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MORTGAGE

THIS MORTGAGE ("Security Instrument") is given on July 18, 1987. The mortgagor is Jerald R. Alexander and Kay A. Alexander, his wife, in joint tenancy ("Borrower"). This Security Instrument is given to First Commercial Bank of Rolling Meadows, which is organized and existing under the laws of Illinois, and whose address is 2701 Algonquin Road, Rolling Meadows, IL 60008 ("Lender"). Borrower owes Lender the principal sum of Forty Thousand and no/100* Dollars (U.S. \$40,000.00). This debt is evidenced by Borrower's note dated the same date as this Security Instrument ("Note"), which provides for monthly payments, with the full debt, if not paid earlier, due and payable on January 14, 1988. This Security Instrument secures to Lender: (a) the repayment of the debt evidenced by the Note, with interest, and all renewals, extensions and modifications; (b) the payment of all other sums, with interest, advanced under paragraph 7 to protect the security of this Security Instrument; and (c) the performance of Borrower's covenants and agreements under this Security Instrument and the Note. For this purpose, Borrower does hereby mortgage, grant and convey to Lender the following described property located in Cook County, Illinois:

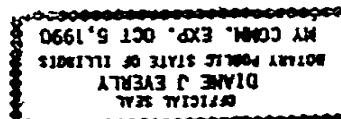

22. Whether or Homeestead. Borrower waives all right of homestead excepted

appointed receiver shall be entitled to enter upon, take possession of and manage the Property and to collect the rents of
the Property including those past due. Any rents collected by Lender or the receiver shall be applied first to payments on
costs of management of the Property and collection of rents, including, but not limited to, receiver's fees, premiums on
rewards and reasonable attorney's fees, and then to the sums secured by this Security
Instrument. Upon payment of all sums secured by this Security Instrument, Lender shall release this Security
Instrument without charge to Borrower. Borrower shall pay any recording costs.

21. Releasee. Upon payment of all sums secured by this Security Instrument, Lender shall release this Security
Instrument the date specified in the notice, Lender at its option may release this Security Instrument in full or all sums secured by
this Security Instrument which further demand and may require immediate payment in full of all sums secured by
Lender shall be entitled to collect all expenses incurred in pursuing the remedies provided in this paragraph 19, including,
but not limited to, reasonable attorney's fees and costs of title evidence.

20. Lender in Possession. Upon acceleration under paragraph 19 or abandonment of the Property and at any time
prior to the expiration of any period of redemption following judicial sale, Lender (in person, by agent or by judgment
appointed receiver) shall be entitled to repossess all rights of homestead excepted in this paragraph 19, including,
but not limited to, reasonable attorney's fees and costs of title evidence.

19. Acceleration; Remedies. Lender shall give notice to Borrower prior to acceleration following Borrower's
breach of any covenant or agreement in this Security Instrument (but not prior to acceleration under paragraphs 13 and 17
unless specifically set forth elsewhere). The notice shall specify: (a) the action required to cure the
default; (c) a date, not less than 30 days from the date the notice is given to Borrower, by which the default must be cured;
and (d) the failure to cure the default on or before the date specified in the notice may result in acceleration of the sums
secured by this Security Instrument, foreclose by judicial proceeding and sale of the Property. The notice shall further
inform Borrower of the right to remit after acceleration and the right to assert in the foreclosure proceeding the non-
existence of a default or any other defense after acceleration and the right to cure the default is not cured on or
before the date specified in the notice, Lender at its option may further demand and may require immediate payment
of all sums secured by this Security Instrument which further demand and may require immediate payment in full of all sums
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secured by this Security Instrument, foreclose by judicial proceeding and sale of the Property. If the notice shall further
specify a date for acceleration and the right to assert in the foreclosure proceeding the non-existence of a default or
any other defense after acceleration and the right to cure the default is not cured on or before the date specified in the notice,
Lender shall be entitled to collect all expenses incurred in pursuing the remedies provided in this paragraph 19, including,
but not limited to, reasonable attorney's fees and costs of title evidence.

