THIS INDENTURE, made December 7, 1986, between Northwest National Bank of Chicago, a national banking association, not personally but as Trustee under the provisions of a Deed or Deeds in trust duly recorded and delivered to said Bank in pursuance of a Trust Agreement dated December 11, 1986, and known as trust number 10-081680-0 herein referred to as "First Party," and Chicago Title and Trust Company, an Illinois corporation herein referred to as "TRUSTEE, witnesseth; THAT, WHEREAS First Party has concurrently herewith executed an Instalment note bearing even date herewith in the PRINCIPAL SUM OF FOUR HUNDRED FIFTY FIVE THOUSAND AND NO/100----- DOLLARS, (\$455,000.00) made payable to BEARER: NORTHWEST NATIONAL BANK OF CHICAGO and delivered, in and by which said Note the First Party promises to pay out of that portion of the trust estate subject to said Trust Agreement and hereinafter specifically described, the said principal sum and interest on the balance of principal remaining from time to time unpaid at the rate of 9.75 per cent per annum in monthly installments as follows: \$4,054.70 DOLLARS on the 15th day of February 1987 and \$4,054.70 DOLLARS on the 15th day of each month thereafter until said note is fully paid except that the final payment of principal and interest, if not sooner paid, shall be due on the 15th day of January 1992. All such payments on account of the indebtedness evidenced by said note to be first applied to interest on the unpaid principal balance and the remainder to principal; provided that the principal of each instalment unless paid when due shall bear interest at the rate of 1.75 per cent per annum, and all of said principal and interest being made payable at such banking house or trust company in Chicago, Illinois, as the holders of the note may, from time to time, in writing appoint, and in absence of such appointment, then at the office of NORTHWEST NATIONAL BANK OF CHICAGO in said City,

NOW, THEREFORE, First Party to secure the payment of the said principal sum of money and said interest in accordance with the terms, provisions and limitations of this trust deed, and also in consideration of the sum of One Dollar in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, does by these presents grant, release, alienate and convey unto the Trustee, its successors and assigns, the following described Real Estate situated, lying and being in the VILLAGE of Streamwood COUNTRY OF Cook COUNTY OF ILLINOIS, to wit:

which, with the property hereinafter described, is referred to herein as the "premises." TOGETHER with all improvements, tenements, easements, fixtures, and appurtenances thereto belonging, and all rents, issues and profits thereof for so long and during all such times as First Party, its successors or assigns may be entitled thereto (which are pledged primarily and on a parity with said real estate and not secondary), and all apparatus, equipment or articles now or hereafter therein or thereon used to supply heat, gas, air conditioning, water, light, power, refrigeration, whether single units or centrally controlled, and ventilation, including (without restricting the foregoing) screens, window shades, storm doors and windows, floor coverings, furniture, beds, awnings, stoves and water heaters. All of the foregoing are declared to be a part of said real estate, whether physically attached thereto or not, and it is agreed that all similar apparatus, equipment or articles hereafter placed in the premises by First Party or its successors or assigns shall be considered as constituting part of the real estate.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the premises unto the said Trustee, its successors and assigns, forever, for the purposes, and upon the uses and trusts herein set forth.

