

Sec. 6321. Lien For Taxes.

If any person liable to pay any lax neglects or refuses so pay the same after demand, the amount (including any interet, additional amount, addition to tax, or assessable penalty separater with any coase that may accrue in addition thereig) shall be a lien in terror of the United States upon all property and rights to preparity, whether real or personal, belonging

Sec. 6322. Period Of Lien.

Unless another date is specifically fixed by law, the lien ed by section 6321 shall arise at the time the assessment is made and shall continue until the liability for the amount so ed for a judgment against the taxpayer arising out of such Nability) is callated or becomes unenforceable by resease of lappe of the

Sec. 6323. Validity and Priority Against Certain Persons.

(a) Purchaser's, Holders Of Security In-lerests, Mechanic's Lienors, And Judgment Lien Creditors. — Tudien imposed by section \$321 shall net be valid as against simpourchaser, holder of a security interest, mechanic's tienor or bidgment iter creditor until notice thereof which meets the delirements of subsection (f) has been filed by the Secretary.

## m Place For Filing Notice; Form.-

(1) Place For Filing The notice referred to in sub-

ection (a) shall be flied -(A) Linder State Laws

(i) Real Property - In the case of real property, in one office within the State (or the county, or other governmental auditivision, as designated by the faws of such State, in which the property subject to the lien is situated; and

(ii) Personal Property - in the case of personal property, whether tempitals or intengible, in one office within the State (or the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the lien is allusted:

(B) With Clark Of District Court - In the office of the clark of the United States district court for the judicial district in which the property subject to lien is situated, whenever the State has r not by law designated one office which meets the requirements of aubparagraph (A), or

(C) With Recorder Of Deeds Of The District Of Columbia - In the office of the Recorder of Doods of the District of Columbia, if the property subject to the Nen is situated in the District of **Celympia**j y y (5 - 4 - 1 - 9 - 5 - 4 - 5

(2) Situs Of Property Subject To Lien - For purposes of paragraphs (1) and (4), property shall be deemed to be situated -

(A) Real Property - In the case of real property, at its physical location; or

(B) Personal Property - In the case of personal property, ther tangible or intangible, at the residence of the taxpt yer at the time the notice of lien is filed.

For purposes of paragraph (2) (8), the residence of a corporation or gart less in shall be deemed to be the place at which the oringipal ericulive office of the business is located, and the residence of the name whose residence is without the United States shall be wer med to be in the District of Columbia.

(a) Form . The ratio and content of the notice referred to in subsection (a) shall be prescribed by the Secretary. Such notice while welld natwithstanding any ather provision of law recent with form or content of a notice of iten

(4) Refiling Of Notice. - For purposes of this section

(1) General Rule. - Unless notice of tien is refiled in the manner prescribed in paragraph (2) during the required refiling period, such notice of lien shall be treated as filed on the date on which it is filled (in accordance with subsection (f)) after the expiration of such refiling period

(2) Place For Filling. — A notice of tien refiled during the required retiling behind that he effective only

(i) such notice of lien is refiled in the office in which the prior notice of lien was filed, and

(ii) in the case of real property, the fact of reliting (s entered and recorded in an index to the extent required by autisection (f) (4), and

(B) in any case in which 90 days or more prior to the date of a ratiling of notice of lien under subparagraph (A), the

Secretary received written information (in the maniprescribed in regulations issued by the Escretary) concerning a change in the taxpayer's residence, if a notice of such lien is also filed in accordance with subsection (I) in the State in which such residence is insaled.

(3) Required Refilling Period. — in the case of any notice of lien, the term "required refilling period" means -(A) the one-year pariod anding 30 days after the expiration of 8 years after the date of the pasesement of the tex, and (B) the one-year period ending with the expiration of 6 years after the cipes of the preceding required refling period for such notice of fish.

6325. Lien Or Release Of Discharge Of Property.

(a) Release Of Lien. - Subject to such regulations as the Secretary may prescribe, the Secretary shall tasue a certificate of release of any lien imposed with respect to any internal revenue tax not later than 30 days after the day on

become legally unenforceable; or

(2) Bond Accepted - There is furnished to the Secretary and according by him a bond that is conditioned upon the payment of th amount assessed, together with all interest in respect thereof em in the time prescribed by law (including any extention of such time), and that is in accordance with such requirematine rulating to terms, conditions, and form of the bond. and suratio, thy lean, as may be assocified by such regulations.

(2) Disclosure of amount of outstanding hen in 11 a notice of lien has been filed pursuant to section 6323(f), the amount of the outstanding obligation secured by such tien may be disclosed to any person who furnishes satisfactory written evidence that he has a right in the property subject to such lien or intands to optain a right in such property.
