TRUST DEED

THIS INDENTURE, Made July 30, 1986, between Citizens Bank & Trust Company, an Illinois Banking Corporation, not personally but as Trustee under the provisions of a Deed or Deeds in trust duly recorded and delivered to said Bank in pursuance of a Trust Agreement dated 11/22/68 and known as trust number L-1117, herein referred to as "First Party," and Chicago Title and Trust Co. of the State of Illinois, not personally but as and by virtue of the laws of an Illinois corporation herein referred to as TRUSTEE, witnesseth:

THAT, WHEREAS First Party has concurrently herewith executed an instalment note bearing even date here-with in the Principal Sum of Fifty-two thousand (\$52,000.00)

Dollars,

made payable to BEARER

and delivered, in and by which said Note the First Party promises to pay out of that portion of the trust estate subject to said Trust Agreement and hereinafter specifically described, the said principal sum and Interest from August 1, 1986 on the balance of principal remaining from time to time unpaid at the rate of Ten (10%) percent per annum in instalments as follows: One Thousand Six Hundred Seventy-Seven & 89/100 (\$1,677.89)

Dollars on the first day of August 1986 and One Thousand Six Hundred Seventy-Seven & 89/100

Dollars on the first day of each month thereafter until said note is fully paid except that the final payment of principal and interest, if not sooner paid, shall be due on the first day of July 1989. All such payments on account of the indebtedness evidenced by said note to be first applied to interest on the unpaid principal balance and the remainder to principal; provided that the principal of each instalment unless paid when due shall bear interest at the rate of fifteen per cent per annum, and all of said principal and interest being made payable at such banking house or trust company in Chicago Illinois, as the holders of the note may, from time to time, in writing appoint, and in absence of such appointment, then at the office of Louis A. Blacher, 95 W. Grand Avenue, Lake Villa, Illinois in said City.

NOW, THEREFORE, First Party to secure the payment of the said principal sum of money and said interest in accordance with the terms, provisions and limitations of this trust deed, and also in consideration of the sum of One Dollar in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, does by these presents grant, remise, release, alien and convey unto the First Party, its successors and assigns, the following described Real Estate situated, lying and being in the COUNTY OF COOK AND STATE OF ILLINOIS, to wit:

LOTS 5, 6, 7, 8 AND 9 IN BLOCK 1 IN JENNINGS' SUBDIVISION OF LOT 2 IN THE COUNTY CLERK'S DIVISION OF THE EAST THREE-QUARTER OF SECTION 33, TOWNSHIP 40 NORTH, RANGE 13 EAST OF THE THIRD PRINCIPAL MERIDIAN, IN COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS.

which, with the property hereinafter described, is referred to herein as the "premises". TOGETHER with all improvements, fixtures, easements, and appurtenances thereto belonging, and all rents, issues and profits thereof for so long and during all such time as First Party, its successors or assigns may be entitled thereto (which are pledged primarily and in a parity with said real estate and not secundarily), and all apparatus, equipment or articles now or hereafter used or therein used to supply heat, gas, air conditioning, water, light, power, refrigeration, telephone, radio, centrally controlled, and ventilation, including (without restricting the foregoing) screens, window shades, storm doors and windows, floor coverings, Indian beds, awnings, stoves and water heaters. All of the foregoing are deemed to be a part of said real estate whether physically attached thereto or not, and it is agreed that all similar apparatus, equipment or articles hereafter placed in the premises by First Party or its successors or assigns shall be considered as constituting part of the real estate.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the premises unto the said Trustee, its successors and assigns, forever, for the purpose, and upon the uses and trusts herein set forth.

IT FURTHER UNDERSTOOD AND AGREED THAT:

1. Until the indebtedness aforesaid shall be fully paid, and in case of the failure of First Party, its successors or assigns to: (1) promptly repair, restore or rebuild any buildings or improvements now or hereafter on the premises which may become damaged or be destroyed; (2) keep said premises in good condition and repair without waste, and from mechanical or other liens or claims for lien, not expressly subordinated to the lien hereof; (3) pay when due any indebtedness which may be required, a lien or charge on the premises superior to the lien hereof, and upon request exhibit satisfactory evidence of the discharge of such prior lien to Trustee or to holders of the notes; (4) complete within a reasonable time any building or buildings now or at any time in process of erection upon said premises; (5) comply with all requirements of law or municipal ordinances with respect to the premises and the use thereof; (6) refrain from making material alterations in said premises except as required by law or municipal ordinance; (7) pay before any penalty attaches all general taxes, and pay special taxes, special assessments, water charges, sewer service charges, and other charges against the premises when due, and upon written request, to furnish to Trustee or to holders of the note duplicate receipts therefor; (8) pay in full under protest, in the manner provided by statute, any tax or assessment which First Party may desire to contest; (9) keep all buildings and improvements now or hereafter situated on said premises insured against loss or damage by fire, lightning or windstorm under policies providing for payment by the insurance companies of moneys sufficient either to pay the cost of replacing or repairing the same or to pay in full the indebtedness secured hereby, all in companies satisfactory to the holder of the note, under insurance policies payable, in case of loss or damage, to Trustee for the benefit of the