IT IS FURTHER UNDERSTOOD AND AGREED THAT

1. Until the indebtedness aforesaid shall be fully paid, and in case of the failure of First Party, its successors or assigns to: (i) promptly repair, restore or rebuild any buildings or improvements now or hereafter on the premises which may become damaged or be destroyed; (ii) keep said premises in good condition and repair, without waste, and free from encumbrances, other items or claims for lien not expressly subordinated to the lien hereof; (iii) pay, when due, any indebtedness which may be secured by a lien or charge on the premises superior to the lien hereof, and upon request exhibit satisfactory evidence of the discharge of such prior liens to Trustee or to holders of the note; (iv) complete within a reasonable time any building or buildings now or at any time in process of erection upon said premises; (v) comply with all requirements of law or municipal ordinances with respect to the premises and the use thereof; (vi) refrain from making material alterations in said premises except as required by law or municipal ordinance; (vii) pay before any penalty attaches all general taxes, and pay special taxes, special assessments, water charges, sewer service charges, and other charges against the premises when due, and upon written request, to furnish to Trustee or to holders of the note duplicate receipts thereof; (viii) pay in full under protest in the manner provided by statute, any tax or assessment which First Party may desire to contest; (ix) keep all buildings and improvements now or hereafter situated on said premises insured against loss or damage by fire, lightning or windstorm under policies providing for payment by the insurance companies of money sufficient either to pay the cost of replacing or repairing the same or to pay in full the indebtedness secured hereby, all in companies satisfactory to the holders of the note, under insurance policies payable, in case of loss or damage. Trustee, for the benefit of the holders of the note, such rights to be evidenced by the standard mortgage clause to be attached to the policy, and to deliver all policies including additional and renewal policies, to holders of the note, and in case of insurance, stand to opt to deliver renewal policies not less than ten days prior to the respective dates of expiration, then trustee or the holders of the note may, but need not, make any payment or perform any act hereinbefore set forth in any form and manner deemed expedient and may, but need not, make full or partial payments of principal or interest on notice, circumstances, if any, and purchase all charge, comprising or settling any such lien or other prior lien or title or claim thereto, or redeem from any tax sale or forfeiture affecting said premises, or cancel any tax or assessment. All monies held for any of the purposes herein authorized and all expenses paid or incurred in connection therewith, including attorney's fees, feed, and any other monies advanced by Trustee or the holders of the note to protect the mortgagee premises and the lien hereon, plus reasonable compensation to Trustee for each matter concerning which action herein authorized may be taken, shall be an much additional indebtedness, ascertainable, and shall become immediately due and payable without notice and with interest thereon at the rate of 10 per cent per annum. Action of Trustee or holders of the note shall never be considered as a waiver of any right accruing to them on account of any of the provisions of this paragraph.

2. The Trustee or the holders of the note hereby secured making any payment hereby authorized relating to taxes or assessments, may do so according to any bill statement or estimate procured from the appropriate public office, without inquiry into the accuracy of such bill, statement or estimate or into the validity of any tax assessment, sale, forfeiture, tax lien or title or claim thereof.

3. At the option of the holders of the note and without notice to First Party, its successors or assigns, all unpaid indebtedness secured by this trust deed shall notwithstanding anything in the note or in this trust deed to the contrary, become due and payable (i) immediately in the case of default in making payment of any instalment of principal or interest on the note, or (ii) in the event of the failure of First Party or its successors or assigns to do any of the things specifically set forth in paragraph one hereof and such default shall continue for three days, said option to be exercised at any time after the expiration of said three day period.

4. When the indebtedness hereby secured shall become due whether by acceleration or otherwise, holders of the note or Trustee shall have the right in foreclosure the lien hereof, in any suit to foreclose the lien hereof there shall be allowed and included as additional indebtedness in the decree for sale all expenditures and expenses which may be paid or incurred by or on behalf of Trustee or holders of the note for attorneys' fees, Trustee's fees, appraiser's fees, outlays for documentary and expert evidence, stenographer's charges, publication costs and costs which may be estimated as to items to be expended after entry of the decree or procuring all such abstracts of title, title searches and examinations, insurance policies, title certificates, and similar data and assurances with respect to title as trustee or holders of the note may deem to be reasonably necessary either to prosecute such suit or to defend to holders of the note which may be had pursuant to such decree, the true condition of the title to or the value of the premises. All expenditures and expenses of the nature in this paragraph mentioned shall become an much additional indebtedness secured hereby and immediately due and payable, with interest thereon at the rate of 10 per cent per annum when paid or incurred by Trustee or holders of the note in connection with (i) any proceeding, including probate and bankruptcy proceedings, to which either of them shall be a party, either plaintiff, claimant or defendant, by reason of this trust deed or any indebtedness hereby secured, or (ii) preparations for the commencement of any suit for the foreclosure hereof after accrual of such right to foreclosure whether or not actually commenced, or (iii) negotiations for the defense of any threatened suit or proceeding which might affect the premises or the security hereof, whether or not actually commenced.

