ORDER

THIS CAUSE coming to be heard for final accounting of the receiver, for hearing of the receivership certificate, and for status, the plaintiff, defendant and the City of Chica to having appeared through counsel and the receiver having appear xl pro se and being OUNTY C/G advised in the premises,

The Court finds:

- 1. That Peoples Housing, the managing agent of the Receiver, has submitted to the Receiver a management fee of 10% of one gross income of the building from December 1, 1985 through February 27, 1986, in an amount in excess of \$600, but is willing to accept the remaining cash assets in the Receiver's account as its fee in full, that being \$294.57.
- 2. That, as of February 27, 1986, the date the Receiver was discharged, the income from rents from the building covered all expenses, with the exception of an invoice for \$1,644.12 from Fix-n-Clean, a company hired by the Receiver's managing agent to provide maintenance and repair services. These services include

code-related items such as light fixture repairs, relocation of smoke detectors to code approved areas and minor plumbing repairs.

- 3. That the Department of Housing of the City of Chicago, through the Housing Abandonment Prevention Program, is willing to expend funds to cover the entire \$1,644.12, if this Court so orders the payment of these expenses.
- 4. That the Department of Housing of the City of Chicago, through the Housing Abandonment Prevention Program, agrees to accept the assignment of a receivership certificate in the amount of \$1,644.12, to be added to the amount in Receiver's Petition of February 27, 1986 of \$20,394.13 to total \$22,038.25.
 - 5. That the final accounting was submitted by the Receiver,
- 6. That water, gas and electric bills are now in the name of Kevin Allen, the owner of the premases.

NOW IT IS HEREBY ORDERED;

- NOW IT IS HEREBY ORDERED;

 A. that the final accounting of the Receiver be approved as submitted.
- B. that the management fee to Peoples Housing of \$294.57 be approved and paid from the income of the building during the receivership.
 - C. that the amount to Fix-n-Clean of \$1644.12 be approved.
- D. that William Hennessy, the Court's Receiver, be authorized to issue and transfer to the City of Chicago, a Receiver's Certificate
