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**8. Inspection.** Lender or its agent may make reasonable entries upon and inspections of the Property. Lender shall give Borrower notice at the time of or prior to an inspection specifying reasonable cause for the inspection.

**9. Condemnation.** The proceeds of any award or claim for damages, direct or consequential, in connection with any condemnation or other taking of any part of the Property, or for conveyance in lieu of condemnation, are hereby assigned and shall be paid to Lender.

In the event of a total taking of the Property, the proceeds shall be applied to the sums secured by this Security Instrument, whether or not then due, with any excess paid to Borrower. In the event of a partial taking of the Property, unless Borrower and Lender otherwise agree in writing, the sums secured by this Security Instrument shall be reduced by the amount of the proceeds multiplied by the following fraction: (a) the total amount of the sums secured immediately before the taking, divided by (b) the fair market value of the Property immediately before the taking. Any balance shall be paid to Borrower.

If the Property is abandoned by borrower, or if, after notice by Lender to Borrower that the condemnoe offers to make an award or settle a claim for damages, Borrower fails to respond to Lender within 30 days after the date the notice is given, Lender is authorized to collect and apply the proceeds, at its option, either to restoration or repair of the Property or to the sums secured by this Security Instrument, whether or not then due.

**10. Borrower Not Released; Forbearance By Lender Not a Waiver.** Extension of the time for payment or modification of amortization of the sums secured by this Security Instrument granted by Lender to any successor in interest of Borrower shall not operate to release the liability of the original Borrower or Borrower's successors in interest. Lender shall not be required to commence proceedings against any successor in interest or refuse to extend time for payment or otherwise modify amortization of the sums secured by this Security Instrument by reason of any demand made by the original Borrower or Borrower's successors in interest. Any forbearance by Lender in exercising any right or remedy shall not be a waiver of or preclude the exercise of any right or remedy.

**11. Successors and Assigns Bound; Joint and Several Liability; Co-Signers.** The covenants and agreements of this Security Instrument shall bind and benefit the successors and assigns of Lender and Borrower, subject to the provisions of paragraph 17. Borrower's covenants and agreements shall be joint and several. Any Borrower who co-signs this Security Instrument but does not execute the Note: (a) is co-signing this Security Instrument only to mortgage, grant and convey that Borrower's interest in the Property under the terms of this Security Instrument, (b) is not personally obligated to pay the sums secured by this Security Instrument; and (c) agrees that Lender and any other Borrower may agree to extend, modify, forgive or make any accommodation with regard to the terms of this Security Instrument or the Note without that Borrower's consent.

**12. Loan Charge.** If the loan secured by this Security Instrument is subject to a law which sets maximum loan charges, and that law is finally interpreted so that the interest or other loan charges collected or to be collected in connection with the loan exceed the permitted limits, then: (a) any such loan charge shall be reduced by the amount necessary to reduce the charge to the permitted limit; and (b) any sums already collected from Borrower which exceeded permitted limits will be refunded to Borrower. Lender may choose to make this refund by reducing the principal owed under the Note or by making a direct payment to Borrower. If a refund reduces principal, the reduction will be treated as a partial prepayment without any prepayment charge under the Note.

**13. Legislation Affecting Lender's Rights.** If enactment or expiration of applicable laws has the effect of rendering any provision of the Note or this Security Instrument unenforceable according to its terms, Lender, at its option, may require immediate payment in full of all sums secured by this Security Instrument and may invoke any remedies permitted by paragraph 19. If Lender exercises this option, Lender shall take the steps specified in the second paragraph of paragraph 17.

**14. Notices.** Any notice to Borrower provided for in this Security Instrument shall be given by delivering it or by mailing it by first class mail unless applicable law requires use of another method. The notice shall be directed to the Property Address or any other address Borrower designates by notice to Lender. Any notice to Lender shall be given by first class mail to Lender's address stated herein or at any other address Lender designates by notice to Borrower. Any notice provided for in this Security Instrument shall be deemed to have been given to Borrower or Lender when given as provided in this paragraph.