5. The proceeds of any foreclosure sale of the premises shall be distributed and applied in the following order of priority: First, on account of all costs and expenses incident to the foreclosure proceedings, including all such items as are mentioned in the preceding paragraph hereof; second, all other items which under the terms hereof constitute secured indebtedness additional to that evidenced by the note with interest thereon as herein provided; third, all principal and interest remaining unpaid on the note. Fourth, any overplus to First Party, its legal representatives or assigns, as their rights may appear.

6. Upon, or at any time after the filing of a bill to foreclose this trust deed, the court in which such bill is filed may appoint a receiver of said premises. Such appointment may be made either before or after sale, without notice, without regard to the solvency or insolvency at the time of application for such receiver, of the person or persons, if any, liable for the payment of the indebtedness secured hereby, and without regard to the then value of the premises or whether the same shall be then occupied as a home or not and the Trustee hereunder may happen to be such receiver. Such receiver shall have power to collect the rents, issues and profits of said premises during the pendency of such foreclosure suit and, in case of a foreclosure, to collect the rents, issues and profits of the premises, whether there be redemption or not, as well as during any further time when First Party, its successors or assigns except for the intervention of such receiver would be entitled to collect such rents, issues and profits and all other powers which may be necessary or are usual in such cases for the protection, possession, control, management and operation of the premises during the whole of said period. The court from time to time may authorize the receiver to apply the net income in his hands in payment in whole or in part of (i) The indebtedness secured hereby, or by any decree foreclosing this trust deed, or any tax, special assessment or other lien which may be or become superior to the lien hereof or of such decree, provided such application is made within six months next after the redemption in case of a sale and deficiency.

The Mortgagor further agrees to deposit with the Northwest National Bank of Chicago on each monthly payment date an amount equal to 1/12th of the general real estate taxes for the current year and of the annual hazard insurance premiums on the real estate secured by the mortgage described above.

In the event that the Mortgagor shall convey title to or otherwise suffer or permit its equity of redemption in the property described in this mortgage to become vested in any person or persons other than the Mortgagor or a successor trustee under the Trust Agreement as Trustee of which Mortgagor has executed this mortgage, or in the event that the present owner or owners of all or any part of the beneficial interest under the hereinabove described Trust Agreement, as Trustee of which Mortgagor has executed this mortgage, shall cause or permit any conveyance of all or any part of their interest under the trust Agreement, or cause or permit said interest, to become vested in any manner or proportion different from that existing on the date of this mortgage (except when the difference in such manner or proportion results solely from a bequest or operation of law upon the death of any such owner who is an individual) then in either such event, Mortgagee is hereby authorized and empowered, at its option and without affecting the lien hereby created or the priority of said lien or any right of the Mortgagee hereunder, to declare all sums secured hereby immediately due and payable and apply toward the payment of said mortgage indebtedness any indebtedness of the Mortgagee to the Mortgagor, and said Mortgagee may also immediately proceed to foreclose this mortgage, and in any foreclosure a sale may be made of the premises en masse without offering the several parts separately. Acceptance by the Mortgagee of any mortgage payments made by any person or persons other than the Mortgagor shall not be deemed a waiver by the Mortgagee of its rights to require or enforce performance of this provision or to exercise the remedies hereunder. For the purposes of this provision, the word "person" means an individual, a corporation, a partnership, an association, a joint stock company, a trust, any unincorporated organization, or a governmental or political subdivision thereof or any one or more or combination of the foregoing. Whenever the Mortgagee shall elect to declare all sums secured hereby immediately due and payable in accordance with this provision, it shall give written notice to the Mortgagor and to the Mortgagor's successors in title not less than thirty (30) days prior to the effective date of such acceleration. Such notice shall be deemed to have been given upon the mailing thereof by registered or certified mail, postage prepaid, addressed to the last known address of the Mortgagor and of the Mortgagor's successors in title as recorded upon the books of the Mortgagee, but if no such address be so recorded then to the address of the mortgaged property.

Where the term "Mortgagee" has been used in the above paragraph, it shall be construed to mean the Holder of the Note. The First Party hereby waives any and all rights of redemption from sale under any order or decree of foreclosure of this Trust Deed, on its own behalf and on behalf of each and every person, except decree or judgment creditors of the Mortgagor, acquiring any interest in or title to the premises subsequent to the date of this Trust Deed.
