absolute transfer and assignment of all of such leases and agreements, and all the avails hereunder, unto the Mortgagee, and Mortgagor does hereby appoint irrevocably the Mortgagee its true and lawful attorney in its name and stead (with or without taking possession of the premises as provided in paragraph 19 hereof) to rent, lease or let all or any portion of said premises to any party or parties at such rental and upon such terms as said Mortgagee shall, in its discretion, determine, and to collect all of said avails, rents, issues and profits arising from or accruing at any time hereafter, and all now due or that may hereafter become due under each and every of the leases and agreements, written or verbal, of other tenancy existing, or which may hereafter exist on said premises, with the same rights and powers and subject to the same immunities, exoneration of liability and rights of recourse and indemnity as the Mortgagee would have upon taking possession pursuant to the provisions of paragraph 20 hereof.

The Mortgagor represents and agrees that no rent has been or will be paid by any person in possession of any portion of any portion of the above described premises for more than one installment in advance and that the payment of none of the rents to accrue for any portion of the said premises has been or will be waived, released, reduced, discounted or otherwise discharged or compromised by the Mortgagor. The Mortgagor waives any rights of set-off against any person in possession of any portion of the above described premises. If any lease provides for the abatement of rent during repair of the premises demised thereunder by reason of fire or other casualty, the Mortgagor shall furnish to the Mortgagee rent insurance, the policies to be in amount and form and written by such insurance companies as shall be satisfactory to the Mortgagee. Mortgagor agrees that it will not assign any of the rents or profits of said premises, except to a purchaser or grantee of the premises.

Nothing herein contained shall be construed as constituting the Mortgagee a mortgagee in possession in the absence of the taking of actual possession of the premises by the Mortgagee pursuant to paragraph 20 hereof. In the exercise of the power herein granted the Mortgagee no liability shall be asserted or enforced against the Mortgagee, all such liability being expressly waived and released by Mortgagor.

The Mortgagor further agrees to assign and transfer to the Mortgagee all future leases upon all or any part of the premises hereinabove described and to execute and deliver, at the request of the Mortgagee, all such further assurances and assignments in the premises as the Mortgagee shall from time to time require.

Although it is the intention of the parties that the assignment contained in this paragraph 19 shall be a present assignment, it is expressly understood and agreed, anything herein contained to the contrary notwithstanding, that the Mortgagee shall not exercise any of the rights or powers conferred upon it by this paragraph until a default shall exist hereunder.

20. Mortgagee's Right of Possession in Case of Default. In any case in which under the provisions of this Mortgage the Mortgagee has a right to institute foreclosure proceedings, whether before or after the whole principal sum secured hereby is declared to be immediately due as aforesaid, or whether before or after the institution of legal proceedings to foreclose the lien hereof or before or after sale thereunder, forthwith, upon demand of Mortgagee, Mortgagor shall surrender to Mortgagee and Mortgagee shall be entitled to take actual possession of the premises or any part thereof personally, or by its agents or attorneys, as for condition broken, and Mortgagee in its discretion may, with or without force and with or without process of law, enter upon and take and maintain possession of all or any part of said premises, together with all documents, books, records, papers and accounts of the Mortgagor or then owner of the premises relating thereto, and may exclude the Mortgagor, its agents or servants, wholly therefrom and may as attorney in fact or agent of the Mortgagor, or in its own name as Mortgagee and under the powers herein granted, hold, operate, manage and control the premises and conduct the business, if any, thereof, either personally or by its agents, and with full power to use such measures, legal or equitable, as in its discretion or in the discretion of its successors or assigns may be deemed proper or necessary to enforce the payment or security of the avails, rents, issues, and profits of the premises, including actions for the recovery of rent, actions in forcible detainer and actions in distress for rent, hereby granting full power and authority to exercise each and every of the rights, privileges and powers herein granted at any and all times hereafter, without notice to the Mortgagor, and with full power to cancel or terminate any lease or sublease for any cause or on any ground which would entitle Mortgagor to cancel the same, to elect to disaffirm any lease or sublease made subsequent to this Mortgage or subordinated to the lien hereof, to make all necessary or proper repairs, decorating, renewals, replacements, alterations, betterments and improvements to the premises as to it may seem judicious, insure and reinsure the same and all risks incidental to Mortgagee's possession, operation and management thereof and to receive all of such avails, rents, issues and profits.