**15. Governing Law; Severability.** This Security Instrument shall be governed by federal law and the law of the jurisdiction in which the Property is located. In the event that any provision or clause of this Security Instrument or the Note conflicts with applicable law, such conflict shall not affect other provisions of this Security Instrument or the Note which can be given effect without the conflicting provision. To this end the provisions of this Security Instrument and the Note are declared to be severable.

**16. Borrower's Copy.** Borrower shall be given one conformed copy of the Note and of this Security Instrument.

**17. Transfer of the Property or a Beneficial Interest in Borrower.** If all or any part of the Property or any interest in it is sold or transferred (or if a beneficial interest in Borrower is sold or transferred and Borrower is not a natural person) without Lender's prior written consent, Lender may, at its option, require immediate payment in full of all sums secured by this Security Instrument. However, this option shall not be exercised by Lender if its exercise is prohibited by federal law as of the date of this Security Instrument.

The notice shall provide a period of not less than 30 days from the date the notice is delivered or mailed within which Borrower must pay all sums secured by this Security Instrument. **18. Borrower's Right to Reinstate.** If Borrower meets certain conditions, Borrower shall have the right to have enforcement of this Security Instrument discontinued at any time prior to the earlier of: (a) 5 days (or such other period as applicable law may specify for reinstatement) before sale of the Property pursuant to any power of sale contained in this Security Instrument; or (b) entry of a judgment enforcing this Security Instrument. Those conditions are that Borrower: (a) pays Lender all sums which then would be due under this Security Instrument and the Note had no acceleration occurred; (b) cures any default of any other covenants or agreements; (c) pays all expenses incurred in enforcing this Security Instrument, including, but not limited to, reasonable attorneys' fees; and (d) takes such action as Lender may reasonably require to assure that the lien of this Security Instrument, Lender's rights in the Property and Borrower's obligation to pay the sums secured by this Security Instrument shall continue unchanged. Upon reinstatement by Borrower, this Security Instrument and the obligations secured hereby shall remain fully effective as if no acceleration had occurred. **NOTICE TO BORROWER: THE SECURITY INSTRUMENT SECURES A NOTE WHICH CONTAINS PROVISIONS ALLOWING FOR CHANGES IN THE INTEREST RATE AND MONTHLY PAYMENTS. THE BORROWER'S MONTHLY PAYMENTS ARE IN FIXED AMOUNTS DURING THE FIRST YEAR OF THE NOTE. THE REMAINING MONTHLY PAYMENTS COULD INCREASE OR DECREASE, DEPENDING ON CHANGES IN THE INTEREST RATE.**

**Modifications.** In addition to the covenants and agreements made in the Security Instrument, Borrower and Lender further covenant and agree as follows:

### INTEREST RATE AND MONTHLY PAYMENT CHANGES

The Note has an Initial Interest Rate of 10.875%. Beginning on the date of the Note, the Borrower will pay interest at the Initial Interest Rate until the first Change Date. The Note interest rate may be changed on the 1st day of the month beginning on FEBRUARY 1, 1987 and on that day of the month every 12 months thereafter. Each date on which the rate of interest may change is called a Change Date.

Changes in the interest rate are governed by changes in an interest rate index called the "Index". The Index is the Federal Home Loan Bank Board Monthly National Median Annualized Cost of Funds for FSLIC-insured savings and loan associations.

To set the new interest rate, before each interest Change Date, the Note Holder will first add **TWO AND THREE QUARTERS PERCENT (2.75%)** to the Current Index. The Current Index is the most recent index figure available 45 days prior to each Change Date. The Note Holder will then round the result of this addition to the nearest one-eighth of one percentage point (0.125%). This rounded amount will be the new rate of interest until the next interest Change Date provided that on any Change Date the new rate of interest will not be increased or decreased by more than two percentage points (2.00%). At no time during the term of the Note shall the interest rate be less than **14.50%** per annum nor more than **18.50%** per annum.

The first twelve monthly payments due under the Note will each be in the amount of \$517.65. Beginning with the 13th payment, the amount of the monthly payments will be determined in accordance with the terms of the Note and will always be sufficient to repay the unpaid principal balance in full in substantially equal payments by the final payment date.

