THE COVENANTS, CONDITIONS AND PROVISIONS REFERRED TO ON PAGE 1 (THE REVERSE SIDE OF THIS TRUST DEED):

I. Mortgago(s shall (a) promptly repair, restore or rebuild any buildings or improvements now or hereafter on the premises which may become damaged or be destroyed; (b) from this premises in good condition and repair, without waste, and free from mechanics, or other liens or claims for then not expressly subspicing and the filen hereof; (c) pay when due any indebtedness which may be secured by a lien or charge on the premises superior to the lien herbit; and applied exhibit satisfactory evidence of the discharge of such prior lien to I rustee or to Holders of the Note; (d) complete within a reasonable time any building or buildings now or at any time in process of erection upon said premises; (c) comply with all requirements of law or municipal ordinances with respect to the premises and the use thereof; (f) make no material alterations in said premises except as required by law or municipal ordinance or as authorized by the Holders of the Note.

2. Mortgagors shall pay before any penalty attaches all general taxes, and shall pay special taxes, special assessments, water charges, sower service charges, and other charges against the premises when due, and shall upon written request, turnish to Trustee or Polders of the Note duplicate receipts therefor.