The Mortgagee shall not be obligated to perform or discharge, nor does it hereby undertake to perform or discharge, any obligation, duty or liability under any leases, and the Mortgagor shall and does hereby agree to indemnify and hold the Mortgagee harmless of and from any and all liability, loss or damage which it may or might incur under said leases or under or by reason of the assignment thereof and of and from any and all claims and demands whatsoever which may be asserted against it by reason of any alleged obligations or undertakings on its part to perform or discharge any of the terms,

6. **Mortgagee's Interest in and Use of Deposits.** In the event of a default in any of the provisions contained in this mortgage or in the Note, the Mortgagee may, at its option, without being required to do so, apply any moneys at the time on deposit pursuant to paragraph 5 hereof, as any one or more of the same may be applicable, in such order and manner as the Mortgagee may elect. When the indebtedness secured hereby has been fully paid, any remaining deposits shall be paid to Mortgagee or to the then owner or owners of the mortgaged premises. Such deposits are hereby pledged as additional security for the indebtedness hereunder and shall be held in trust to be irrevocably applied by the Mortgagee for the purposes for which made hereunder and shall not be subject to the direction or control of the Mortgagee; provided, however, that the Mortgagee shall not be liable for any failure to apply to the payment of taxes, assessments, water and sewer charges and insurance premiums any amount so deposited unless Mortgagee, while not in default hereunder, shall have requested Mortgagee in writing not less than thirty (30) days prior to the date thereof to make application of such funds to the payment of the particular taxes, assessments or insurance premiums for payment of which they were deposited, accompanied by the bills for such taxes, assessments and insurance premiums.

7. **Mortgagee's Right to Act.** If Mortgagee fails to pay any claim, lien or encumbrance which shall have a prior lien to the lien of this indenture, or to pay, when due, any tax or assessment, or any insurance premium, or to keep the premises in repair, as aforesaid, or shall commit or permit waste, or if there be commenced any action or proceeding affecting the premises or the title thereto, then Mortgagee, at its option, may pay such claim, lien, encumbrance, tax, assessment or premium, with right of subrogation thereunder, may procure such abstracts or other evidence of title as it deems necessary, may make such repairs and take such steps as it deems advisable to prevent or cure such waste, and may appear in any such action or proceeding and retain counsel therein, and take such action as Mortgagee deems advisable, and for any of such purposes Mortgagee may advance such sums of money as it deems necessary. Mortgagee shall be the sole judge of the legality, validity and priority of any such claim, lien, encumbrance, tax, assessment and premium, and of the amount necessary to be paid in satisfaction thereof. Mortgagee will pay to Mortgagee, immediately and without demand, all sums of money advanced by Mortgagee pursuant to this paragraph, together with interest on each such advance at the rate set forth in the Note, and all such sums and interest thereon shall be secured hereby.

8. **Adjustment of Losses with Insurer and Application of Proceeds of Insurance.** In case of loss, the Mortgagee (or after entry of decree of foreclosure, purchaser at the sale, or the decree creditor, as the case may be) is hereby authorized either (a) to settle, collect, compromise and adjust, in its discretion any claim under such insurance policies without consent of Mortgagee, or (b) to allow Mortgagee to agree with the insurance company or companies on the amount to be paid upon the loss. In either case Mortgagee is authorized to collect and receipt for any such insurance money. Mortgagee agrees to sign, upon demand by Mortgagee, all receipts, vouchers and releases required of him by the company. If (a) Mortgagee is obligated to restore or replace the damaged or destroyed buildings or improvements under the terms of any lease or leases which are or may be prior to the lien of this Mortgagee, (b) such damage or destruction does not result in cancellation or termination of such lease, (c) the insurer do not deny liability as to the restoration of buildings and improvements on the said premises. In all other cases, such insurance proceeds may, at the option of Mortgagee, either be applied in reduction of the indebtedness secured hereby, whether due or not, or be held by the Mortgagee and used to reimburse Mortgagee for the cost of the rebuilding or restoration of buildings or improvements on said premises. The buildings and improvements shall be so restored or rebuilt as to be of at least equal value and substantially the same character as prior to such damage or destruction. In the event Mortgagee is entitled to reimbursement out of insurance proceeds, such proceeds shall be held as a variable, from time to time, upon the Mortgagee being furnished with satisfactory evidence of the estimated cost of completion thereof and with such other certificates, waivers of lien, contractors' work statements and other evidence of cost and of payments as the Mortgagee may reasonably require and approve, and if the estimated cost of the work exceeds ten percent (10%) of the original principal amount of the indebtedness secured hereby, with all plans and specifications for such rebuilding or restoration as the Mortgagee may reasonably require and approve. No payment made prior to the final completion of the work shall exceed ninety percent (90%) of the value of the work performed, the cost of completion of the work free and clear of liens.

