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Excerpts From Internal Revenue Cody

Sec. 6321. Lien For Taxes.

If any person liable to pay any tax neglects or reluses to pay the same after demand, the amount (including any interest, additional amount, addition to tax, or assessable penalty, together with any costs that may accrue in addition thereto) shall be a lien in favor of the United States upon all property and rights to property, whether real or personal, belonging Le such person,

Sec. 6322. Period Of Lien.

Unless another date is specifically fixed by law; the fien Imposed by section 6321 shall arise at the tine) the assessment is made and shall continue until the liability for the amount so assessed (or a judgment against the taxpayar arising out of auch liability) is satisfied or becomes unenforceable by reason at lages of time.

Sec. 6323. Validity and Priority Against Œ Certain Persons.

(a) Purchasers; Holders Of Security Interests, Mechanics Lienors, And Judgment Lien Creditors. The lien imposed by section \$321 shall not be valid as against any succhaser, holder of a security interest, mechanics lienor, or judgment lien creditor until notice thereof which meets the requirements of subsection (f) has been filled by the Secretable. been filed by the Secretary

on Place For Filing Notice; Form.—

(1) Place For Filling - The notice rederred to in subrection (a) shall be filed -

(A) Under State Laws

(i) Real Property - In the case of real property, in one office within the State for the county, or other governmental, subdivision) as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the lien is situated; and

(ii) Personal Property - In the case of personal property, whether tangible or inlangible, in one office within the State (or the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the lien is situated;

(B) With Clerk Of District Court - In the hillies of the clerk of the United States district court for the judicial district in which the property subject to lien is situated, whi never the State has not by law designated one office which meets the requirements of subparagraph (A), or

(C) With Recorder Of Deeds Of The Distrut Of Columbia - in the office of the Recorder of Deeds of the District of Columbia; if the property subject to the ilen is situated in the District of Revenue Official

(2) Situs Of Property Subject To Lien - For purposes of paragraphs (1) and (4), property shall be deemed to be situated -

(A) Real Property - In the case of real property, at its physical location; or

(Rt Personal Property - In the case of personal property, who her tangible or intangible, at the residence of the taxpayer at the time the notice of ilen is filed.

For puryose s of paragraph (2) (B), the residence of a corporation or participate shall be deemed to be the place at which the principal eleculur office of the business is located, and the residence of a funyayer whose residence is without the United

Status shall be de imed to be in the District of Columbia.

[8] Form • The form and content of, the notice. referred to in subsection (a) shall be prescribed by the Secretary. Such notice shall be valid notwithstanding any other provision of law regarding the form or content of a notice of line.

- (g) Refilling Of Notice. For purposes of this section -
- (1) General Rule. Unless notice of lien is refilted in the manner prescribed in paragraph (2) during the required refilling period, such notice of livn shall be treated as filled on the date on which it is filed (in accordance with subsection (f)) after the expiration of such refiling period.
- (2) Place For Filing. A notice of lien refiled during the required refilling period shall be effective only -

(i) such notice of lien is refiled in the office in which the prior notice of lien was filed, and

(ii) in the case of real property, the fact of reliling isentered and recorded in an index to the extent required by subsection (f) (4), and

(B) In any case in which, 90 days or more prior to the date of a refilling of notice of lien under subparagraph (A), the Secretary received written information (in the manner prescribed in requisitions issued by the Secretary) concerning a change in the texpayer's residence, if a notice of such Hen is also filed in accordance with subsection (f) in the State in which such residence is located.

(3) Required Refiling Period. — in the case of any notice of tien, the term "required refiling period" means-(A) the one-year period ending 30 days after the expiration of 6 years after the date of the assessment of the tax, and (B) the one-year period anding with the expiration of 6 years. after the close of the praceding required refilling period for auch notice of lien.

Release Of Lien Or Discharge Of Property. Sec. 6325.

(a) Release Of Lien. - Subject to such regulations as the Secretary may prescribe, the Secretary shall Issue a certificate of release of any lien imposed with respect to any internal revenue tax not later than 30 days after the day on which -

(1) Liability Satisfied or Unenforceable - The Secretary finds that the liability for the amount assessed, together with all interest in respect thereof, has been fully satisfied or has

become legally unaziorpable; of

(7) Bond Accepted - There is furnished to the Secretary and are pied by him a bond that is conditioned upon the payment of the amount assessed, together with all Interest in respect therer, wit in the time prescribed by law (including any extension of each time), and that is in accordance with such requirements to sung to terms, conditions, and form of the bond and sureties their un, as may be specified by such regulations.

Sec. 6103. Confidentiality and Disclosure of Returns and Return Information.

(k) Disclosure, of Certain Returns and Return Information For Tax Administration Purposes. -

(2) Disclosure of amount of outstanding lien. - If a notice of lien has been filed pursuant to section 6323(1), the amount of the outstanding obligation secured by such hen may be disclosed to any person who furnishes satisfactory written evidence that he has a right in the property subject to such ben or intends to obtain a right in such property.