THIS ADDENDUM TO ADJUSTABLE RATE LOAN RIDER is incorporated into and shall be deemed to amend and supplement the Adjustable Rate Loan Rider (the "Rider") to the Mortgage, Deed of Trust or Security Deed (the "Security Instrument"), each dated the same date as this Addendum and given by the undersigned (the "Borrower") to secure Borrower's Adjustable Rate Note with Addendum To Adjustable Rate Note to ST. PAUL FEDERAL BANK FOR SAVINGS, (the "Lender") and dated the same date as this Addendum (the "Note"), covering the property described in the Security Instrument and located at:

ADDITIONAL COVENANTS. In addition to the covenants and agreements made in the Security Instrument and the Rider, Borrower and Lender further covenant and agree as follows:

### A. FIXED INTEREST RATE OPTION

The Note provides for the Borrower's option to convert from an adjustable interest rate to a fixed interest rate, as follows:

#### 1. Option to Convert to Fixed Rate

I have a Conversion Option which I can exercise unless I am in default or this Section A1 or Section A3 below will not permit me to do so. The "Conversion Option" is my option to convert the interest rate I am required to pay by the Note from an adjustable rate to a fixed rate.

The conversion can only take place on the third, fourth or fifth Change Date. Each Change Date on which my interest rate can convert from an adjustable rate to a fixed rate also is called a "Conversion Date." I can convert my interest rate only on one of these three Conversion Dates.

If I want to exercise the Conversion Option, I must first meet certain conditions. Those conditions are that: (a) I must give the Note Holder notice that I am doing so at least 15 days before the next Conversion Date; (b) on the Conversion Date, I am not in default under the Note or the Security Instrument; (c) by the Conversion Date, I must pay the Note Holder a conversion fee equal to one percent (1.0%) of the unpaid principal I am expected to owe on that Conversion Date plus U.S. \$250.00; (d) by the Conversion Date, if an appraisal report is required by Section A3 below, the Note Holder has received the report and I have paid the appraisal fee and any amount necessary to reduce unpaid principal; and (e) I must sign and give the Note Holder any documents the Note Holder requires to effect the conversion.

#### 2. Calculation of Fixed Rate

My new, fixed interest rate will be equal to the Federal National Mortgage Association's required net yield for 30-year, fixed rate mortgages covered by 30-day mandatory delivery commitments in effect as of the date 15 days before the Conversion Date, plus five-eighths of one percent (.625%). If this required net yield is not available, the Note Holder will determine my interest rate by using a comparable figure.

#### 3. Reduction of Principal Balance Before Conversion; Appraisal

If the unpaid principal I am expected to owe on the Conversion Date will be greater than the original principal amount of my loan, the Note Holder may require an appraisal report on the value of the property described in the Security Instrument. The appraisal report must be prepared by a qualified appraiser chosen by the Note Holder. I will pay the Note Holder a reasonable fee for this appraisal report.

The unpaid principal I am expected to owe on the Conversion Date could be an amount greater than 95% of the appraisal report's stated value of the property securing my loan. If so, I cannot exercise the Conversion Option unless I pay the Note Holder an amount sufficient to reduce my unpaid principal to an amount equal to 95% of the stated value of the property.

#### 4. Determination of New Payment Amount

If I choose to exercise the Conversion Option, the Note Holder will determine the amount of the monthly payment that would be sufficient to repay the unpaid principal I am expected to owe on the Conversion Date in full by the final payment date at my new fixed interest rate in substantially equal payments. The result of this calculation will be the new amount of my monthly payment. Beginning with my first monthly payment after the Conversion Date, I will pay the new amount as my monthly payment until the final payment date.

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## B. ASSUMPTION OPTION

The provisions of Uniform Covenant 17 of the Security Instrument provides as follows:

**Transfer of the Property or a Beneficial Interest in Borrower.** If all or any part of the Property or any interest in it is sold or transferred (or if a beneficial interest in Borrower is sold or transferred and Borrower is not a natural person) without Lender's prior written consent, Lender may, at its option, require immediate payment in full of all sums secured by this Security Instrument. However, this option shall not be exercised by Lender if exercise is prohibited by federal law as of the date of this Security Instrument.

If Lender exercises this option, Lender shall give Borrower notice of acceleration. The notice shall provide a period of not less than 30 days from the date the notice is delivered or mailed within which Borrower must pay all sums secured by this Security Instrument. If Borrower fails to pay these sums prior to the expiration of this period, Lender may invoke any remedies permitted by this Security Instrument without further notice or demand on Borrower.