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NON-UNIFORM COVENANTS. Borrower and Lender further covenant and agree as follows:

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If Lender required mortgage insurance as a condition of making the loan secured by this Security Instrument, Borrower shall pay the premiums required to maintain the insurance in effect until such time as the requirement for the insurance terminates in accordance with Borrower's and Lender's written agreement or applicable law.

8. Inspection. Lender or its agent may make reasonable entries upon and inspections of the Property. Lender shall give Borrower notice at the time of or prior to an inspection specifying reasonable cause for the inspection.

9. Condemnation. The proceeds of any award or claim for damages, direct or consequential, in connection with any condemnation or other taking of any part of the Property, or for conveyance in lieu of condemnation, are hereby assigned and shall be paid to Lender.

In the event of a total taking of the Property, the proceeds shall be applied to the sums secured by this Security Instrument, whether or not then due, with any excess paid to Borrower. In the event of a partial taking of the Property, unless Borrower and Lender otherwise agree in writing, the sums secured by this Security Instrument shall be reduced by the amount of the proceeds multiplied by the following fraction: (a) the total amount of the sums secured immediately before the taking, divided by (b) the fair market value of the Property immediately before the taking. Any balance shall be paid to Borrower.

If the Property is abandoned by Borrower, or if, after notice by Lender to Borrower that the condemnor offers to make an award or settle a claim for damages, Borrower fails to respond to Lender within 30 days after the date the notice is given, Lender is authorized to collect and apply the proceeds, at its option, either to restoration or repair of the Property or to the sums secured by this Security Instrument, whether or not then due.

Unless Lender and Borrower otherwise agree in writing, any application of proceeds to principal shall not extend or postpone the due date of the monthly payments referred to in paragraphs 1 and 2 or change the amount of such payments.

10. Borrower Not Released; Forbearance By Lender Not a Waiver. Extension of the time for payment or modification of amortization of the sums secured by this Security Instrument granted by Lender to any successor in interest of Borrower shall not operate to release the liability of the original Borrower or Borrower's successors in interest. Lender shall not be required to commence proceedings against any successor in interest or refuse to extend time for payment or otherwise modify amortization of the sums secured by this Security Instrument by reason of any demand made by the original Borrower or Borrower's successors in interest. Any forbearance by Lender in exercising any right or remedy shall not be a waiver of or preclude the exercise of any right or remedy.

11. Successors and Assigns Found; Joint and Several Liability; Co-signers. The covenants and agreements of this Security Instrument shall bind and benefit the successors and assigns of Lender and Borrower, subject to the provisions of paragraph 17. Borrower's covenants and agreements shall be joint and several. Any Borrower who co-signs this Security Instrument but does not execute the Note: (a) is co-signing this Security Instrument only to mortgage, grant and convey that Borrower's interest in the Property under the terms of this Security Instrument; (b) is not personally obligated to pay the sums secured by this Security Instrument; and (c) agrees that Lender and any other Borrower may agree to extend, modify, forbear or make any accommodations with regard to the terms of this Security Instrument or the Note without that Borrower's consent.

12. Loan Charges. If the loan secured by this Security Instrument is subject to a law which sets maximum loan charges, and that law is finally interpreted so that the interest or other loan charges collected or to be collected in connection with the loan exceed the permitted limits, then: (a) any such loan charge shall be reduced by the amount necessary to reduce the charge to the permitted limit; and (b) any sums already collected from Borrower which exceeded permitted limits will be refunded to Borrower. Lender may choose to make this refund by reducing the principal owed under the Note or by making a direct payment to Borrower. If a refund reduces principal, the reduction will be treated as a partial prepayment without any prepayment charge under the Note.

13. Legislation Affecting Lender's Rights. If enactment or expiration of applicable laws has the effect of rendering any provision of the Note or this Security Instrument unenforceable according to its terms, Lender, at its option, may require immediate payment in full of all sums secured by this Security Instrument and may invoke any remedies permitted by paragraph 19. If Lender exercises this option, Lender shall take the steps specified in the second paragraph of paragraph 17.

