All insurance shall be carried in companies approved by the Mortgages and the policies and renewals thereof shall be held by the Mortgagee and have attached thereto loss payable clauses in favor of and in form acceptable to the Mortgagee. #### RIDER TO STATE OF ILLINOIS MORTGAGE HUD-92116M (5-80)

This rider attached to and made part of the Mortgage between MARK J. BLOUGH AND LYDIA M. BLOUGH, HIS WIFE

MORTGAGOR, AND, JAMES F. MESSINGER & CO., INC.

MORTGAGEE, DATED MARCH 6, 1986 revises said Mortgage as follows:

1. Page 2, the second covenant of the Mortgagor is amanded to read:

That, together with, and in addition to, the monthly payments of principal and interest payable under the terms of the note secured hereby, the Mortgagor will pay to the Mortgagee, on the first day of each month until the said note is fully paid, the following sums:

- (a) A sum equal to the ground rents, if any, next due, plus the premiums that will next become due and payable on policies of fire and other hazard insurance covering the mortgaged property, plus taxes and assessments next due on the mortgaged property (all as estimated by the Mortgagee) less all sums already paid therefor divided by the number of months to elapse before one month prior to the date when such ground rents, premiums, taxes and assessments will occome delinquent, such sums to be held by Mortgagee in trust to pay said ground rents, premiums, taxes and special assessments; and
- (b) All payments mencioned in the two preceding subsections of this paragraph and all payments to be made under the note secured hereby shall be added cogether and the aggregate amount thereof shall be paid by the Northyagor each month in a single payment to be applied by the Mortgage to the following items in the order set forth:
  - (I) ground rents, if any, taxes, special assessments, fire, and other hazard unwance premiums;
  - (II) interest on the note secured hereby; and (III) amortization of principal of the said note.

Any deficiency in the amount of any such aggregate monthly payment shall, unless made good by the Mortgagor prior to the due date of the next such payment, constitute an event of default under this mortgage. The Mortgagee may collect a "late charge" not to exceed four cents (4¢) for each dollar (\$1) for each payment more than fifteen (15) days in arrears, to cover the extra appease involved

in handling delinquent payments.

If the total of the payments made by the Mortgagor under subsection (a) of the preceding paragraph shall exceed the amount of the payments /ctually made by the Mortgagee for ground rents, taxes, and assessments, or incurance premiums, as the case may be, such excess, if the loan is current, at the option of the Mortgagor, shall be credited on subsequent payments to be made by the Mortgagor under subsection. If, however, the monthly payments made by the Mortgagor under subsection (a) of the preceding paragraph shall not be sufficient to pay ground rents, taxes, and assessments, or insurance premiums, as the case may be, when the same shall become due and payable, then the Mortgagor shall pay to the Mortgagee any amount necessary to make up the deficiency, on or before the date when payment of such ground rents, taxes, assessments, or insurance premiums shall be due. If at any time the Mortgagor shall tender to the Mortgagee, in accordance with the provisions of the note secured hereby, full payment of the entire indebtedness represented thereby, the Mortgagee shall, in computing the amount of such indebtedness, credit to the account of the Mortgagor any balance remaining in the funds accumulated under the provisions of subsection (a) of the preceding paragraph. If there shall be a default under any of the provisions of this mortgage resulting in a public sale of the premises covered hereby, or if the Mortgagee acquires the property otherwise after default, the Mortgagee

This option may not be exercised by the Mortgages when the ineligibility for insurance under the National Housing Act is due to the Mortgages's failure to remit the mortgage insurance premium to the Department of Housing and Urban Development.
