

#### Excerpts From Internal Revenue Cride

#### Sec. 6321. Lien For Taxes.

If any person liable to pay any tax neglects or refuses to pay the same after demand, the amount (including any interest, additional amount, addition to tax, or assessable penalty, together with any costs that may accrue in addition thereto) shall be a lien figure of the United States upon all property and rights to property, whether real or personal, belonging to such person.

#### Sec. 6322; Reriod Of Lien.

Unless another date its ispecifically fixed by law, the lean imposed by section 6321 shall arise at the time the assessment is flage and shall continue until the liability for the amount so assessed (or a judgment against the taxpayer arising out of such liability) is satisfied or becomes unenforceable by reason of lapse of time.

# Sec. 6323. Validity and Priority Against Certain Persons.

19 Purchaser's, Holders Of Security Interests, Mechanic's Lienors, And Judgment Lieff Creditors. — The Nen imposed by section 5321 shall not be valid as against any purchaser, holder of a security interest, mechanic's lienor, or judgment lien creditor until notice thereof which meets the requirements of subsection (i) has been filed by the Secretary.

#### m Place For Filing Notice; Form.-

(1) Place For Filling - The notice referred to in subsection (a) shall be filed -

(A) Under State Laws

(i) Real Property - in the case of real property, in one office within the State (or the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the lien is situated; and

(ii) Personal Property - In the case of personal occuperty, whether tangible or intangible, in one office—within the State (or the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the lien is situated.

(S) With Clerk Of District Coort - In the office of the clerk of the United States district court for the judicial district in which the property subject to like its situated, whonever the State has not by law designated one office which meets the requirements of subparagraph (A) or

(C) With Recorder Of Deeds Of The District Of Columbia - In the office of the Recorder of Deeds of the District of Columbia - In the property subject to the hen is situated in the District of Columbia.

(2) Situs Of Property Subject To Lien - For purposes of paragraphs (1) and (4), property shall be deemed to be situated— (A) Real Property - In the case of real property, at its

physical togation; or

(B) Personal Property - in the case of personal property, whether tangible or intangible, at the residence of the taxp yer at the time the notice of lien is filed.

Figurposes of paragraph (2) (B), the residence of a corporation or partiers sip shall be deemed to be the place at which the principal articular office of the business is located, and the residence of a furtier whose residence is without the United States shall be to used to be in the District of Columbia.

(3) Required Refilling Period. — In the case of any notice of lien, the term required refilling period means—(A) the one-year period ending 30 days after the expiration of 6 years after the date of the assessment of the taxic and (B) the one-year period ending with the expiration of 6 years after the close of the preceding required refilling period for such notice of these preceding required refilling period for such notice of the preceding required.

### Sec. 6325. Release Of Lien Or Discharge Of Property.

(a) Release Of Lien. — Subject to such regulations as the Secretary may prescribe, the Secretary shall issue a certificate of rolease of any lien imposed with respect to any internal revenue tax not later than 30 days after the day on

(1) Liability Satisfied or Unenforceable - The Secretary finds that the liability for the amount assessed, together with all interest in respect thereof, has been fully satisfied or has become legally unenforceable; or

(2) Bond Accepted - There is furnished to the Secretary and accepted by him a bond that is conditioned upon the payment of the imount assessed, together with all interest in respect function, within the time prescribed by law (including any extension of such time), and that is in accordance with such require, and refuse to the time to terms, conditions, and form of the bond and sureties there in as may be specified by such regulations.

Sec. 6103. Confidentiality and Disclosure o Returns and Return Information.

(a) Disclosure of Certain Returns and Return Information For Tax Administration Purposes.

(2) Disclosure of amount of outstanding hen. - If a notice of lien has beenfuled pursuant to section 6323(f), the amount of the outstanding obligation secured by such Len may be disclosed to any person who fornishes satisfactory written evidence that he has a right in the property subject to such lien or intends to obtain a right in such property.
