JUDGMENT FOR DISSOLUTION OF MARRIAGE

THIS MATTER having come on for hearing on the Stipulation of the parties that the matter be heard on the Petition for Dissolution of Marriage as in cases of default, both the Respondent and Respondent's attorney being present in open Court, the Court having heard the evidence adduced and a Report of Proceedings having been prepared and made a part hereo, a Certification of which is filed herein, and the Court now being fully informed:

- 1. That the Court has jurisdiction of the subject matter and the parties hereto.
- 2. That the parties are now and for more than 90 days continuously and immediately preceding the filing of Petitioner's Petition for Dissolution of Marriage, have been actual residents of Cook County and domiciled in the State of Illinois.
- The Petitioner is thirty-seven (37) years of age, and presently resides at 111 Boardwalk, Elk Grove Village, Illinois, and is presently employed as a school teacher in Addison School District #4.

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- 4. The Respondent is forty-one (41) years of age, and presently resides at 637 S. Warren, Palatine, Illinois, and is presently employed as an electrician at Edward Electric Co., in Hillside, Illinois.
- 5. That the parties were lawfully married on July 26, 1980, and that said marriage was registered in Cook County, Illinois.
- 6. That one child was born to the parties as a result of their marriage, namely: Anthony Joseph Abbate, having been born on July 10, 1981. No children were adopted by the parties and the Petitioner acknowledges that she is not now pregnant.
- 7. That the Patitioner has established by competent and relevant proof that the Respondent, JOSEPH ABBATE, was guilty of extreme and repeated acts of mental cruelty toward the Petitioner as alleged and charged in her Patition for Dissolution of Marriage without cause or provocation on the part of the Petitioner.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED by the Court that the Petitioner, LAUREL BETH ABBATE, and the Respondent, JOSEPH ABBATE, are hereby granted a Judgment for Dissolution of Marriage, and the bonds of matrimony heretofore existing between them are hereby dissolved.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED by the Court that the parties having entered into an oral property settlement agreement on June 12, 1985, in open Court, and verified by the REPORT OF PROCEEDINGS herein, THE COURT FURTHER FINDS AS FOLLOWS:

THE RESERVE TO THE PROPERTY OF THE CUSTODY WELL

Petitioner shall have the sole care, custody, control and education of the minor child.

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Respondent shall have the right to reasonable visitation including visitation away from Petitioner's home on alternate weekends from Saturday noon through Sunday evening at 7:00 p.m.

Major holidays will be shared and alternated; child will spend Father's Day and father's birthday with the Respondent.

Respondent will have the right to a two week summer vacation with the minor child as long as Respondent gives Petitioner a 60-day price notice concerning a definite schedule and itinerary.

CHILD SUPPORT

Respondent shall pay Petitioner the sum of Three Hundred Ninety-Six Dollars (\$396.00) per month (based on Respondent's \$2,200 net monthly salary), as and for child support, nunc pro-tune June 12, 1985. Respondent shall pay child support through Circuit Court of Cook County.

Petitioner shall claim their minor child as an exemption for federal and state income tax purposes.

MARITAL RESIDENCE

Petitioner agrees to quit claim to Respondent all of her right, title, and interest in and to the marital home located at 637 Warren Street, Palatine, Illinois.

Respondent shall pay Petitioner the sum of Eleven Thousand Five

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Hundred Dollars (\$11,500), numer pre-tune June 12, 1985, in consideration

of Petitioner's interest in said home.

LIFE INSURANCE

Respondent shall obtain life insurance, insuring himself, naming the minor child as beneficiary, in the minimum amount of Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000).

VIBITATION

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MAJOR MEDICAL INSURANCE FOR THE MINOR

Respondent shall provide major medical insurance coverage for the minor child, and give the Petitioner a copy of said policy and cooperate with Petitioner whenever necessary in providing claim forms and other needed documentation.

Petitioner shall be responsible for ordinary medical care of the minor child not to exceed Three Hundred Dollars (\$300) per year. Ordinary medical care in excess of Three Hundred Dollars (\$300) per year shall be paid by Respondent.

MAINTENANCE

Petitioner and Respondent hereby waive any and all rights to receive maintenance from eachother, past present or future.

PERSONAL PROPERTY

Petitioner and Respondent have divided all personal property by agreement to each other's satisfaction.

DEBTS

Petitioner and Respondent have divided all marital debts by agreement to each other's satisfaction.

ATTORNEY'S FEES

Petitioner and Respondent shall be responsible for his or her own attorney's fees.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED by the Court that Petitioner, LAUREL BETH ABBATE, and Respondent, JOSEPH A. ABBATE, are hereby ordered and directed to make, execute and deliver any and all documents necessary to carry

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out the provisions of this Judgment for Dissolution of Marriage and to make the payments as herein required.

The Court hereby retains jurisdiction of this cause for the purpose of carrying into effect the provisions of this Judgment for Dissolution of Marriage.