In the case of loss after foreclosure proceedings have been instituted, the proceeds of any such insurance policy or policies, if not applied as aforesaid in rebuilding or restoring the buildings or improvements, shall be used to pay the amount due in accordance with any decree of foreclosure that may be entered in any such proceedings, and the balance, if any, shall be paid to the owner of the equity of redemption if he shall then be entitled to the same or as the court may direct. In case of the foreclosure of this mortgage, the court's decree may provide that the mortgagee's clause attached to each of said insurance policies may be cancelled and that the decree creditor may cause a new loss clause to be attached to each of said policies making the loss thereunder payable to said creditor, and any such foreclosure decree may, further provide, that in case of one or more redemptions under said decree, pursuant to the statute in such case made and provided, then and in every such case, each successive redeemer may cause the preceding loss clause attached to each insurance policy to be cancelled and a new loss clause to be attached thereto, making the loss thereunder payable to such redeemer. In the event of foreclosure sale, Mortgagee is hereby authorized, without the consent of Mortgagee, to assign any and all insurance policies to the purchaser at the sale, or to take such other steps as Mortgagee may deem advisable, to cause the interest in such purchase to be protected by any of the said insurance policies.

9. **Stamp, Transfer or Revenue Tax.** If, by the laws of the United States of America, or of any state having jurisdiction over the Mortgagee or the premises, any tax is due or becomes due in respect of the issuance of the Note or this Mortgage or the recordation thereof, the Mortgagee covenants and agrees to pay such tax in the manner required by any such law. The Mortgagee further covenants to hold harmless and agrees to indemnify the Mortgagee, its successor or assigns, against any liability incurred by reason of the imposition of any such tax.

10. **Prepayment Privilege.** At such time as the Mortgagee is not in default either under the terms of the Note or under the terms of this Mortgage, the Mortgagee shall have such privilege of making prepayments on the principal of the Note (in addition to the regular payments) as may be provided in the Note, and in accordance with the terms and conditions, if any, set forth in the Note.

11. **Effect of Extensions of Time.** If the payment of said indebtedness or any part thereof be extended or waived or if any part of the security be released, all persons now or at any time hereafter liable therefor, or interested in said premises, shall be held to a lien, to such extension, variation or release, and their liability and the lien and all provisions hereof shall continue in full force, the right of recourse against all such persons being expressly reserved by the Mortgagee, notwithstanding such extension, variation or release.

12. **Effect of Changes in Laws Regarding Taxation.** In the event of the enactment after this date of any law of the state, in which the premises are located deducting from the value of land for the purpose of taxation any lien hereon, or imposing upon the Mortgagee the payment of the whole or any part of the taxes or assessments or charges or liens hereon required in any law relating to the taxation of mortgages or the whole or any part of the debt or debts secured by mortgages or the mortgagee interest in the property, or the manner of collection of taxes, so as to affect this Mortgage or the debt secured hereby or the holder thereof, then, and in any such event, the Mortgagee, upon demand by the Mortgagee, shall pay such taxes or assessments, or reimburse the Mortgagee therefor; provided, however, that if in the opinion of counsel for the Mortgagee (a) it might be unlawful to require Mortgagee to make such payment or (b) the making of such payment might result in the imposition of interest in excess of the maximum amount permitted by law, then and in such event, the Mortgagee may elect, by notice in writing given to the Mortgagee, to declare all of the indebtedness secured hereby to be and become due and payable sixty (60) days from the date of giving of such notice.

13. **Mortgagee's Performance of Defaulted Acts.** In case of default therein, Mortgagee may, but need not, make any payment or perform any act herein required of Mortgagee in any form and manner deemed expedient by Mortgagee, and may, but need not, make full or partial payments of principal or interest on prior encumbrances, if any, and purchase, discharge, compromise or settle any tax lien or other prior lien or title or claim in the mortgage, from any tax sale or foreclosure affecting said premises or consent any tax or assessment. All moneys paid for any of the purposes herein authorized and all expenses paid or incurred in connection therewith, including attorneys' fees, and any other moneys advanced by Mortgagee to protect the mortgaged premises and the lien hereof, shall be so much additional indebtedness secured hereby, and shall become immediately due and payable without notice and with interest thereon at the rate of interest then applicable to the indebtedness secured by this Mortgage. Inaction of Mortgagee shall never be considered as a waiver of any right accruing to it on account of any default on the part of Mortgagee.

14. **Mortgagee's Release on Tax and Insurance Bills, Etc.** Mortgagee in making any payment is hereby authorized: (a) to pay any taxes, assessments and insurance premiums, according to any bill, statement or estimate procured from the appropriate public office or vendor without inquiry into the accuracy of such bill, statement or estimate or into the validity of any tax, assessment, insurance premium, sale, forfeiture, tax lien or title or claim therefor; or (b) to purchase, discharge, compromise or settle any other prior lien, without inquiry as to the validity or amount of any claim for lien which may be asserted.
