

This Indenture, Made this 23rd day of May 1986, between the First National Bank in Chicago Heights, a corporation duly organized and existing under the laws of the United States of America and qualified to do a trust business under and by virtue of the laws of the State of Illinois, as trustee under the provisions of a deed or deeds duly recorded and delivered to said company in pursuance of a trust agreement dated the twenty-seventh day of March, 1972, and known as Trust No. 1708, party of the first part, and Robert L. Mack and Dolores Cohn Mack, husband and wife, of Olympia Fields, Illinois, party of the second part.

Witnesseth, That said party of the first part, in consideration of the sum of _____ Dollars, and other good and valuable considerations in hand paid, does hereby grant, sell and convey unto said party of the second part, not in tenancy in common but in joint tenancy, with right of survivorship, the following described real estate, situated in Cook County, Illinois, to-wit:

Lot 61 in Graymoor, a Subdivision of the East 1/2 of the Northwest 1/4 and the North fifty acres of the West 1/2 of the Northwest 1/4 of Section 18, Township 35 North, Range 14, East of the Third Principal Meridian, in Cook County, Illinois

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together with the tenements and appurtenances thereunto belonging.

To Have and to Hold the same unto said party of the second part, and to the proper use, benefit and behoof forever of said party of the second part, not in tenancy in common but in joint tenancy with right of survivorship.

This deed is executed pursuant to and in the exercise of the power and authority granted to and vested in said trustee by the terms of said deed or deeds in trust delivered to said trustee in pursuance of the trust agreement above mentioned. This deed is made subject to the lien of every trust deed or mortgage (if any there be) of record in said county given to secure the payment of money, and remaining unreleased at the date of the delivery hereof.
