ORDER

This case is before the Court on plaintiff's, Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation ("FDIC"), motion for summary judgment. Plaintiff submitted a Local Rule 12 Statement of Material Facts as to which there is no dispute. See General Local Rule 12(e). Defendants have failed to submit a 12(f) statement of genuine issues and, therefore, the matters submitted in the 12(e) statement are deemed admitted. Seneral Local Rule 12(f).

The undisputed facts establish that defendent executed a guaranty for the debt on a mortgage and mortgage note executed by Pelron Corporation. Pelron Corporation failed to make timely payments on the note and is in default. Exercising its rights under the note, the holder, the FDIC, accelerated all sums due. Thus, FDIC seeks judgment against Paul E. Pelletier for the amount of principal and interest due on the note.

Because there are no genuine issues of material fact and FDIC is entitled for judgment as a matter of law, judgment is entered in favor of plaintiff, FDIC, and against defendant, Paul E. Pelletier, in the amount of \$309,535.16 plus interest in the amount of \$163,195.14.
