Excerpts From Internal Revenue Coue

Sec. 6321. Lien For Taxes.

If any person liable to pay any tax neglects or refused to pay the same after demand, the amount including any interest, additional amount, addition to tax, or assessable penalty together with any costs that may accrue in addition theration shall be a lien in favor of the United States upon all property and rights to property, whether real or personal, belonging to such person.

Sec. 6322. Period of Lien.

Unless another date is specifically fixed by law, the litar... imposed by section 0321 shall arise at the time the assessment is made and shall continue until the flability for the amount so assessed (or a judgment against the larpayer arising out of such flability) is satisfied or becomes unenforceable by reason of tapse of time.

Sec. 6323. Validity and Priority Against Certain Persons.

(a) Purchasor's, Holders Of Security interests. Mechanic's Lienors, And Judgment Lien-Geditors.— The lien imposed by section 6321 shall not be valid as against any purchase, holder of a security interest, mechanic's lienor, or judgment lien creditor until notice thereof which meets the requirements of subsection (f) has been filed by the Secretary.

(b) Protection For Certain Interests Even Though Notice Filad. — Even though notice of a lien imposed by section 5321 has been filed, such lien shall not be valid.

(n) Place For Filing Notice; Form.—

- (1) Place for filling. The notice referred to in subsection (a) shall be filed.—
 - (A) "Under State Laws."
 - (i) Real Property. In the case of real property, in one office within the Stale (or the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the lien is situated, and
 - (ii) Personal Property. In the case of personal property, whether langible or intangible, in one office within the State (or the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the lien is situated;
 - (B) With Clerk Of District Court. In the office of the clerk of the United States district court for the judicial district in which the property subject to lien is situated, whenever the State has not by law designated one office

Sec. 6325. Rolease Of Lien Or Discharge Of Property.

- (a) Roleans Of Lien. Subject to such regulations as the Sec etary may prescribe, the Secretary may issue a contricate of release of any fine imposed with respect to any internal evenue tax if -
- (1) Liability Salisited or Unenforceable. The Secretary finds that the liability for the amount assessed, together with all interest in respect thereof, has been fully salistied or has become enaily unenforceable. It
- (2) Bond Accepted there is furnished to the Secretary and accepted by him a bond that is conditioned upon the payment of the amount assessed, together with all interest in expect thereof, within the time prescribed by the (including any extension of such time), and that is in accordance with such requirements relating to terms, conditions, and form of the bond and sureties thereun, as may be specific, by such regulations

- (k) Disclosure of Certain Returns and Return Information For Tax Administration Purposes. —
- (2) Disclosure of amount of autotanding tien. If a notice of tien has been filled pursuent to section 6323(f), the amount of the outstanding obligation secured by such tien may be disclosed to any serson who furnithes satisfactory written evidence that he has a right in the property subject to such lien or intends to obtain it right in such property.