Notwithstanding the provisions of Uniform Covenant 17 of the Security Instrument, Lender shall waive such option to accelerate and shall release Borrower from all obligations under the Security Instrument and the Note provided that, prior to the sale or transfer, (a) Borrower is not in default of the terms and conditions of the Security Instrument and the Note, (b) the credit of the person to whom the Property is to be sold or transferred is satisfactory to Lender, (c) Lender is paid Lender's then applicable assumption fee, (d) the person to whom the property is to be sold or transferred executes an assumption agreement acceptable to Lender wherein such person agrees to assume all of the Borrower's obligations under the Security Instrument and the Note.

BY SIGNING BELOW, Borrower accepts and agrees to the terms and covenants contained in this Addendum To Adjustable Rate Loan Note.

## CONDOMINIUM RIDER

THIS CONDOMINIUM RIDER is incorporated into and shall be deemed to amend and supplement a Mortgage, Deed of Trust or Deed to Secure Debt (herein "security instrument") dated of even date herewith, given by the undersigned (herein "Borrower") to secure Borrower's Note to ST. PAUL FEDERAL BANK FOR SAVINGS (herein "Lender") and covering the Property described in the security instrument and located at:

497 KIOWA TRAIL, WHEELING, IL 60090

(PROPERTY ADDRESS)

The Property comprises a unit in, together with an undivided interest in the common elements of, a condominium project known as TAHOE VILLAGE (Name of Condominium Project).

CONDOMINIUM ASSESSMENTS. In addition to the covenants and agreements made in the security instrument, Borrower and Lender further covenant and agree as follows:

A. Assessments. Borrower shall promptly pay, when due, all assessments imposed by the Owners Association or other governing body of the Condominium Project (herein "Owners Association") pursuant to the provisions of the declaration, by-laws, code of regulations or other constituent document of the Condominium Project.

B. Hazard Insurance. So long as the Owners Association maintains a "master" or "blanket" policy on the Condominium Project which provides insurance coverage against fire, hazards included within the term "extended coverage," and such other hazards as Lender may require, and in such amounts and for such periods as Lender may require, then:

(i) Lender waives the provision in Uniform Covenant 2 for the monthly payment to Lender of one-twelfth of the premium it charges for hazard insurance on the Property;

(ii) Borrower's obligation under Uniform Covenant 5 to maintain hazard insurance coverage on the Property is deemed satisfied; and

(iii) the provisions in Uniform Covenant 5 regarding application of hazard insurance proceeds shall be superseded by any provisions of the declaration, by-laws, code of regulations or other constituent document of the Condominium Project or of applicable law to the extent necessary to avoid a conflict between such provisions and the provisions of Uniform Covenant 5. For any period of time during which such hazard insurance coverage is not maintained, the immediately preceding sentence shall be deemed to have no force or effect. Borrower shall give Lender prompt notice of any lapse in such hazard insurance coverage.

In the event of a distribution of hazard insurance proceeds in lieu of restoration or repair following a loss to the Property, whether to the unit or to common elements, any such proceeds payable to Borrower are hereby assigned and shall be paid to Lender for application to the sums secured by the security instrument, with the excess, if any, paid to Borrower.

C. Lender's Prior Consent. Borrower shall not, except after notice to Lender and with Lender's prior written consent, partition or subdivide the Property or consent to:



(i) the abandonment or termination of the Condominium Project, except for abandonment or termination provided by law in the case of substantial destruction by fire or other casualty or in the case of a taking by condemnation or eminent domain;

(ii) any material amendment to the declaration, by-laws or code of regulations of the Owners Association, or equivalent constituent document of the Condominium Project, including, but not limited to, any amendment which would change the percentage interests of the unit owners in the Condominium Project, or

(iii) the effectuation of any decision by Owners Association to terminate professional management and assume self-management of the Condominium Project.

D. Remedies. If Borrower breaches Borrower's covenants and agreements hereunder, including the covenant to pay when due condominium assessments, then Lender may invoke any remedies provided under the security instrument, including, but not limited to, those provided under Uniform Covenant 7.
