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Excerpts From Internal Revenue Crue

Sec. 6321. Lien For Taxes.

Il any person liable to pay any tax neglects or reluses to pay the same after demand, the amount including any inder est, additional amount, addition to tax, or assessable penalty together with any costs that may accrue in addition thereto; shall be a fren in favor of the United States upon all property' and rights to property, whether feel or personal, belonging to such person.

Sec. 6322, Period of Lien.

Unless another date is specifically fixed by law, the liqu imposed by section 6321 shall arise at the time the assessment is made and shall continue until the liability for the amount so assessed (or a judgment against the taxpayer prising out of such hability! is satisfied or becomes unenforceable by reason of tapse of tires.

Sec. 6323. Validity and Priority Against Certain Persons.

(a) Purchaser's, Holders Of Security Interests. - (1) General Rule. Unless notice of tien is retited in the manner prescribed in paragraph (2) during the repuried refiling period, such notice of firm shall be freated as filed on the date on which it is filed (in accordance with subsection (f)) after the expiration of such criting period.