14. Notices. Any notice to Borrower provided for in this Security Instrument shall be given by delivering it or by mailing it by first class mail unless applicable law requires use of another method. The notice shall be directed to the Property Address or any other address Borrower designates by notice to Lender. Any notice to Lender shall be given by first class mail to Lender's address stated herein or any other address Lender designates by notice to Borrower. Any notice provided for in this Security Instrument shall be deemed to have been given to Borrower or Lender when given as provided in this paragraph.

15. Governing Law; Severability. This Security Instrument shall be governed by federal law and the law of the jurisdiction in which the Property is located. In the event that any provision or clause of this Security Instrument or the Note conflicts with applicable law, such conflict shall not affect other provisions of this Security Instrument or the Note which can be given effect without the conflicting provision. To this end the provisions of this Security Instrument and the Note are declared to be severable.

16. Borrower's Copy. Borrower shall be given one conformed copy of the Note and of this Security Instrument.

17. Transfer of the Property or a Beneficial Interest in Borrower. If all or any part of the Property or any interest in it is sold or transferred (or if a beneficial interest in Borrower is sold or transferred and Borrower is not a natural person) without Lender's prior written consent, Lender may, at its option, require immediate payment in full of all sums secured by this Security Instrument. However, this option shall not be exercised by Lender if exercise is prohibited by federal law as of the date of this Security Instrument.

If Lender exercises this option, Lender shall give Borrower notice of acceleration. The notice shall provide a period of not less than 30 days from the date the notice is delivered or mailed within which Borrower must pay all sums secured by this Security Instrument. If Borrower fails to pay these sums prior to the expiration of this period, Lender may invoke any remedies permitted by this Security Instrument without further notice or demand on Borrower.

18. Borrower's Right to Reinstate. If Borrower meets certain conditions, Borrower shall have the right to have enforcement of this Security Instrument discontinued at any time prior to the earlier of: (a) 5 days (or such other period as applicable law may specify for reinstatement) before sale of the Property pursuant to any power of sale contained in this Security Instrument; or (b) entry of a judgment enforcing this Security Instrument. Those conditions are that Borrower: (a) pays Lender all sums which then would be due under this Security Instrument and the Note had no acceleration occurred; (b) cures any default of any other covenants or agreements; (c) pays all expenses incurred in enforcing this Security Instrument, including, but not limited to, reasonable attorneys' fees; and (d) takes such action as Lender may reasonably require to assure that the lien of this Security Instrument, Lender's rights in the Property and Borrower's obligation to pay the sums secured by this Security Instrument shall continue unchanged. Upon reinstatement by Borrower, this Security Instrument and the obligations secured hereby shall remain fully effective as if no acceleration had occurred. However, this right to reinstate shall not apply in the case of acceleration under paragraphs 13 or 17.

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Lender may take action under this paragraph if Lender does not have to do so.
Any amounts disbursed by Lender under this paragraph shall become additional debt of Borrower secured by this
Security instrument unless Borrower and Lender agree to terms of payment Lender from which interest shall bear interest from
the date of disbursement at the Note rate and shall be payable, with interest, upon notice from Lender to Borrower.

7. Protection of Lemder's Rights in the Property: If Borrower fails to perform the covenants and agreements contained in this Security Interest, then Lender may immediately exercise his rights in the property. If Borrower fails to pay the amount due, then Lender may proceed to sell the property to satisfy the debt.

Instrumental immateriality prior to the acquisition.

Unless Lender and Borrower otherwise agree in writing, any application of proceeds to principal is all not extend or when the notice is given.

All insurance policies and renewals shall be acceptable to Lender, and any standard mortgage clause. Lender shall have the right to hold the policies and renewals, if Lender requires it. Borrower shall promptly give to Lender receipts of paid premiums and renewals. In the event of loss, Borrower shall give prompt notice to the insurance carrier and Lender. Lender may make proof of loss if not made promptly by Borrower.

3. Application of Amendments. Unless applicable law provides otherwise, all payments received by Lender under paragraphs 1 and 2 shall be applied first, to late charges due under the Notes; second, to principal charges due under the Notes; third, to amounts payable under paragraph 2; fourth, to interest due, and last, to principal due.

2. Funds for Taxes and Insurance. Subject to applicable law or to a written waiver by Lender, Borrower shall pay the principal of and interest on the debt evidenced by the Note and any charges due under this Note.
